Face to face contact was made with the three children on this night to verify their wellbeing. CM went to the home at [REDACTED] accompanied by [REDACTED] Sheriff's Deputies at approximately 4:15 a.m. on the morning of March 15, 2014. When CM knocked on the door, it was opened by the mother, [REDACTED]. She had not been asleep and it was evident she had been crying. She kept a washcloth in her hand throughout the conversation and continually wiped tears from her eyes. She was very cooperative and understanding about CM's request to see her children and verify their wellbeing, despite her obvious grief. She said that the baby, [REDACTED] was with [REDACTED] brother at his home and the other two children were in the apartment upstairs, with her mother. She called her mother, but she did not answer, so CM, the officers, and the mother went upstairs and knocked on the door. The door was opened by maternal grandmother, who stated that the children had just fallen asleep a few minutes earlier. Mother and grandmother embraced and grandmother stated that the two older children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], had been very upset and wanted to know where [REDACTED] was, and they had told them that she had gotten hurt really badly, and she wasn't going to be able to come home. Grandmother stated that it just seemed like a dream and they just couldn't believe what had happened. She said that the children were devastated and sad and they finally fell asleep just a few minutes prior to CM's arrival. Mother and grandmother had not yet been to sleep. CM went into the bedroom and observed the children, who were sleeping in the same bed, but had several feet between them. The lights were still on throughout the apartment and in the bedroom. Grandmother stated that they wanted to stay close to each other so she let them sleep together just for the night. The homes of both the grandmother and the mother were clean with good housekeeping standards and no immediate safety concerns were noted. Age appropriate toys were visible in both homes and there were several bicycles and toys visible in the front yard and around the front porch area. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that her brother had taken the baby, [REDACTED] and she was at his home with uncle and his girlfriend, but CM was welcome to go to the home to see the baby. Grandmother called her son, [REDACTED] (1) and advised that CM needed to come by to see the baby and he provided his street address, [REDACTED].

Mother stated that she and the children are all covered by BlueCare insurance and CM provided my phone number and advised her that grief counseling would be wise for everyone and CM could provide a resource manual or phone numbers when she was able to think about that after things are settled later in the week. She agreed this would be useful.

CM went to the home at [REDACTED] and observed the baby, [REDACTED], who was sleeping in the bedroom. The uncle and his girlfriend were awake and they stated they also had not yet been asleep, as it had been a very eventful,
