<p>Referral ██████████ was submitted to the CAH on 1/21/14 at 9:42pm the county was notified of the child death referral on 1/22/14 at 5:47am EST.</p> <p>Approximately two weeks ago, the exact date is unknown at this time; ██████████ Sheriff's Office received information regarding an accidental drowning regarding ██████████. Three children (██████████ his older sister ██████████ age 9 and another child ██████████ age 11) were skating on a pond when all three children fell into the cold water. ██████████ and ██████████ were able to get out of the water but not able to help ██████████. They went to get help for ██████████ but by the time help arrived the child was non responsive. ██████████ was airlifted to a local hospital but was DOA. ██████████ believes the event to be an accidental drowning but an autopsy has been requested. ██████████ interviewed ██████████, his father ██████████, ██████████ mother ██████████, and her daughter ██████████. CPSI ██████████ reports these interviews were audiotaped. DCS was never contacted regarding the incident.</p>

<p>██████████ did not assist CPS as they state their investigation is complete. They are making copies of tapes and documents for CPS. CPSI ██████████ spoke with the children regarding the incident. Both ██████████ and ██████████ state the three children were playing and were having an "adventure" when they saw a dog and began following the dog. The dog began walking back and forth across the pond and would slide on the ice. ██████████ suggested the children attempt this because it looked like fun. The children had been playing on the ice for about ten minutes "when the sun came out" all three of the children fell through the ice at the same time.</p>

Reporter states that at this time the child, unknown male child, doesnt appear to be in state custody. There is no information on the unknown male child.

Currently, living in the familys home are [REDACTED] (11), unknown stepsister (age 9), father, [REDACTED] and unknown stepmother.

Referent stated that this evening [REDACTED] brought [REDACTED] into [REDACTED] Hospital with suicidal ideations.

It was reported that during dinner tonight, [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stated he wanted to kill himself. [REDACTED] then responded, Id like to kill you too. Prior to this conversation, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to pack his clothes and get out and not to come back. The stepmother and step sister heard [REDACTED] make this comment. [REDACTED] told the referent that all the things [REDACTED] told the referent are correct.

A stepbrother (whose name and age are unknown by the referent) that lived in the home with the family drowned in a pond approximately two weeks ago. [REDACTED] and his stepsister were both in the water at the time of the drowning. The stepmother got into the water in an effort to save the child, but was unsuccessful and the child died on the scene. The referent stated this has an impact on [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] wants [REDACTED] to be committed. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] has knives in his room and he cant get them away from him. [REDACTED] was on Prozac for approximately two weeks. Originally, [REDACTED] was on 10 milligrams of Prozac, then the doctor cut the dosage back to 5 milligrams, and [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED] completely off the medication. The referent spoke with a hospital case worker this evening regarding whether or not [REDACTED] needs to be admitted to a psychiatric facility, but the case worker doesnt feel like [REDACTED] needs to be admitted this evening. In September/October 2013, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital for suicidal ideations. [REDACTED] told the referent he was then sent to [REDACTED] Psychiatric Hospital in [REDACTED] TN where he was admitted. It is unknown how long he stayed at that facility.

The referent stated that it is not certain if [REDACTED] will be committed to a psychiatric hospital. He will likely be at the hospital for approximately an hour before a final decision is made. The referent stated they would like to have a DCS case worker come out and speak with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as there is concern

because [REDACTED] seems so overbearing. The referent stated that [REDACTED] is a very intelligent little boy and there's just concern for him. The referent is not aware of any dangers in the home and has only been told by [REDACTED] about [REDACTED] having the knives.

[REDACTED] said his birth mother lives in [REDACTED] and is believed to be strung out on drugs.

and he fell in before reaching the other side. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] fall in she began to run across the ice to help him and [REDACTED] fell in for the second time. [REDACTED] stated he walked over to where they were as he was afraid of falling in himself if he ran. [REDACTED] stated when he got close to them to help he fell in also. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] arm but she had to push him off or she would have drowned to. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] then grabbed his leg and [REDACTED] said had to kick him off so he could get out or he would have drowned to. [REDACTED] stated he helped [REDACTED] out of the pond and at that point they could not see [REDACTED] anymore. [REDACTED] stated they ran to the road to flag down help but no one came. [REDACTED] stated he went back to the pond and jumped in and tried to feel around for [REDACTED] but could not find him. [REDACTED] stated at that point they ran to the neighbor [REDACTED] house and he went down to the pond and got [REDACTED] out by the time the responders arrived and they flew [REDACTED] to the hospital in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated his father was at work at the time of the incident and [REDACTED] mother [REDACTED] was in the house at the time of the incident.

E.R. Dr. [REDACTED] was still working a 24 hour shift from the night before. Dr. stated he knew the child [REDACTED] had been in [REDACTED] hospital in the fall but was not sure of the circumstances. Dr. [REDACTED] stated he feels the father is a bit overwhelmed and may not know much about parenting as Mr. [REDACTED] told him his father left when he was an infant. Dr. [REDACTED] feels that continued service through [REDACTED] would be beneficial to [REDACTED]. Dr. stated the father was appropriate while at the hospital and felt it was a strength that the father even brought [REDACTED] into the E.R. at all. Dr. stated he did not have anything to do with the emergency care of [REDACTED] as he believes they flew him straight to [REDACTED].

After going over the allegations with Mr. [REDACTED] he stated he did tell [REDACTED] to leave after [REDACTED] became upset due to Mr. [REDACTED] taking the knives away that he was not supposed to have. Mr. [REDACTED] stated after [REDACTED] went outside he went and got him. [REDACTED] started saying her was just going to kill himself. Mr. [REDACTED] said that was when he took him to the E.R. to be evaluated. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he was at work when [REDACTED] drown. Mr. [REDACTED] said he was told that the children were playing and got on the ice on the pond when [REDACTED] fell through and [REDACTED] got her out and [REDACTED] fell through and they were all in a once trying to get [REDACTED] out. Mr. [REDACTED] stated they went to their neighbors who called responders and got [REDACTED] out. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he did not take [REDACTED] off his medication but said it was left while they were in [REDACTED] for 8 days for the funeral services. Mr. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has been 2 times to [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] and saw therapist [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he just wanted to get his son the help he needs and plans to follow Dr. [REDACTED] recommendations 1. To take [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] to get referred to a child Psych. 2. Get with school personnel about IEP due to [REDACTED] stating ADD issues

Mrs. [REDACTED] stated her children and her moved to TN in with Mr. [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] on 12/28/2013. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated on the evening [REDACTED] went to the E.R. Mr. [REDACTED] discovered [REDACTED] had knives in his room that he is not supposed to have. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] stated he would leave and Mr. [REDACTED] told him to go. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] went out the door Mr. [REDACTED] went after him and took him on to the E.R. because [REDACTED] stated he wanted to kill himself. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated she knows [REDACTED] goes to a therapist in [REDACTED] but not sure of the name as she recently moved to TN. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated on the day her son died the children asked her if they could go outside and have an adventure. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated she allowed them to go outside, but she never thought about them going as far as they did or ever go close to the big pond. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated Mr. [REDACTED] was at work at the time of the incident. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated by the time she got down to the pond the neighbor Mr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was already there and had gotten [REDACTED] out of the water. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated they flew [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] where he was pronounced dead around 5:33 P.M. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Home in [REDACTED]. Currently, living in the familys home are [REDACTED] (11), unknown stepsister (age 9), father, [REDACTED] and unknown stepmother.

Referent stated that this evening [REDACTED] brought [REDACTED] into [REDACTED] Hospital with suicidal ideations.

It was reported that during dinner tonight, [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stated he wanted to kill himself. [REDACTED] then responded, Id like to kill you too. Prior to this conversation, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to pack his clothes and get out and not to come back. The stepmother and step sister heard [REDACTED] make this comment. [REDACTED] told the referent that all the things [REDACTED] told the referent are correct. A stepbrother (whose name and age are unknown by the referent) that lived in the home with the family drowned in a pond approximately two weeks ago. [REDACTED] and his stepsister were both in the water at the time of the drowning. The stepmother got into the water in an effort to save the child, but was unsuccessful and the child died on the scene. The referent stated this has an impact on [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] wants [REDACTED] to be committed. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] has knives in his room and he cant get them away from him. [REDACTED] was on Prozac for approximately two weeks. Originally, [REDACTED] was on 10 milligrams of Prozac, then the doctor cut the dosage back to 5 milligrams, and [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED] completely off the medication.

The referent spoke with a hospital case worker this evening regarding whether or not [REDACTED] needs to be admitted to a psychiatric facility, but the case worker doesnt feel like [REDACTED] needs to be admitted this evening.
