He reported "I was only turned around for a split second when I heard to pop of the gun going off. I also heard ██████████ saying 'OUCH' and the gun was laying on the floor". Due to the child later dying, allegations of neglect death (NGD) were added to the classification report. The alleged perpetrators (AP) were [REDACTED] (other non-relative), [REDACTED] (other non-relative, who is also the AP for the NGD allegation), and [REDACTED] (birth mother), and the alleged child victim (ACV) was [REDACTED] age 4. The family has no previous history with the Department of Children Service's.

[REDACTED] reported she and her husband lock up their medications when the children come over to visit, and [REDACTED] should have known enough to lock away dangerous weapons. [REDACTED] became tearful and when asked, she reported she guessed [REDACTED] was still at the crime scene with homicide detectives and law enforcement.
