**Describe (in detail) circumstances surrounding death/near death:**

[redacted] received a phone call from Detective [redacted] with the [redacted] Sheriff's Dept on 9-16-14 at around 1:20p. Det [redacted] reported that there was a small child at [redacted] of [redacted] with severe burns to his body. Det [redacted] stated that he was advised that the child was being life flighted to [redacted]. CPSI and Det [redacted] arrived at [redacted] at around 1:40p. CPSI and Det [redacted] were advised by Deputy [redacted] that the child was [redacted]. Dep [redacted] reported that 85% of [redacted] body was burned. Dep [redacted] reported that the mother was [redacted] and the step-father was [redacted]. Dep [redacted] reported that [redacted] was home alone with [redacted] at the time of the incident. Dep [redacted] reported that the maternal grandparents were inside the hospital room with [redacted].

CPSI and Det [redacted] were advised that [redacted] was home alone with [redacted] when the incident occurred. It was reported that [redacted] was in the bathtub alone and got burned by the shower.

[redacted] was life flighted to [redacted] in [redacted] on 9-16-14. CPSI spoke with Social Worker [redacted] at [redacted] on 9-16-14 at 5:45p. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had arrived and was stable. [redacted] called back shortly after and reported that [redacted] vital signs had dropped and he had to be intubated. [redacted] reported that [redacted] had to be transferred to the Critical Care Unit. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had to be placed into a medically induced coma. [redacted] reported that [redacted] would have to have surgery tomorrow in regards to his injuries.

CPSI spoke with [redacted], Child Abuse Doctor, at [redacted] on 9-17-14 at 4:03p. [redacted] reported that the injuries on [redacted] were in no way consistent with the story given. [redacted] also stated that the delay in seeking medical attention was medical neglect. [redacted] stated that the burns were a slow pattern of a hot liquid with no splash pattern. [redacted] stated that the injuries were life threatening and needed to be a near fatality.

[redacted] and Det [redacted] spoke with [redacted], maternal grandfather, at [redacted] Center on 9-16-14. [redacted] reported that he was not home when the incident occurred. [redacted] reported that he had been at the dentist in [redacted]. [redacted] reported that his wife, [redacted], called him and reported that [redacted] had been burned in the shower. [redacted] stated that [redacted] and [redacted] mother, [redacted], were at a doctor's appointment in [redacted]. [redacted] newborn, [redacted], was also with them at the doctor's appointment. [redacted] reported that he got home around 11:30a and observed that [redacted] was severely burned. [redacted] reported that he told [redacted] that [redacted] needed to go to the hospital, but [redacted] refused to let [redacted] take [redacted]. [redacted] reported that [redacted] reported that [redacted] was in the shower and [redacted] had walked away when he heard [redacted] yell. He stated that [redacted] told him that [redacted] saw [redacted] running

around in the tub. [redacted] stated that [redacted] reported that [redacted] fell and hit his head on the tub. [redacted] reported that [redacted] and [redacted] arrived home shortly after he did. [redacted] reported that he and his wife got into an argument with [redacted] and [redacted] in regards to taking [redacted] to the hospital. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told him that he had to tell the hospital that she [redacted] was giving [redacted] a bath but [redacted] started crying in the next room. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told him that he had to say that [redacted] got burned when she left him to go check on [redacted]. [redacted] stated that he and [redacted] agreed to tell that story so they could take [redacted] to the hospital.

CPSI and Det [redacted] spoke with [redacted], maternal grandmother, at [redacted] Center on 9-16-14 [redacted] reported that [redacted] called [redacted] when they were heading home from [redacted]. [redacted] reported that they left home around 8:10a that morning. [redacted] stated that [redacted] called and said that there had been an incident and [redacted] had been burned in the tub. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told her that they needed to get medicine for the burn [redacted] stated that when they arrived home, she said "Oh my God, let's go to the hospital". [redacted] stated that [redacted] said no. [redacted] stated that she was supposed to tell the hospital that [redacted] was the one giving [redacted] a bath when he got burned in the tub. [redacted] stated that she couldn't lie about it though.

CPSI and Det [redacted] went to the family's residence to interview [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] reported that he got up around 8:30a that morning. He stated that he did not know [redacted] was at home at first. [redacted] stated that [redacted] was at the dentist. He stated that [redacted] and [redacted] were gone to a doctor's appointment. [redacted] stated that after [redacted] got up, he asked to take a bath. [redacted] stated that he ran [redacted] some water in the bathtub and placed him in the tub. [redacted] reported that the water was warm, but not hot. [redacted] stated that the water was around ankle deep. [redacted] stated that while the water was still running, the timer went off on the washing machine. [redacted] stated that he left [redacted] in the bathtub to go switch clothes over into the dryer. [redacted] stated that a [redacted] yelled. [redacted] stated that he told [redacted] to hold on for a second [redacted] stated that [redacted] started screaming hysterically. [redacted] stated that he ran to the hallway and saw [redacted] running around the bathtub in circles. [redacted] stated that he could see steam in the shower. [redacted] stated that before he could get into the bathroom, [redacted] fell in the tub and hit his head on the bathtub. [redacted] stated that he turned the water off and picked [redacted] up. [redacted] stated that the water in the tub was still warm. [redacted] stated that the water coming out of the shower was "scorching" hot. [redacted] stated that [redacted] kept asking for cold water. [redacted] stated that he poured cold water on [redacted] and his body blistered as soon as the cold water hit his body. [redacted] stated that [redacted] skin was red when he first got to him, but when he put the cold water on him, it blistered. [redacted] reported that this happened around 10:00a. [redacted] stated that he used a cool rag to wipe the dead skin off [redacted] body. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told him that he felt better. [redacted] stated that he called [redacted] and [redacted] and told them what happened. [redacted] stated that [redacted] got [redacted] some medicine from the pharmacy to put on the burn. [redacted] stated that they put the medication on [redacted] when [redacted] and [redacted] got home. [redacted] stated that he did not go to the hospital with [redacted], and [redacted] because he was not the parent and could not provide any information. [redacted] stated that the hospital would have turned him away.

[redacted] and Det [redacted] spoke with [redacted]. [redacted] stated that [redacted] called her between 10:00-10:30a and stated that [redacted] had gotten "burned up" in the shower. She stated that [redacted] told her that he had also fallen and hit his head. [redacted] stated that she was at [redacted] with her mother when [redacted] called. She stated that she bought spray from the pharmacist and came home. [redacted] stated that she didn't want to take [redacted] to the ER because she knew that the ER would call DCS. [redacted] stated that she wanted to call [redacted] family physician instead. [redacted] stated that she was afraid that "someone" would call DCS over the bruising and "he'd" go to jail over the burns. [redacted] stated that she did ask her parents to tell the ER that she was the one giving [redacted] the bath when he was injured. [redacted] stated that she felt that it looked better that she left him alone in the bathtub for a few seconds.

[redacted] was being triaged to be life flighted to [redacted]

After surgery, he was told that the surgery went very well and that [REDACTED] was in recovery. [REDACTED] and his father left the unit while [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], grandparents, went to see him. He said that about 5 minutes later, he got a call from [REDACTED] stating that [REDACTED] blood pressure and pulse had crashed. He stated that they had to do CPR to bring him back, did a blood transfusion due to blood loss, and he is now re-intubated and has the machine breathing for him. He said that he was currently stable and is suffering from some itching so they have given him benadryl to make him more comfortable. This FSW expressed the importance of letting us know even if it is very late in the evening.

The social worker contacted FSW [REDACTED] back while FSW was on the phone with dad and basically said the same thing, that they had to do 4 minutes of CPR about 90 minutes after surgery. He suffered from desaturation and his body temp got down to 34 degrees celsius. He is suffering from severe anemia so they are planning to do a CT scan of his abdomen and pelvis to see if he has any internal injuries that they haven't found yet because it was noted that he did not lose much blood during surgery. He is currently stable but is back on the breathing machine even though he had been taken off of it on Saturday. FSW [REDACTED] asked that we be contacted ASAP if anything like that occurs again but she reported that she didn't know until this morning either. They are sending this FSW the notes from yesterday.

Investigations Coordinator [REDACTED] spoke by phone numerous times on this date with both Lead Investigator [REDACTED], and Case Manager [REDACTED] regarding this case. In addition to the ACV, there is another child who is the half sibling of the ACV, as they share a mother. The alleged perpetrator in this case is the father of the sibling. CM [REDACTED] talked with family members about possible placements of both children in a third party placement, and at this time, none were deemed suitable. The maternal grandfather was indicated for sexual abuse on the mother of this ACV, another person who the family 'ran in to' at [REDACTED] indicated a desire to be a placement, however, she admitted that she had a marijuana charge from several years ago, and as it was after hours, it would be difficult to get a disposition. Another option was presented later, and based on information provided by another case manager, it did not appear that home would be suitable for placement. CM [REDACTED] and DCS attorney [REDACTED] spoke via three way conversation with the [REDACTED] Juvenile Court Judge, who said she would sign an Ex parte order and CM [REDACTED] could bring it to her for her signature. Both children were placed in custody. The ACV remains at [REDACTED] Hospital, in the Critical Care Unit, with skin graft surgery scheduled for 9-17-14. CM [REDACTED] will continue to investigate this case with LE and try to determine what caused the severe burns to the child, as well as to investigate the role the mother played in the delay of medical treatment for the child.
