It is unknown if the family has a history with law enforcement. The reporter has never been in the family home. It is unknown if there are any guns,

FACE TO FACE WITH CHILD- CPSI met with ██████████ ██████████ is too young to interview but she appeared happy and healthy. The home was appropriate for her and CPSI saw where she slept while visiting her grandparents.
 FACE TO FACE WITH CHILD- CPSI met with ██████████ and she said that everything was going good at her grandmother's home. She said that her mom came and saw her last night. She said that they watched TV. She said that she did go to the funeral. She said that her sister died because she was a baby. She said that she thinks after the funeral she went with her mom but not for sure and could not remember what they did. ██████████ appeared healthy and happy.

Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

COLLATERAL CONTACT- CPSI spoke to ██████████ (social worker at ██████████). She reported that ██████████ died at the ██████████ and she was transported there on 6-18 for necrotizing-enterocolitis (gi issues). She said that condition caused her death but they received the meconium on 6-24 and the child was positive for THC. She sent the medical records to the CPSI.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

ALLEGED PERPETRATOR INTERVIEW/PARENT INTERVIEW- CPSI ██████████ met in the paternal grandmother's home with ██████████ after being invited inside. ██████████ reported she knew the report was about her smoking meth and other drugs. ██████████ denies ever using methamphetamines. ██████████ admits she smokes marijuana. ██████████ agreed to a urine drug screen. ██████████ tested positive for THC. ██████████ was negative for all other tested substances. ██████████ denies using any form of drugs in front of her children. ██████████ reports she only smokes marijuana when her children are not around.

Summarize witnesses' descriptions of what they saw and what they believe indicates child abuse/neglect:

Reporter states:

██████████ (4 yrs) is in the custody of her father, ██████████ and ██████████ and ██████████ reside with ██████████ mother, ██████████ mother is ██████████ DCS has been involved with ██████████ has another child, ██████████ (2 yrs). ██████████ and ██████████ reside with ██████████ father, ██████████.

██████████ had a baby, ██████████ a few weeks ago (date of birth is unknown), and that baby never left the hospital. The baby was born prematurely and had an infection. The baby was sent from the local hospital to ██████████ for treatment. The baby died on 6/19/14, and the baby was buried on Saturday, 6/21/14. It is believed that ██████████ smoked marijuana during her pregnancy, and ██████████ could have been using "hard drugs" too. The reporter did not see ██████████ using the drugs. The reporter stated that ██████████ refused to allow an autopsy for ██████████.

On Saturday night (6/21/14), ██████████ requested that ██████████ spend the night with ██████████ as ██████████ has been allowed unsupervised visits with ██████████ for the past two months. Yesterday, ██████████ (██████████ last name unknown), ██████████ aunt, reported that ██████████ texted ██████████ on Saturday night 6/21/14, saying that they found "ice", meaning meth. The reporter saw the text. It was learned that ██████████ and ██████████ (██████████ mother) were smoking meth in the home. It was reported that they got the meth from ██████████ ██████████ stepfather. ██████████ and ██████████ were confronted about the meth, and they refused a drug screen. ██████████ reported that ██████████ and ██████████ were calling relatives looking for "clean piss".

DCS policy defines that DEI occurs when an infant who has been exposed to a drug or chemical substance (e.g., alcohol, cannabis, hallucinogens, stimulants, sedatives, narcotics, meth, heroin, inhalants or any other illegal substances), as verified by a positive drug screen.

DCS Policy defines that Drug exposed child as child who has been exposed to a drug or chemical substance that could adversely affect his/her physical, mental, or emotional functioning. Parents/caretakers who have a positive drug screen, or have admitted to the use of an illegal or non-prescribed drug or chemical substance, and whose use of drugs or chemical substances that impairs the parent/caretakers ability to meet child-care responsibilities. Impairment of the parent/caretaker's ability to meet childcare responsibilities MUST be supported by evidence, including documented examples.

DCS received a referral on 06-24-14 alleging that the ACVs, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were exposed to drugs while in the mother's care. [REDACTED] is too young to interview. [REDACTED] lives with her paternal grandmother and the biological father. [REDACTED] is in the custody of her father, [REDACTED].

The APs [REDACTED] (mother) and [REDACTED] (father) were interviewed during the case. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were on again off again throughout the case. At the closing the parents were not together. [REDACTED] denies any drug use. The mother submitted to random urine drug screens and was positive for only THC. The mother admitted to smoking THC. There was no evidence of drug use in the mother's home.

At this time the case will be classified as allegation unsubstantiated/ perp unsubstantiated.

The signs of safety include: children appear to be safe in the current placement. Well Being issues include: [REDACTED] attends [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. Permanence issues include: children have a strong bond with the mother and have extended family support.

[REDACTED] meconium screen results returned on June 24, 2014 and [REDACTED] was positive for marijuana. [REDACTED] was born at [REDACTED] on June 8, 2014. [REDACTED] was born at 27 weeks 1 day gestation. [REDACTED] weighed 2 pounds 4 ounces at birth. The mother had inadequate prenatal care.

The mother had a urine drug screen upon admission to [REDACTED] to delivery, and the mother was positive for marijuana.

[REDACTED] had a urine drug screen at [REDACTED] and it was positive for opiates. The mother was provided morphine prior to delivery and this could have caused [REDACTED] positive urine drug screen.

[REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] on June 9, 2014 due to prematurity, sepsis and respiratory distress. [REDACTED] had a meconium screen sent off for further testing by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] meconium screen results returned on June 24, 2014 and [REDACTED] was positive for marijuana. [REDACTED] was never diagnosed with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome. The mother's early delivery was due to preterm labor and premature rupture of membranes.

[REDACTED] was transferred out of [REDACTED] on June 18, 2014 and sent to [REDACTED] (neonatal intensive care unit). [REDACTED] was sent to [REDACTED] due to a diagnosis of necrotizing enterocolitis (g.i. issue). [REDACTED] passed away while at [REDACTED] on June 19, 2014. The mother refused an autopsy when the child died.
