This Child is Not in Custody.

[REDACTED] (1 month) was in the custody of his mother, [REDACTED]. The father of [REDACTED] is unknown. [REDACTED] has two other children in her custody and their names are [REDACTED] (4) and [REDACTED] (3). The fathers of [REDACTED] are also unknown. None of the children had any special needs. It is unknown if the family has history with the Tennessee Department of Children's Services. The referent is unaware of any history of domestic violence out at the home. There are no known safety concerns for a case worker going out to the home. [REDACTED] is unemployed at this time. [REDACTED] does not appear to have any alcohol/drug issues or any mental health diagnosis.

On January 5, 2015 around 9:50 AM [REDACTED] Police officers were contacted to make response at [REDACTED] home in regards to an unresponsive 2 month old. Upon arrival at the scene it was discovered by officers that the child, [REDACTED] was still non-responsive. EMTs also made the scene and attempted to perform CPR on [REDACTED] but he could not be revived. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] by ambulance at which time CPR was continued, but with no success. Upon arrival at [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased.

[REDACTED] was interviewed by officers and stated that she and all her three children slept in the same bed. It was stated by [REDACTED] around 6 AM today she woke up and gave [REDACTED] a pacifier and then went back to sleep. At 6 AM [REDACTED] was responsive to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] claimed that around 9:40 AM she woke back up and noted that [REDACTED] had blood coming out of his nose. [REDACTED] hand was also cold to [REDACTED] touch. That is when [REDACTED] reported that she noticed that [REDACTED] was non-responsive and contacted 911.

[REDACTED] was reported to have been lying on a pillow on the bed to the right side of [REDACTED] and against a wall. The other two children were sleeping at the foot of the bed. Officers did note that there was a blood stain on the pillow in which [REDACTED] was sleeping as well as on [REDACTED] clothing. The blood on [REDACTED] clothing was near his chest area. [REDACTED] did not have any blood on her. [REDACTED] stated that the blood stain on the pillow and [REDACTED] clothing came from [REDACTED] nose.

Officer went through the home and noticed that there were some blood splatters in the bathroom. [REDACTED] was not asked about the blood splatters in the bathroom. The home is a one bathroom and one bedroom duplex. The home was reported to be unclean and had spoiled food in the kitchen on both the counters and on top of the refrigerator. There were no animals in the home. No exposed wiring was seen and no holes were in the wall. The home did not appear to be infested with bugs or rodents.

It did not appear that [REDACTED] had all the necessities to care for an infant or small child. [REDACTED] did have

formula and bottles, but there was not crib or other sleeping arrangement made for the child. There were no diapers or other items seen in the home.

Both of the other children were observed and none of the children had any visible marks or injuries. The only injury noted to [REDACTED] was that to his nose in was bleeding. [REDACTED] had no other signs of abuse or trauma.

A detective with the [REDACTED] Police Department has been contacted and is going to be making the scene. The detective assigned to the case is unknown. [REDACTED] body is still at [REDACTED], but will be transported to the [REDACTED] Coroners' office. The memo number for the [REDACTED] Police Department is [REDACTED]. No arrest has been made, but the investigation will be sent to the homicide unit at this time.

It is noted that both [REDACTED] are currently staying with their uncle, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] resides in the duplex next door to the family. It is unknown if [REDACTED] has history with the Tennessee Department of Children Services. [REDACTED] did not have any other children in his home and the home appeared to be clean and free of any safety concerns.

CASE SUMMARY:

The Department of Children's Services (DCS) Investigations Unit received a referral on January 5, 2015 with an allegation of Child Neglect Death regarding non-custodial child [REDACTED] and Environmental Neglect on [REDACTED] (victims). The alleged perpetrator listed is birth mother [REDACTED]. The case was assigned to Child Protective Services Investigator (CPSI) [REDACTED] on January 5, 2015.

CPSI conducted a TFACTS search on the family and found no prior Department of Children's Services (DCS) history. [REDACTED] was not in the department's custody at the time of death. This is a non-custodial case.

On January 5, 2015 a one month old child [REDACTED] was found unresponsive in his residence located at [REDACTED] at approximately 9:50 hours in the morning. Emergency Medical Technicians transported [REDACTED] to [REDACTED], where death was pronounced at 1046 hours by [REDACTED]. A scene investigation was conducted by [REDACTED] Police Department and the decedent's remains were transported to medical examiner's office for autopsy.

This case was not coordinated with [REDACTED] Police Department for additional investigation. The Child Protective Investigation Team (CPIT) was waiting on the autopsy to determine if law enforcement would conduct an investigation. CPSI [REDACTED] was the only investigator on this case.

The alleged perpetrator in this investigation was the birth mother [REDACTED].

CPSI [REDACTED] interviewed the mother [REDACTED] in her home at [REDACTED] to obtain a statement [REDACTED] took a deep breathe then told CPSI what occurred with [REDACTED] on January 5, 2015. [REDACTED] stated her and her three children [REDACTED] went to bed on January 4, 2015. [REDACTED] stated she woke up around 6:00 AM and feed [REDACTED] a bottle. [REDACTED] stated she and [REDACTED] went back to sleep. [REDACTED] stated when she woke up about 9:30 AM (sometime around that hour) and she noticed [REDACTED] was not awake. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did not appear to be sick and he had a normal day [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was his lil man. [REDACTED] stated on Monday January 5th he got up and caught the bus to a doctor's appointment. [REDACTED] stated everybody was in the house asleep when he left. [REDACTED] stated when he returned home couple hours late he noticed the police was at his house. [REDACTED] stated when he got to the house he saw the detectives looking around the home and that's when he was notified that [REDACTED] had passed. [REDACTED] stated he has never seen any abuse or neglect on any of the children. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] is a young mother but she loves her children to death and she provides great care for them. DCS policy Work Aid 1 (E) defines the following criteria for Child Neglect Death:

1. Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
2. Any child death caused by abuse resulting from direct action of the child's caretaker or the consequence of the child's caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of a child. Child deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.
3. Any child death that is the result of the caretaker's failure to meet childcare responsibilities. Neglect death is always treated as severe child abuse.

The case was presented to the [REDACTED] Child Protective Investigation Team on May 5, 2015. The team signed the Child Protective Investigation Team form as AUPU (allegation unsubstantiated/perpetrator unsubstantiated) for Neglect Death on [REDACTED]. The case was not coordinated with [REDACTED] Police Department for investigation by law enforcement. [REDACTED] received a copy of [REDACTED] autopsy from the [REDACTED] Medical Examiner.

The cause of death was "sudden unexplained infant death associated with co-sleeping and unsafe sleep conditions". The manner of death 'could not be determined'.

There is not a preponderance of evidence to substantiate the allegation of Child Neglect Death.

The case will be closed and classified as Allegation Unsubstantiated Perpetrator Unsubstantiated for the allegation of Child Neglect Death.

On 1/5/15 CPSI [REDACTED] received a referral from LI [REDACTED] for Neglect Death and Environmental Neglect on [REDACTED] (victims). The alleged perpetrator listed is birth mother [REDACTED]. Response due date is by 1/6/15 by 11:15 AM.

The reporter stated This Child is Not in Custody.

[REDACTED] (1 month) was in the custody of his mother [REDACTED]. The father of [REDACTED] is unknown. [REDACTED] has two other children in her custody and their names are [REDACTED] (4) and [REDACTED] (3). The fathers of [REDACTED] are also unknown. None of the children had any special needs. It is unknown if the family has history with the Tennessee Department of Children Services. The referent is unaware of any history of domestic violence out at the home. There are no known safety concerns for a case worker going out to the home. [REDACTED] is unemployed at this time. [REDACTED] does not appear to have any alcohol/drug issues or any mental health diagnosis.

On January 5, 2015 around 9:50 AM [REDACTED] Police officers were contacted to make response at [REDACTED] home in regards to an unresponsive 2 month old. Upon arrival at the scene it was discovered by officers that the child, [REDACTED] was still non-responsive. EMTs also made the scene and attempted to perform CPR on [REDACTED] but he could not be revived. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] by ambulance at which time CPR was continued, but with no success. Upon arrival at [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased.

[REDACTED] was interviewed by officers and stated that she and all her three children slept in the same bed. It was stated by [REDACTED] around 6 AM today she woke up and gave [REDACTED] a pacifier and then went back to sleep. At 6 AM [REDACTED] was responsive to [REDACTED] claimed that around 9:40 AM she woke back up and noted that [REDACTED] had blood coming out of his nose. [REDACTED] hand was also cold to [REDACTED] touch. That is when [REDACTED] reported that she noticed that [REDACTED] was non-responsive and contacted 911.

[REDACTED] was reported to have been lying on a pillow on the bed to the right side of [REDACTED] and against a wall. The other two children were sleeping at the foot of the bed. Officers did note that there was a blood stain on the pillow in which [REDACTED] was sleeping as well as on [REDACTED] clothing. The blood on [REDACTED] clothing was near his chest area. [REDACTED] did not have any blood on her. [REDACTED] stated that the blood stain on the pillow and [REDACTED] clothing came from [REDACTED] nose. Officer went through the home and noticed that there were some blood splatters in the bathroom. [REDACTED] was not asked about the blood splatters in the bathroom. The home is a one bathroom and one bedroom duplex. The home was reported to be unclean and had spoiled food in the kitchen on both the counters and on top of the refrigerator. There were no animals in the home. No exposed wiring was seen and no holes were in the wall. The home did not appear to be infested with bugs or rodents.

It did not appear that [REDACTED] had all the necessities to care for an infant or small child. [REDACTED] did have formula and bottles, but there was not crib or other sleeping arrangement made for the child. There were no diapers or other items seen in the home. Both of the other children were observed and none of the children had any visible marks or injuries. The only injury noted to [REDACTED] was that to his nose in was bleeding. [REDACTED] had no other signs of abuse or trauma.

It is noted that both [REDACTED] are currently staying with their uncle [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] resides in the duplex next door to the family. It is unknown if [REDACTED] has history with the Tennessee Department of Children Services. [REDACTED] did not have any other children in his home and the home appeared to be clean and free of any safety concerns.

CPSI conducted a TFACTS search on the family and found no prior DCS history.

The referent was not notified upon request. The Judge (Juvenile Court) and the District Attorney have been notified of the referral.
