The referent stated that law enforcement responded to the daycare facility today, November 10, 2014 at 4:53 PM due to [REDACTED] calling dispatch and stating that [REDACTED] (1) was unresponsive. [REDACTED] stated to law enforcement that the child was put down for a nap and when she came back to the crib to check on him an hour later he was unconscious. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had a pacifier around his neck when he went to sleep and it had wrapped around his neck preventing him from breathing. It was unknown to the referent if the string was attached to a clip on his shirt or if had been wearing a necklace with the pacifier attached. Comments: Based on the information obtained during the investigation, there was no evidence to substantiate the allegation of Neglect Death. The autopsy report stated the following (typed verbatim): There are 2 patterned abrasions on the front of the neck with red marks extending from these abrasions upward toward the ears. The marks and abrasions are consistent with the pacifier and a cord having been around the child's neck. In my opinion, this death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging. The manner of death is accident. On March 12, 2015 SI [REDACTED] received the DCS to handle as appropriate. The Team agreed with the classification of Allegation Unsubstantiated Perpetrator Unsubstantiated.

Special Investigator [REDACTED] contacted the referent to inquire about the alleged child victim's remains. SI [REDACTED] was advised that the ACV's body was at the medical examiners office for an autopsy.

**Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?**

Summary and Interpretation autopsy report: This 1-year-old male child was reportedly found unresponsive in his play pen after a nap at a daycare facility. Despite resuscitative attempts, death was pronounced at the scene. His known medical history included nasal congestion and otitis media. He delivered by cesarean section without complications. According to the responding local law enforcement officer, the caretaker

noticed that the cord holding his pacifier was wrapped around his neck. According to first medical responders, the child was found with a blanket wrapped tightly around the neck. At postmortem examination of the body, there is no evidence of inflicted traumatic injury. There are 2 patterned abrasions on the front of the neck with red marks extending from these abrasions upward toward the ears. The marks and abrasions are consistent with the pacifier and a cord having been around the child's neck. In my opinion, this death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging. The manner of death is accident.

Alleged Perpetrator was not interviewed due to her attorney advised SI not to contact his client [REDACTED].

Ms. [REDACTED] assistant also refused to speak with SI [REDACTED] stating she had an attorney.

The Department of Children's Services (DCS) Special Investigations Unit received a referral on 11/10/2014 with an allegation of Child Neglect Death regarding non- custodial child [REDACTED]. According to the referral [REDACTED] (1) and Unknown child (age unknown) live with their mother, [REDACTED] (35) and [REDACTED] (32) in [REDACTED] TN. The referent stated that [REDACTED] daycare center, [REDACTED] is not licensed. Ms. [REDACTED] has been in operation for over 15 years and runs the daycare out of her home. She keeps 10 children between the ages of 9 weeks and 4 years of age. The referent stated that law enforcement responded to the daycare facility today, November 10, 2014 at 4:53 PM due to [REDACTED] calling dispatch and stating that [REDACTED] (1) was unresponsive. [REDACTED] stated to law enforcement that the child was put down for a nap and when she came back to the crib to check on him an hour later he was unconscious. The Emergency Medical Team (EMT's) arrived on the scene and attempted lifesaving interventions, but they were unsuccessful. EMT's noted the child had some bruising/redness to the left side of his neck, which appeared to be an indentation from a blanket or a pacifier. Life sustaining measures were ended at 16:48

The investigation into this incident was conducted by [REDACTED] County Sherriff Department Homicide Sergeant [REDACTED] and DCS Special Investigator [REDACTED]

Special Investigator (SI) [REDACTED] completed a visit with the parents of [REDACTED] at their home located in [REDACTED] TN. The parents stated they have been residing with family members to avoid the media. SI [REDACTED] spoke with both parents privately. They both stated they did not think anyone was at fault for [REDACTED] death and they believed he suffocated while he was in his crib at the daycare. They did not report any concerns with the daycare and stated they have a three year old son name [REDACTED] who also attends the daycare. They stated [REDACTED] turned one year old November 7, 2014.

The Investigator and the Law enforcement attempted to obtain statements from the daycare owner ██████████ and her assistant ██████████. The attempts were unsuccessful because individuals obtained an attorney. Special Investigator ██████████ spoke with ██████████ from the Department of Human Services Child Care Licensing. Mr. ██████████ stated he was not a supervisor when ██████████ was in operation but he would assist as much as possible. He stated ██████████ opened as a licensed daycare. He stated it was licensed from 1992 until 2007. Mr. ██████████ stated ██████████ could only have 7 children at the time she was in operation. Mr. ██████████ also stated ██████████ home was only for children who were close relatives or foster children of ██████████. ██████████ was asked to provide information concerning the daycare requirements. Mr. ██████████ stated there were no documentations for him to provide concerning daycare requirements. Mr. ██████████ stated issues such as the use of blankets in an infant crib are just best practice and there is nothing in their rules to address that. Mr. ██████████ was not able to provide any information as to why the daycare was no longer a licensed facility.

The autopsy report was obtained and did not show any evidence of an inflicted traumatic injury. There were 2 patterned abrasions on the front of the neck with red marks extending from these abrasions upward toward the ears. The marks and abrasions were reported to be consistent with the pacifier and a cord having been around the child's neck. It is the Medical Examiners opinion; this death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging. The manner of death is accidental.

The case was present to the ██████████ County Child Protection Investigation Team (CPIT) on 3/12/15. The allegation of neglect death was classified as allegation unsubstantiated/perpetrator unsubstantiated. In April 2015, Assistant District Attorney ██████████ requested for the case to be placed back on the CPIT agenda.

The case was returned to CPIT on 4/9/15. ADA ██████████ reported this daycare had a child death several years ago and lost their license. She stated her office is looking at prosecuting Ms. ██████████ for criminally negligent homicide or reckless homicide charges.

SI ██████████ spoke with ██████████, who stated there is no record of child death at this daycare.

The case was returned to CPIT on 4/30/15, 5/21/15, 5/28/15, 6/11/15, 6/25/15, 7/9/15, 7/16/15, and 8/20/15.

On 8/20/ 15, Law enforcement decided to prosecute ██████████ for reckless homicide.

The case was staffed with Investigations Coordinator ██████████ and Deputy Director of Investigations ██████████. Law enforcement and DCS were not able to obtain statements from the daycare owner or her assistant. ██████████ appears to have been supervising ██████████ appropriately on the date of this incident. She stated she noticed that the cord holding his pacifier was wrapped around his neck. The autopsy report from the ██████████ County Medical Examiner's office stated that the marks and abrasions are consistent with the pacifier and a cord having been around the child's neck. The autopsy report also stated that the child's death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging and the manner of death is accident.

DCS policy Work Aid 1 (E) defines the following criteria for Child Neglect Death:

1. Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
2. Any child death caused by abuse resulting from direct action of the child's caretaker or the consequence of the child's caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of a child. Child deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.
3. Any child death that is the result of the caretaker's failure to meet childcare responsibilities. Neglect death is always treated as severe child abuse.

The case was presented to the ██████████ County Child Protective Investigation Team on September 3, 2015. Team members were in agreement that there was not sufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation of Child Neglect Death. Based on the information obtained during the investigation, there was not enough evidence to substantiate the allegation of Neglect Death. The Medical Examiner's report stated the child's death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging and the manner of death is accident. Case will be submitted for closure as Allegation Unsubstantiated

2. LE - Don't think daycare owner put baby down. Thinks someone else did. Thinks lady in charge of baby room used to be cleaning lady. LE has pacifier tagged but don't have strong. In ME remark, has mark on neck where pacifier was stuck. ME is saying probably was an accident. Responding officer did not see string. Daycare owner said baby did not have clip for pacifier. Says she made some kind of strong, but no one has ever found it.
3. Daycare owner has never been licensed to run a daycare.
4. Prosecute, per [REDACTED], by indictment for reckless homicide.
5. Bring back 9/3/15 for SIU to staff w/management.

**Summary and Interpretation (typed verbatim)**

This 1-year-old male child was reportedly found unresponsive in his play pen after a nap at a daycare facility. Despite resuscitative attempts, death was pronounced at the scene. His known medical history included nasal congestion and otitis media. He delivered by cesarean section without complications.

According to the responding local law enforcement officer, the caretaker noticed that the cord holding his pacifier was wrapped around his neck. According to first medical responders, the child was found with a blanket wrapped tightly around the neck.

At postmortem examination of the body, there is no evidence of inflicted traumatic injury. There are 2 patterned abrasions on the front of the neck with red marks extending from these abrasions upward toward the ears. The marks and abrasions are consistent with the pacifier and a cord having been around the child's neck.

In my opinion, this death resulted from asphyxiation due to hanging. The manner of death is accident.

Central Intake received the following referral at 7:06 PM on 11/10/14. The investigation was assigned to SIU Investigator [REDACTED] with a Priority 1 response on November 10, 2014. The report stated the following:

The referent stated that [REDACTED] daycare center, [REDACTED] is not licensed. [REDACTED] has been in operation for over 15 years and runs the daycare out of her home. She keeps 10 children between the ages of 9 weeks and 4 years of age. The referent stated that law enforcement responded to the daycare facility today, November 10, 2014 at 4:53 PM due to [REDACTED] calling dispatch and stating that [REDACTED] (1) was unresponsive. [REDACTED] stated to law enforcement that the child was put down for a nap and when she came back to the crib to check on him an hour later he was unconscious. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had a pacifier around his neck when he went to sleep and it had wrapped around his neck preventing him from breathing. It was unknown to the referent if the string was attached to a clip on his shirt or if had been wearing a necklace with the pacifier attached. Law enforcement did not see a string or the pacifier around his neck upon arriving and observing the child. [REDACTED] was the adult designated to supervise the infant. It was unknown to the referent where she was when [REDACTED] was asleep. An autopsy has not been completed at this time but [REDACTED] has been taken to the Forensic center. Law enforcement has left the scene at this time. [REDACTED] and her assistant have been taken downtown for further questioning at this time.
