[REDACTED] was not able to be interviewed. At the beginning of the case he was on life support but was later disconnected from the life support. He died on 04/20/2015.

The final autopsy determined that [REDACTED] died from blunt head trauma and the manner of death was undetermined. [REDACTED] brain was swollen and bleeding. He had prominent, bi-lateral retinal hemorrhage.

Mr. [REDACTED] has a history of domestic violence and stalking. He and other witnesses admitted he was the only caregiver for the infant when the injuries occurred. Medical staff reported the injuries did not match the explanation of what happened. The case was presented to CPIT and the team agreed to substantiate.

This referral was received by [REDACTED] County Department of Children's Services (DCS) on 04/17/2015 at 10:41 AM [REDACTED] for a Lack of Supervision allegation. The alleged child victim (ACV) was [REDACTED]. At 5:48 PM [REDACTED] an extended referral was received and an allegation of Physical Abuse was added and the case was listed as Preliminary Near Death. On 04/20/2015 at 10:28 PM [REDACTED] the infant was pronounced dead. The Department was notified and allegation of Abuse Death was added. The ACV was not in DCS custody at the time of death.

The 5 month old, [REDACTED] was being cared for by the mother's ([REDACTED]) paramour, [REDACTED] at the time of the incident. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was propped up on the couch with blankets while he left the room to get something to eat and drink. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he heard a loud thud and a scream and when he came back into the room he found [REDACTED] in the floor and when he picked him up he was limp and unresponsive. Mr. [REDACTED] put the child in his vehicle and drove him to the emergency room instead of calling 911 for EMS.

When [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Hospital ER he was unresponsive. EMS Director, [REDACTED] administered CPR to the child and intubated him. Director [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] did not have any visible marks or injuries to his body. Director [REDACTED] noted the injury did not appear to be consistent with the story that was provided by Mr. [REDACTED] was then transported to the [REDACTED] Hospital and admitted to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) and was diagnosed with a severe brain injury. [REDACTED] was without oxygen for a significant amount of time resulting in anoxic brain injury. On the morning of 04/20/2015 [REDACTED] had an Electroencephalogram (EEG) that showed no brain activity. A second EEG was done later the same day and [REDACTED] was pronounced dead at 10:28 PM.

The investigation into this incident was led by Tennessee Bureau of Investigation Special Agent [REDACTED] County Sheriff's Department Detective [REDACTED] and Chief Detective [REDACTED] assisted in the investigation. Also investigating was Child Protective Services Lead Investigator (CPSLI) [REDACTED] and Child Protective Services Investigator (CPSI) [REDACTED]. In June 2015 the case was transferred to CPSI [REDACTED]. The Medical Examiners (ME) were Dr. [REDACTED] and Dr. [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] was listed as the perpetrator for both the physical abuse and abuse death allegation. The mother, Ms. [REDACTED] was listed as the perpetrator for Lack of Supervision. Mr. [REDACTED] was caring for [REDACTED] at the time of his injury. Both adults were interviewed as part of this investigation.

Ms. [REDACTED] was interviewed and stated she had a court hearing to attend on the morning of 04/17/2015. At

approximately 8:00 AM Ms. [REDACTED] met Mr. [REDACTED] and gave him [REDACTED] to care for while she was in court. She reported that when she left [REDACTED] he appeared to be fine and was acting normal. Ms. [REDACTED] went to the [REDACTED] County Justice Center for court. The Judge did not take the bench until 10:30 AM. At some point a female officer came into the courtroom and called her name. The officer told her there had been an accident and she needed to get to the hospital. Ms. [REDACTED] called Mr. [REDACTED] on her way there but could not understand him because he was crying. She also contacted her mother and told her to meet her at the hospital. When she arrived she learned that there was a serious injury and the infant was going to be transferred. She reported that Mr. [REDACTED] told her he was sorry.

Mr. [REDACTED] was interviewed by TBI Agent [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] admitted he was caring for [REDACTED] when his injury happened. He reported that [REDACTED] had been fussy the day before and through the night. He described [REDACTED] as screaming and crying throughout the morning. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had fallen off the couch. He heard a thump and a scream so he ran in the room and saw [REDACTED] lying face down on the floor. Mr. [REDACTED] said he shook [REDACTED] 5-6 times and he took a gasp of air. He denied ever shaking [REDACTED] prior to the incident. Mr. [REDACTED] said he loved [REDACTED] the same as he loved his own 19 month old daughter. During the interview Mr. [REDACTED] did report he was arrested for domestic violence in the past but the case was dismissed. He was also charged with stalking. He denied both offenses. Medical staff did not find the injuries to [REDACTED] to be consistent with him falling off the couch.

DCS policy Work Aid 1 (E) defines the following criteria for Abuse Death: a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect. b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report. c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse. 2. A near death, per Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 37-5-107(c)(4) is defined as a serious or critical medical condition resulting from abuse, neglect or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the child subsequent to the abuse or neglect.

NOTE: When an initial referral or a referral on an open case contains information that suggests the child is in a serious or critical medical condition as a result of the allegation(s) or has been determined to meet the criteria for an allegation of near death as defined above, the Child Abuse Hotline will select Preliminary Near Death (PND) Indicator in TFACTS on the participants tab on a new intake or the investigative persons tab on an active case. The information does not have to come from a physician.

NOTE: Preliminary near deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.

This case was presented to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team on 12/10/2015. Team members were in agreement to substantiate for Physical Abuse and Child Abuse Death.

There is a preponderance of evidence to substantiate the allegation.

The case will be closed and classified as Allegation Substantiated/ Perpetrator Substantiated for the allegations of Physical Abuse and Child Abuse Death.

The injuries to the child are not consistent with the story that was provided by the mother's paramour ([REDACTED]) to medical personnel. According to medical reports, the injuries were confirmed to be from non-accidental trauma. The child was in the care of both the mother and her paramour just prior to the injuries occurring. Because both the mother and her paramour had access to the child, both of them were asked to take a polygraph. The mother took, and passed, a polygraph exam, however, her paramour would not agree to take a polygraph. It is believed that at the time the injuries occurred, that the paramour was the sole caretaker of the child and that he was the perpetrator of the non-accidental blunt force trauma to the child, which ultimately resulted in the death of the child. The allegations of lack of supervision against the mother are unsubstantiated. The allegations of both physical abuse and abuse death against the paramour, [REDACTED], are classified as allegation substantiated and perpetrator substantiated.

The alleged perpetrators are listed as [REDACTED] (birth mother) and [REDACTED] (mother's boyfriend). The child victims is [REDACTED] (age 5 months, now deceased). The referral stated that the child had fallen off the couch and was taken to [REDACTED] Health. The child has a brain injury that is suspected to be a result of physical abuse. The mother was not present when the child was injured. [REDACTED] was caring for the child when the incident occurred.

Investigator follow-up: The child's autopsy was completed on 04/23/15. Preliminary information reported is that it lists retinal hemorrhages and brain injury. This case was staffed on this date between Investigator [REDACTED], Lead Investigator [REDACTED], and Regional Investigations Director [REDACTED]. A referral was received this past Friday 04/17/15 stating the child (age 5 months) had fallen off the couch and had suffered an injury. It was discovered that the child had a traumatic head injury; the baby had to be intubated and there were periods where the baby was not breathing. TBI has also been notified and they are also working the case at the request of the District Attorney's office. Inv. [REDACTED] spoke with medical staff at [REDACTED] Hospital in [REDACTED] and it was reported the child had a slim chance of recovery and that his injuries were not consistent with a fall. Investigations Coordinator [REDACTED] was notified of the situation as well on 04/17/15.

Birth mother reported she had left the baby with her boyfriend and the baby was fine the last time she saw him. The boyfriend's parents had also seen the baby before his fall and reported the baby was fine when they saw him. Birth mother left to go to court and approximately an hour later, a call was made to 911 by the boyfriend to report the baby was not breathing. The boyfriend did not wait for an ambulance; he drove the baby to the hospital himself. His statement was that he put the baby on the couch and he went to the kitchen to get something to drink and he heard the baby scream and when he came back into the room, he saw the baby had fallen off the couch. The boyfriend did sign a written statement. There were no other witnesses at that point.

Medical staff was interviewed again and it was reported the baby had no visible injury and the incident could not have happened the way the boyfriend described. It was discovered the baby had two bruises near his armpit area and photos were taken of those marks. Medical staff are reporting the baby was without oxygen for a significant amount of time--longer than it would have taken the boyfriend to drive the baby to the hospital. The baby went into cardiac arrest over the weekend. It was reported that an EEG was completed on the baby and he had no brain activity on Monday 04/20/15. He was declared brain dead last night 04/20/15.

An IPA was created on Sunday with the birth mother stating the boyfriend would have no contact with the child; however, the child died so there is no petition to file. TBI is heavily involved with the case and may be charging the boyfriend with the baby's death. Once the baby's organs are harvested, an autopsy will be completed.

This man also has a long history of domestic violence. The mother of the 19-month-old did contact Inv. [REDACTED] to provide her with additional information pertaining to the birth father's violent history; she reported she has suffered broken bones from him in the past. The mother of that child stated the birth father has had a lot of access to the 19-month-old child and that child has returned home with bruises. Another referral will be made concerning the 19-month-old child in order for the Department to work with that child's family as well to ensure that child is safe. Once that referral is made and the case is assigned, the case will be staffed with DCS attorney [REDACTED].

The birth mother of the deceased child plans to file for an order of protection against the boyfriend once she leaves the hospital.

Inv. [REDACTED] will make a referral concerning the 19-month-old child of the alleged perpetrator. She will also continue to obtain all medical records and police records/photos and will scan all documents into TFACTS and will continue to enter all interviews/contacts into TFACTS as well.
