The baby is not in state custody.

[REDACTED] (age 2 months) and his five siblings are the children of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The other children's names and ages are not known at this time. [REDACTED] does have a twin sibling.

On 4-1-2015 at 6:32 A.M. a patrol deputy responded to the home in reference to a baby not breathing. Upon arrival, Law Enforcement (LE) found [REDACTED] kneeling on the living room floor next to her baby, [REDACTED] who was lying on a green pillow. [REDACTED] was on the phone with 911 and was hysterical. The baby was warm and LE picked up the baby and began CPR. LE carried the baby to the curb as EMS arrived. EMS transported the baby to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] continued working on the baby but was unsuccessful in reviving the baby.

LE met with the family and got their statements. The baby and his twin were sleeping with the parents the night before. [REDACTED] stated that she breast fed around 6:00 A.M. and got up around 6:15 A.M. to get the school-aged children on the bus. She returned to the room where the baby was around 6:30 A.M. to find [REDACTED] unresponsive. Today the autopsy was attended by LE and there were no physical abnormalities found. The preliminary report suggests that the incident involved a "roll-over."

LE will get the rest of the children's names and get them to DCS. There were no other safety concerns seen by LE when they went to the home on the day of the incident. This is the first time that LE has had to respond to this home. This is all the information that the reporter has at this time. There are no additional details or concerns.

Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

On July 16, 2015 the Autopsy results were received and the A complete autopsy with ancillary studies reveals bilateral bronchiolitis related to rhinovirus related rhinovirus infection, which in itself is not sufficient to be the main cause of death; however, it could have contributed to the infant's great respiratory vulnerability if exposed to a challenge, including an environmental/positional challenge that ultimately led to asphyxia. Policy 14 states that the allegation of Neglect Death will be substantiated when there is "Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of the child. The CPIT team agreed to unsubstantiate the allegation of Abuse Death as [REDACTED] death does not fit the allegation. Allegations were unsubstantiated.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

The alleged perpetrator is unknown. Detective [REDACTED] interview the mother [REDACTED] and she reported the following "She had gotten up at approx. 0615 to get the 2 oldest boys ready for school and at 0625 she put them on the bus. At approx. 0630 she came back to the bedroom and found the boy not breathing. She then called 911 grabbed pillows from the bed and took them to the living room and laid it on the floor and began CPR. "

On April 1, 2015 I received a page from the 911 Center at 0651 to respond to [REDACTED] in reference to an unresponsive 2 month old baby. I responded at from my residence at 0705. I arrived on scene at [REDACTED]. Upon my arrival I first spoke with [REDACTED] as he was leaving. He informed me that the mother had stated she had fed both babies at 0600 and at 0616 she got up to get the other kids on the bus. She had fed them in her bedroom. Once the baby was found unresponsive she took it to the living room and performed CPR. The baby was found at approx. 0630. He also advised that Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had also responded to the scene. CSI [REDACTED] also responded to the scene also.

Once I arrived at the house I then spoke with Dep. [REDACTED]. He informed me that Dep. [REDACTED] had transported the mom and the twin sister of the victim to [REDACTED]. I was then advised what had happened and that the mother and 6 children were present. This family consisted of 8 subjects (mom and dad, an 8 yr old, a 6 yr old, a 4 yr old, a 1 yr old and the set of twins). We then entered the home at 0734. Deputy [REDACTED] continued to tell me that the mother [REDACTED] had breast fed both of babies at approx. 0600 in the bedroom. She had gotten up at approx 0615 to get the 2 oldest boys ready for school and at 0625 she put them on the bus. At approx. 0630 she came back to the bedroom and found the boy not breathing. She then called 911 grabbed pillows from the bed and took them to the living room and laid it on the floor and began CPR. Upon Deputy [REDACTED] arriving on scene he took the child and continued CPR until [REDACTED] arrived on scene and took the child. Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived on scene while [REDACTED] was performing CPR. [REDACTED] then transported the child to [REDACTED]. While I was at the scene a friend from across the street had came over to assist with watching the 2 other children. I was also informed that the father was currently in [REDACTED] working. The baby is not in state custody.

[REDACTED] (age 2 months) and his five siblings are the children of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The other children's names and ages are not known at this time. [REDACTED] does have a twin sibling.

On 4-1-2015 at 6:32 A.M. a patrol deputy responded to the home in reference to a baby not breathing. Upon arrival, Law Enforcement (LE) found [REDACTED] kneeling on the living room floor next to her baby, [REDACTED] who was lying on a green pillow. [REDACTED] was on the phone with 911 and was hysterical. The baby was warm and LE picked up the baby and began CPR. LE carried the baby to the curb as EMS arrived. EMS transported the baby to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] continued working on the baby but was unsuccessful in reviving the baby.

LE met with the family and got their statements. The baby and his twin were sleeping with the parents the night before. [REDACTED] stated that she breast fed around 6:00 A.M. and got up around 6:15 A.M. to get the school-aged children on the bus. She returned to the room where the baby was around 6:30 A.M. to find [REDACTED] unresponsive. Today the autopsy was attended by LE and there were no physical abnormalities found. The preliminary report suggests that the incident involved a "roll-over."

LE will get the rest of the children's names and get them to DCS. There were no other safety concerns seen by LE when they went to the home on the day of the incident. This is the first time that LE has had to respond to this home. This is all the information that the reporter has at this time. There are no additional details or concerns.
