**Describe (in detail) circumstances surrounding death/near death:**

On 1/9/14, ██████████, mother, left her two youngest children ██████████, 7 weeks old, and ██████████, 3 years old, alone while she transported her 5 years old son, ██████████ to school (██████████). The children were left unsupervised for approximately 30 minutes. Ms. ██████████ reported that upon her return to the home, ██████████ was missing. She stated she attempted to quiz ██████████ about ██████████ whereabouts but was not successful. She went looking for ██████████ both in the home and outside in the neighborhood (ditches, trash bins, abandon homes, etc.). When she was unable to locate ██████████ she contacted her mother, ██████████. Ms. ██████████ came over to her home and asked if she had called the police. Ms. ██████████ stated she had not contacted the police. Ms. ██████████ then left the home and went to the paternal grandmother's (██████████) home. However, she was not present. Ms. ██████████ then went to Mr. ██████████ (birth father) brother's home. He too was not at home. Ms. ██████████ then attempted to contact Mr. ██████████. He did not answer his phone. She then proceeded to his home. Ms. ██████████ texted ██████████ and he called her asking what was wrong. She arrived at his home and told him her home had been broken into. He asked what was taken and she stated ██████████ was missing. He asked if she had called the police. She stated, "No". It is unknown how long she stayed at Mr. ██████████ home. Ms. ██████████ returned to her home. When she left the home, Mr. ██████████ contacted the ██████████ Police Department and stated Ms. ██████████ had reported to him that her home had been broken into and her baby was missing. He provided Ms. ██████████ contact information. The ██████████ contacted Ms. ██████████ while she was in route to her home. The police identified themselves and asked if her home had been broken into and if her child was missing. Ms. ██████████ stated she did not know if they were really ██████████ and hung up. It is unclear if ██████████ were on the scene when she returned to her home or if she contacted them after arriving home.

██████████ has been missing since that time. Her body was discovered on Sunday, 2/16/14. Ms. ██████████ has been arrested and charged with two counts of Murder in Perpetration of a Felony as of 2/17/14. Ms. ██████████ was previously charged with two counts of Aggravated Child Abuse. On January 14, 2014, the Department filed a No Contact Order between Ms. ██████████ and her children, ██████████ and ██████████. On January 14, 2014, Ms. ██████████ bond was dropped to \$250,000.00. On February 5, 2014, ██████████ made bail and was released from jail. Ms. ██████████ went to ██████████ to visit and eat lunch with her oldest child, ██████████. Ms. ██████████ asked ██████████ about who he was living with and what was the school asking/saying about the family's recent events. (this conversation was overheard by school staff ██████████). At the time, of this violation of the No Contact Order, ██████████ ██████████ Security Team was contacted. Three officers responded. The officers did not have any contact with Ms. ██████████ as she was leaving the premises before they could address their concerns. Officer, ██████████, was in charge at the time. It should be noted the school did not have a copy of the No Contact Order and as such Officer ██████████ was unable to ban Ms. ██████████ from the school. However, the school is now in possession of the No Contact Order. Officer ██████████ stated they observed Ms. ██████████ and her interactions with ██████████ and at no time was Ms. ██████████ volatile. On 2/14/14, the No contact Order was before Juvenile Court. At that time, the case was continued until 3/21/14. On 2/18/14, the Department filed a contempt of the No Contact Order.

He also reported attending daycare, but disclosed that baby ██████████ was too young to attend. Most of his interview was concerning dinosaurs, the movie Jurassic Park, and the "D" sound. The interview was terminated by both the interviewer, Ms. ██████████ and the observer, Sgt ██████████.

██████████ had a forensic interview on Thursday, 1/9/14. The interview was completed by ██████████ and observed by Sgt ██████████. ██████████ disclosed that his mother, ██████████ transported him to school on Thursday morning. He disclosed they had stopped and purchased donuts on the way to school. ██████████ stated his mom told him not to scribble on his school work. ██████████ reported his brother, ██████████ and sister, ██████████ had been left at the home while his mother took him to school. They were at home asleep. According to ██████████ ██████████ was on the couch asleep. However, there was not anyone left at the home with his siblings. They were left by themselves. At the end of the interview, ██████████ made two conflicting statements. One of which was that he had to sit in the front seat of the car to make room for his siblings. He reported his mom was holding ██████████ but she did not get squished. ██████████ did not explain his statements.

According to the report ██████████ did not have any broken bones or other definitive injuries to her body. The internal examination of the body did not reveal any injuries or diseases that would result in her death. The report also revealed that there were no drugs or medications in her system. Although the toxicology report was positive for alcohol-volatiles and Ethanol, these findings are consistent with postmortem changes.

Ms. ██████████ did not make eye contact with this worker. She refused to speak with this worker. The only time Ms. ██████████ did make eye contact was when this worker spoke about her sons, ██████████ and ██████████. Ms. ██████████ told the jailer to take her back to her cell. The interview was over. Ms. ██████████ refused to answer any questions about ██████████. CPSI tried to find out exactly how to spell her name and her date of birth, but Ms. ██████████ would not answer.

The Department of Children Services received a referral concerning the allegation of Lack of Supervision. The alleged victims were ██████████ and ██████████. The alleged perpetrator was ██████████. She reported Ms. [REDACTED] would not complete these tasks. She also reported that the boys initially only wanted to eat fast food. They would not eat any fruits, vegetables nor would they drink any water or milk. However, they now ask for water and milk, they eat fruit and some vegetables.

Mrs. [REDACTED] continues to be a support person for her son. When he is working, she will keep the boys. He will then come by and pick them up and take them home. Mrs. [REDACTED] also reported that she had been picking them up from school once she is out of school. She does this for all of her grandchildren. Mrs. [REDACTED] is a school teacher at [REDACTED] School. Her school gets out at 2 PM and is able to pick up the other grandchildren at 3 PM and 4 PM.

CPSI obtained a copy of the Autopsy Report this morning. According to the autopsy report, the cause of death was listed as Homicidal Violence and the manner of death was homicide. The pathological diagnosis was postmortem changes. The autopsy report disclosed that there was decomposition of the body as well as evidence of "animal activity" to [REDACTED] ears and the tips of her 3rd, 4th, and 5th fingers of her right hand. According to the report, [REDACTED] did not have any broken bones or other definitive injuries to her body. The internal examination of her body did not reveal any injuries or diseases that would result in her death. The report also revealed that there were no drugs or medications in her system. Although the toxicology report was positive for alcohol-volatiles and Ethanol, these findings are consistent with postmortem changes.
