The referent stated that they are leaning towards the child not surviving due to the complications [REDACTED] had during her pregnancy; it is unknown what type of complication they were.

[REDACTED] tested positive for THC on January 26th. It is unknown if she was drug tested today. [REDACTED] stated that she would test positive for Subutex but it is not prescribed to her. It is unknown if the baby has been screened for drugs. The baby does have a heart beat but hospital staff are worried about her lung functioning. It is unknown if [REDACTED] drug abuse is the cause of the baby being born early. It is unknown if the baby is withdrawing at this time. [REDACTED] did receive prenatal care through Dr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is at the hospital with [REDACTED]. He is aware of her drug abuse. It is unknown when [REDACTED] will be discharged. Recon requested by [REDACTED] on 04/08/15 @ 10:17 PM. CM [REDACTED] responded to the hospital. While at the hospital the child passed away at 8 pm. At this time an autopsy is going to be performed. At this time the doctor is not able to say what was cause of death or if it could have been prevented. Mom has had complications with pregnancy. She was at the hospital on 4-6 due to bleeding and water breaking. She was negative on her drug screen but today reported she would be positive for subutex - she has no prescription - her husband does. There are 5 other children but they are in DCS custody for drug use and domestic violence. At this time the mother and father are at the hospital. Doctor can't say at this time if it was drug use but did say maybe if mom came in earlier when her water broke it could have been prevented. Mom reports she did go see her doctor when water broke. Medical examiner called to pickup the baby for autopsy to be performed. Baby's blood cord is being tested for drugs.

Recon request granted by [REDACTED], TL on 04/08/15 @ 11:00 PM. Changed allegation from DEI to NGD. CM responded to the hospital previously tonight and met response time around 6 PM. Child passed away at 8 PM while CM was still at hospital with family. Unable to determine if cause of death is due to being premature/not fully developed or the mother's drug usage. An autopsy will be performed on the child to determine cause of death. This is mother's 3rd pregnancy in 12 months, her water broke one week ago. Mother reports going to the doctor on 03/31 but hospital does not have a record of this, however she did present to the hospital on 04/06. Mother was drug screened on 04/06 but was not tested for subutex, however, she admitted to usage on admittance today even though it is not prescribed.

-Woke up on 04/06 with mild contractions. Went to bathroom and found lots of blood. Went to Dr. at 5:15 A.M., contractions picked up. Doctors were able to stop contractions.

-04/07. No contractions, "it just started". Gave birth 04/08 at 6:05 A.M.

-Five other children are in Foster care. Was scheduled for alcohol/drug counseling in Feb. but snow hit. More snow every day it was rescheduled- Then pregnancy complications started.

The Department received a referral on 4/08/2015 due to allegations of Drug Exposed Infant but was later changed to Neglect Death due to the alleged child victim, [REDACTED] passing away. [REDACTED], 13-hours old, is listed as the alleged child victim. Birth Mother, [REDACTED] is listed as the alleged perpetrator.

[REDACTED] Alleged Perpetrator, gave birth to [REDACTED] at 23 weeks and 1 day gestational. CPSI responded to the referral at [REDACTED] at approx. 8:00pm [REDACTED] time. CPSI was informed that the child was transferred to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital. CPSI arrived at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital at approx. 8:20pm eastern time. CPSI was informed that the child had passed away at approximately 8:00pm [REDACTED] time.

The investigation into this incident was conducted by the [REDACTED] Police Department Special Crimes Unit, Investigator [REDACTED], and Office of Child Safety Investigator, [REDACTED]. As part of the investigation, [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED] was interviewed. The father [REDACTED] at first agreed to speak to CPSI, but then declined. Records were requested from medical staff as well.

It should also be noted that there were two prior investigations in January 2015 (one in [REDACTED] and one in [REDACTED] in which mother was indicated for DEC on both cases. During the [REDACTED] County Investigation the mother admitted to using suboxone not prescribed. During the [REDACTED] County investigation Ms. [REDACTED] paramour [REDACTED] admitted that he and [REDACTED] use illegal drugs and reports last use was in January 2015.

According to medical records provided to CPSI [REDACTED] is Ms. [REDACTED] third pregnancy in the past 12 months. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that her water broke a week prior to her arriving at [REDACTED] on 04/06/2015. Ms. [REDACTED] reports going to the doctor on 3/31 for bleeding. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that an ultrasound was conducted where ruptured membranes were observed. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that her doctor instructed Ms. [REDACTED] to return in one week. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that she did return to the hospital on 4/6/2015 where she was admitted for delivery. According to medical records Ms. [REDACTED] was drug screened on 4/6/2015 with negative results; however Ms. [REDACTED] was not tested for Subutex. Ms. [REDACTED] had one false positive drug screen for Methamphetamine during her pregnancy.

Ms. [REDACTED] has five other children who were removed from the mother in January, 2015. All five children are in foster care; however they recently began a trail home placement with a family member. CPSI spoke to Family Services Worker [REDACTED] who reported that the mother submitted to a urine drug screen on 1/26/15 and was positive for THC. [REDACTED] Birth mother and alleged perpetrator, gave birth to [REDACTED] at 23 weeks and 1 day gestational. CPSI (Child Protective Services Investigator) responded to the referral at [REDACTED] at approximately 8:00pm [REDACTED] time. CPSI was informed that the child was transferred to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital. CPSI arrived at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital at approximately 8:20pm [REDACTED] time. CPSI was informed that the child had passed away at approximately 8:00pm [REDACTED] time.

The investigation into this incident was conducted by the [REDACTED] Police Department Special Crimes Unit, Detective [REDACTED] and Office of Child Safety Investigator, [REDACTED]. As part of the investigation, [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED], was interviewed. The father, [REDACTED], at first agreed to speak to CPSI, but then declined. Records were requested from medical staff at this time.

The Department received a referral on 4/08/2015 due to allegations of Drug Exposed Infant but was later changed to Neglect Death due to the alleged child victim, [REDACTED] passing away. [REDACTED], Alleged Perpetrator, gave birth to [REDACTED] at 23 weeks and 1 day gestational. CPSI responded to the referral at [REDACTED] at approx. 8:00pm [REDACTED] CPSI was informed that the child was transferred to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital. CPSI arrived at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital at approx. 8:20pm [REDACTED] CPSI was informed that the child has passed away at approx. 8:00pm [REDACTED] death is currently undetermined. It is unknown if the cause of death is due to premature birth (lack of development) or Ms. [REDACTED] admitted suboxone use during pregnancy.

It should also be noted that there were two prior investigations in January (one in [REDACTED] and one in [REDACTED] in which mother was indicated for DEC on both cases. This case was assigned to CPSI [REDACTED] on 4/08/2015. The District Attorney's office is notified of all severe abuse cases per local protocol. Upon classification the District Attorney is notified at the Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT) monthly meeting. Juvenile Court judges are notified of all referrals per local protocol. Notice of classification is submitted to the Juvenile Court Judge per local protocol via the 740. The allegations reported are: Neglect Death. The referral states the following: Reporter states:

THIS CHILD IS NOT IN DCS CUSTODY

Unknown 1 day old female lives with her mother, [REDACTED] and father, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County.

[REDACTED] gave birth to a baby girl today at [REDACTED] Hospital in [REDACTED] County. The baby was born at 23 weeks. There is a 50/50 chance of the child's survival due to not being fully developed. They are currently running test to determine the status of the child. The referent stated that they are leaning towards the child not surviving due to the complications [REDACTED] had during her pregnancy; it is unknown what type of complication they were.

[REDACTED] tested positive for THC on January 26th. It is unknown if she was drug tested today. [REDACTED] stated that she would test positive for Subutex but it is not prescribed to her. It is unknown if the baby has been screened for drugs. The baby does have a heart beat but hospital staff are worried about her lung functioning. It is unknown if [REDACTED] drug abuse is the cause of the baby being born early. It is unknown if the baby is withdrawing at this time. [REDACTED] did receive prenatal care through Dr. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is at the hospital with [REDACTED]. He is aware of her drug abuse. It is unknown when [REDACTED] will be discharged. [REDACTED] mother is at the hospital with her.

[REDACTED] currently has 5 children in custody. [REDACTED] was pulled over by law enforcement in January 2015 and she had a crack pipe beside the baby in the car seat. The children were brought into custody in January because of drugs and domestic violence. Children have previously been in custody due to one of the children being pushed out of the window by [REDACTED]. It is unknown when this occurred but it was reported to DCS.
