Describe (in detail) circumstances surrounding death/near death:

On 09/22/2014 at 05:26pm, DCS received a referral with allegations of physical abuse, perpetrated by an unknown. The referral stated that the EMT was called on 9/22/2014 because ██████████ was unresponsive. ██████████ arrived at ██████████ ER about 4:50 PM. When the referral was received there was no specific information on what happened to ██████████ that could have caused him to become unresponsive.

Upon arrival at ██████████ ██████████ had a head scan. However when the referral was initially received those results had not yet been received. ██████████ Hospital had not done any other tests or scans and did not know what had happened to ██████████. When scan results were returned they showed ██████████ had multiple head bleeds. Initially it was unknown if ██████████ would become responsive and stable enough to be transferred to ██████████ or if he would pass away. ██████████ did become stabilized and was transported to ██████████ Hospital at 5:57 PM on 9/22/14.

Child Protective Service Investigator (CPSI) ██████████ was notified of the referral the evening of 09/22/2014. Telephone contact was made with Lead Investigator (LI), ██████████ who notified Investigative Coordinator (IC) ██████████. CPSI ██████████ was notified that the child was taken by helicopter to ██████████ Hospital. CPSI ██████████ was notified by LI ██████████ that ██████████ Law Enforcement was the agency involved. CPSI ██████████ and LI ██████████ responded to ██████████ Hospital where they met Detective ██████████ and Detective ██████████.

CPSI ██████████ and LI ██████████ arrived at the ██████████ Hospital at 8:00pm on 09/22/2014, where they made contact with Detective ██████████ and Detective ██████████ from ██████████ Police Department.

The father of ██████████ was interviewed by Det. ██████████ and Det. ██████████ in the security office at ██████████ Hospital. Mr. ██████████ was asked when the last time he had seen his son, ██████████. Mr. ██████████ advised it was approximately the last week of August. Mother, ██████████, had taken out an order of protection against Mr. ██████████ on July 11, 2014. He advised he has a current case against him of physical abuse regarding 4 yr old ██████████ who is an older child of ██████████ mother. He reported that it has been several weeks since he has seen ██████████. When asked how he found out about ██████████, Mr. ██████████ said ██████████ had called him when he was on his way to work at approximately 4:45pm and said there was something wrong with ██████████ and that ██████████ was being transported to ██████████ ER. At 4:47 PM she called again and said he won't wake up and he is not breathing on his own. He stated at 6:10 he sent Ms. ██████████ a text inquiring about ██████████ situation and was told the child was being

taken to [redacted] because of a brain injury. When asked who [redacted] stays with, Mr. [redacted] stated he stays with his mom or with [redacted]. Mr. [redacted] is the mother's paramour.

Mother, [redacted] was interviewed on the [redacted] floor of [redacted] by Det. [redacted] and Det. [redacted]. Ms. [redacted] said [redacted] has been sick for about 3 weeks. She reported he had been vomiting. On 9/3/2014, [redacted] had been taken to the [redacted] ER. Xrays were completed and [redacted] was given an IV. According to Ms. [redacted] there was nothing found wrong during that hospital visit. She went on to report that the last couple of days [redacted] had been sleeping a lot. They didn't know what was wrong, they said "we don't know what to tell you. The last couple of days he has been sleeping a lot. When asked about the specific events of 9/22/14, Ms. [redacted] stated that she had left for work at approximately 5:30 AM that morning and [redacted] was sleeping when she left. [redacted] and her older daughter were left with her paramour, [redacted]. She said Mr. [redacted] has been babysitting the children during the day since 9/8/14 when she began a new job. She reported getting the call from Mr. [redacted] that afternoon and telling him to call 911 when he reported the child to be "limp" and unresponsive.

The mother's paramour, [redacted], was interviewed. He advised that he and [redacted] were dating and had a good relationship. When asked what happened he replied he got [redacted] up at 9 or 10 and gave him cereal. He said [redacted] was acting tired so he put him down for a nap and took the 4 yr old, [redacted] out to play in the yard. He said when he came back in to check on [redacted] that [redacted] was moody, and he was moody and wanted to go back to sleep. He reported that he tried to wake him up but that the child was lethargic. He reported spraying water on his feet. He further reported carrying him around and then that the child went "limp". He said [redacted] took a deep breath and then stopped breathing. Mr. [redacted] reported at that point he called Ms. [redacted] who told him to call 911. Mr. [redacted] was asked if he disciplines [redacted] and Mr. [redacted] stated that he did not. Mr. [redacted] was also asked where the child sleeps and he reported that the child sleeps in his crib wrapped like a "burrito". Mr. [redacted] was asked if he could pass a drug screen. Mr. [redacted] stated he takes a lot of heart medications. He advised he would not test positive for marijuana if given a drug screen.

The referent states that the EMT was called today, 9-22-14, because [REDACTED] was unresponsive. It is unknown exactly when the call was made or who made the call. [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] ER about 45 minutes ago around 4:50pm. [REDACTED] parents are in the waiting room, but the referent has not spoken to the parents yet and their names are unknown.

The referent does not have any information on what happened to [REDACTED] that could have caused him to become unresponsive. The doctor who is working on [REDACTED] stated that it is likely due to abuse or neglect. [REDACTED] will be transported to [REDACTED] as soon as he is physically stable.

[REDACTED] had a head scan at the [REDACTED] ER, but the results are not back yet. They have not done any other tests or scans yet and they do not know what is wrong with [REDACTED]. CPSI observed at hospital on 9/24/15. was in his bed, unable to move his head because it has been bandaged. CPSI observed as unable to move his eyes to follow objects around. He did look peaceful and not showing any signs of discomfort.

Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

Detective interviewed Dr. at hospital. Dr. advised that has been the victim of abuse on at least two incidents. The most recent incident was on Monday and he will have brain damage and will not be able to feed himself. He has Abusive Head Trauma which is usually caused by violent shaking or slamming. According to Ms. descriptions, has been showing symptoms for 3 weeks. When asked if could have been injured on Sunday, she said that he would not eat if he had

Detective [REDACTED] Police department interviewed Mr. [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] said that he woke up between 09:00 and 10:00 hours. [REDACTED] was up watching TV when he went into the living room. He made some rice cereal mixed with pear juice for [REDACTED] to eat and [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] cereal from [REDACTED] After feeding [REDACTED] he put [REDACTED] down on the floor to watch TV with [REDACTED] He then went to the kitchen to clean up and take his medications. [REDACTED] then started getting fussy so he put [REDACTED] in a bouncy seat but when that didn't pacify him [REDACTED] was put back to bed at approximately 11:00. That is when he and [REDACTED] got dressed and went outside. He cut the front lawn and trimmed a tree in the front yard. At about 12:30, he went inside to check on [REDACTED] He took the covers off of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] started whining so [REDACTED] was allowed to go back to sleep. Mr. [REDACTED] went back outside to finish up the yard work. At around 13:00, he went back inside to wake [REDACTED] but he still will not get up. [REDACTED] was set on the floor with [REDACTED] in order to get him to wake up. [REDACTED] put pillows around him so that he would not fall and they sat watching TV. He then made [REDACTED] a corndog for lunch. [REDACTED] is still fussing and trying to sleep so he tells [REDACTED] to play with him to get him to wake up. [REDACTED] was still fussy so he picks him up and carries him around while doing house work to get him up. Mr. [REDACTED] then sprays his feet off with cold water in order to wake him up but that doesn't work either. While holding him, [REDACTED] went limp. He sprayed [REDACTED] feet again with cold water but that didn't do anything. He then called [REDACTED] and tells her what's going on and she tells him to call 911. 911 was then called.

CPSI [REDACTED] received this case on 9/22/14 as a P1 with the allegation of physical abuse, severe. The victim was listed as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] alleged perpetrators were listed as unknown birth parents, later established as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Report states that [REDACTED] (8 months old) lives with his parents, Unknown. It is unknown whether there are any other children in the home.

[REDACTED] is not in state's custody.

The referent states that the EMT was called today, 9-22-14, because [REDACTED] was unresponsive. It is unknown exactly when the call was made or who made the call. [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] ER about 45 minutes ago around 4:50pm. [REDACTED] parents are in the waiting room, but the referent has not spoken to the parents yet and their names are unknown.

The referent does not have any information on what happened to [REDACTED] that could have caused him to become unresponsive. The doctor who is working on [REDACTED] stated that it is likely due to abuse or neglect. [REDACTED] will be transported to [REDACTED] as soon as he is physically stable.

[REDACTED] had a head scan at the [REDACTED] ER, but the results are not back yet. They have not done any other tests or scans yet and they do not know what is wrong with [REDACTED]. The referent states that it is unknown whether [REDACTED] will become responsive and stable enough to be transferred to [REDACTED] or if he will pass away. The RN stated that it is a near-death. The medical staff will call back when [REDACTED] is being transferred to [REDACTED].

**Referent called back at 5:53pm and stated that the results from the head scan came back and [REDACTED] has multiple head bleeds. [REDACTED] is being transported to [REDACTED] Hospital now, 5:57pm on 9-22-14.

The child has no special needs or disabilities that the referent is aware of.

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

LI [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED] conferenced regarding the [REDACTED] case. Initially the Priority 1 case was received with allegations of physical abuse. Response was made to [REDACTED] Hospital by LI [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED]. Initial face to face was made with [REDACTED] and law enforcement assisted with interviews on both Mr. [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] mother. A Care Team consult was completed that should a chronic (old, around 3-4 wks prior) brain bleed and an acute (from the same day of the referral) brain bleed. [REDACTED] was said to sustain retinal hemorrhaging as well and the Care Team diagnosed the incidents as ABUSE. It was determined that Ms. [REDACTED] was not in the home and present during the incident as she was at work and Mr. [REDACTED] was home watching the two children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] ate breakfast and due to this the doctors stated in his condition he would not have eaten at all and therefore it was determined that Mr. [REDACTED] was the aggressor/perpetrator. Mr. [REDACTED] was arrested and charged with Child Abuse.

On 1/16/2015 an email was received stating that [REDACTED] (Mr. [REDACTED] 9 year old son) was interviewed and that he stated that Mr. [REDACTED] plays the "airplane game" with [REDACTED]. This was described as when Mr. [REDACTED] lifts [REDACTED] up and flies him until Mr. [REDACTED] drops [REDACTED] onto the couch. [REDACTED] reported that on at least one incident [REDACTED] fell off of the couch onto the floor and that Ms. [REDACTED] was present at this time. [REDACTED] also stated that on one occasion he placed [REDACTED] in the highchair and [REDACTED] fell out of the highchair so he picked him up and took him outside to Mr. [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] and told them.

***NOTE: Ms. [REDACTED] did not disclose either of these incidents when being questioned regarding the alleged physical abuse to her son.

LI [REDACTED] passed this information on to Det. [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] Police Department whom stated this was also told to him during an interview with [REDACTED]. The only difference was that Det. [REDACTED] did not ask [REDACTED] if Ms. [REDACTED] was present when [REDACTED] fell off the couch during the "airplane game". Det. [REDACTED] agreed that if nothing else comes in that he will go tonight to further question Ms. [REDACTED] with CPSI [REDACTED] as to why these incidents were not mentioned during initially questioning.

DCS legal is up to speed and will be consulted again following the interview with Ms. [REDACTED] on 1/16/2015.
