[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were sleeping on a mattress in the living room of the apartment several hours ago. One of the other residents in the home left the home to walk their dog, then returned home. As they returned to the home [REDACTED] ran out of the home screaming [REDACTED] was not breathing.

Police were contacted by one of the residents. Police arrived to the home on 6-14-15 at 2:02am to find [REDACTED] to be cold to the touch and have rigor in both arms and legs. EMS and the fire department arrived to the home and EMS transported [REDACTED] to the [REDACTED] Hospital by 2:10am.

Once at the hospital Dr. [REDACTED] examined [REDACTED] and declared [REDACTED] to be deceased at roughly 2:11am. Police spoke with [REDACTED]. She reported that she went to sleep with [REDACTED] but woke up when she heard the resident walking around. She checked on [REDACTED] and found him not breathing.

[REDACTED] does not have any other children. It is unknown if [REDACTED] has a history of child abuse or neglect. It is unknown if [REDACTED] has a criminal history of assault, abuse or violent acts. [REDACTED] is observed to be upset and crying, refusing to let go of [REDACTED]. It is unknown if [REDACTED] had any medical or physical



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complications. There were no weapons, aggressive animals nor environmental risk factors observed inside of the apartment where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] resided.

The autopsy of [REDACTED] was received on 11/18/2015. Per the autopsy, "Autopsy examination revealed a well-nourished, well-developed black baby boy. No acute trauma was identified. The lungs showed florid petechiae and moderate pulmonary edema. No petechiae were seen on the thymus or heart. The heart did show an anomalous take-off of a small right coronary ostia. No abnormalities in the heart muscle were identified. Numerous cultures are either negative or show a postmortem contaminant. Toxicology is negative and vitreous electrolytes are within expected postmortem ranges. Histology reveals no infections. They confirm pulmonary edema. After a complete autopsy with laboratory evaluation and review of scene history and photos, no specific

cause of death was identified, although an asphyxial death cannot be ruled out. In my opinion, therefore, the cause of death is sudden unexplained infant death. Ms. ██████ reported that for the past week she was staying at her friend ██████ apartment. She stated that on Saturday 6/13/15, she and ██████ woke up at 8AM. She reported that they watched television and stayed home the entire day. She reported that ██████ was fine and was not sick recently. Ms. ██████ reported that she fed ██████ twice and they went to sleep at 5PM. She reported that she woke up at 10PM to feed ██████. Ms. ██████ stated that she covered ██████ and put a pacifier in his mouth. She reported that ██████ mouth moved. Ms. ██████ reported that she realized something was wrong at 1AM when Ms. ██████ woke her up. Ms. ██████ stated that when Ms. ██████ came home, she realized that ██████ was not waking up. She stated that she tried to wake him by moving him but he did not move. She reported that ██████ body was cold and hard. She stated that she tried to get Ms. ██████ to do CPR but ██████ was already deceased and blood was coming out of his nose. Ms. ██████ reported that she and ██████ shared a bed. She reported that ██████ did not have a crib.

CPSI interviewed ██████, acquaintance of ██████. She stated that Ms. ██████ came to her home with an air mattress, car seat, some clothes, and baby food. She reported that Ms. ██████ and ██████ slept together on the mattress. She stated that on Tuesday, she had to stay up with the baby for 3 hours while he was crying because Ms. ██████ would not wake up. She reported that she asked Ms. ██████ if she was using drugs and she denied it. She reported that Ms. ██████ was up with ██████ when he was crying except for Tuesday. Ms. ██████ stated that she thought Ms. ██████ did take something because she was unable to get up. She reported that on Saturday, at 7:45PM she went to the ██████ and out with her friends. She stated that while she was out with her friends, she attempted to call Ms. ██████ 6 times but she did not answer. She stated that she called Ms. ██████ at 1:17AM and Ms. ██████ did not answer. She stated that she called again at 1:30AM. Ms. ██████ stated that she came back to her residence because she felt that something was not right. She stated that she went inside Ms. ██████ stated that everything was okay and that she was about to leave when her guy friend said that Ms. ██████ was yelling that the baby was not breathing. Ms. ██████ reported that she was a certified nurse and that she felt the baby and he was cold and hard. She stated that blood was running down his nose and that she knew he was already deceased so she gave the baby back to Ms. ██████ CPSI recommended grief counseling for Ms. ██████ who appeared to be upset about the death of ██████.

The case was presented to the ██████ County Child Protective Investigation Team on 12/03/2015. Team members were in agreement that there was not sufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation of Child Neglect Death.

The Department of Children's Services (DCS) Investigations Unit received a referral on 06/14/2015 with an allegation of Child Neglect Death regarding non-custodial child [REDACTED].

Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were residing at one of [REDACTED] friend's home with several other individuals. It was reported that she and [REDACTED] were sleeping on an air mattress. On 06/14/2015, [REDACTED], birth mother of [REDACTED], ran out of the family home and screamed that [REDACTED] was not breathing. Law enforcement from the [REDACTED] Police Department arrived at the residence at 2:02AM and observed that [REDACTED] was cold to the touch and had rigor in his arms and legs. [REDACTED] was transported to the [REDACTED] Hospital in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased at 2:10AM on 06/14/2015.

The initial investigation into this incident was conducted by The [REDACTED] Police Department Sergeant, [REDACTED], DCS Investigations Unit Lead Investigator [REDACTED] and Investigator [REDACTED]. During the course of this investigation, Child Protective Service Investigator (CPSI) [REDACTED] supervisor changed to DCS Investigations Unit Lead Investigator [REDACTED].

The report to DCS listed [REDACTED] mother [REDACTED] as the alleged perpetrator of Child Neglect Death. Numerous interviews were conducted of acquaintances, family, and law enforcement. Medical information was obtained.

As part of the investigation, [REDACTED] family was interviewed. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that for the past week she was staying at her friend [REDACTED] apartment. She stated that on Saturday 6/13/15, she and [REDACTED] woke up at 8AM. She reported that they watched television and stayed home the entire day. She reported that [REDACTED] was fine and was not sick recently. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that she fed [REDACTED] twice and they went to sleep at 5PM. CPSI [REDACTED] completed a home visit on this date with [REDACTED] Ms. [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] children. Prior to the home visit, CPSI went to [REDACTED] to ask for Mr. [REDACTED] contact information. CPSI knocked on the door but there was no response. CPSI left a card in the door. CPSI observed that there were no cars in the driveway. CPSI then went to [REDACTED]. When CPSI arrived, Ms. [REDACTED] came outside. CPSI explained that she was at the home to visit with [REDACTED] and to get Mr. [REDACTED] updated contact information. CPSI spoke to [REDACTED] reported that she was now attending [REDACTED] School and was in the 4th grade. She reported that she was doing well at her current residence. CPSI then spoke to Ms. [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that Mr. [REDACTED] new number was [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that a slumber party was going on inside her home and that her children were in the home with their friend. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that Ms. [REDACTED] had Mr. [REDACTED] new number. She stated that Ms. [REDACTED] called Mr. [REDACTED] 3 times since [REDACTED] started living with him. She stated that when Ms. [REDACTED] called, [REDACTED] stated that she did not want to talk to her. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that calls between [REDACTED] and her mother are supervised because [REDACTED] would act out after speaking to her and after the transition to Mr. [REDACTED] home. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that a few weeks ago, Ms. [REDACTED] called Mr. [REDACTED] for a visit, he said okay, but Ms. [REDACTED] did not follow up to schedule the visit. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that Mr. [REDACTED] was laid off from [REDACTED]. She reported that she worked. She reported that Mr. [REDACTED] had lived with his mother prior to living at the current address. Ms. [REDACTED] called Mr. [REDACTED] and CPSI spoke to him by phone. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he was unable to pay the contract bill for his old phone and now had a prepaid phone. He stated that Ms. [REDACTED] had his current number. He reported that Ms. [REDACTED] called twice. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that Ms. [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] a few weeks ago and [REDACTED] said that she did not want to talk and Ms. [REDACTED] said, "You don't want to talk to me" and then said bye and hung up. He reported that [REDACTED] told him that she did not want to live with her mother. CPSI explained to Mr. [REDACTED] that the case was being transferred to FSW [REDACTED] and that there was a CFTM earlier that week. CPSI informed Mr. [REDACTED] that he was to ensure that DCS had his current contact information. Mr. [REDACTED] asked about the visitation Ms. [REDACTED] was required to receive. CPSI explained that the current court order states to follow the order of the previous one which allots Ms. [REDACTED] 10 hours of visitation time.

CPSI went inside the family home. CPSI observed that the home was clean but the children's room were a bit disheveled. CPSI observed Ms. [REDACTED] children at the home and the girls' friend inside as well. In the girls' bedroom, there is a bunk bed. [REDACTED] sleeps on the top bunk. Ms. [REDACTED] two younger girls sleep on the bottom bunk. Ms. [REDACTED] son has his own room. Ms. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] share a room and have their baby in there. The baby has a crib. CFTM began with introductions and the purpose of the meeting. Mother participated via phone. Mr. [REDACTED] (GAL) participated via phone. Mr. [REDACTED] mother's attorney, and Mr. [REDACTED] attorney for Mr. [REDACTED] attended in person. The team was not able to call Mr. [REDACTED] in because DCS does not have a working number for him.

CPSI [REDACTED] reported the reason for involvement: CPSI [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] passed away in the care of his mother, Ms. [REDACTED]. A safety placement was then completed on [REDACTED] was originally placed with a family friend, Ms. [REDACTED]. However, starting October 2, 2015, [REDACTED] has been in the custody of Mr. [REDACTED] her father, due to the court giving him custody. Since that time, the autopsy results have returned for [REDACTED] and it reported SIDS was the cause of death. CPS requested a courtesy home visit for Mr. [REDACTED] home and there were no concerns reported. There is not a working phone number for Mr. [REDACTED] at this time. CPS had requested a courtesy home visit from [REDACTED] County DCS in November, but hasn't received a response. The last confirmed visit with CPS and Mr. [REDACTED] was 10/14/15. CPSI [REDACTED] will be conducting a home visit with Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] prior to the new FSS worker, [REDACTED], completing a home visit.

Team reviewed the plan and revised as needed. Mother is allowed to have supervised visits with [REDACTED]. Mother reports that she has difficulty getting visits in with [REDACTED] since she cannot reach Mr. [REDACTED] via phone. Mother expressed concern with not being able to reach Mr. [REDACTED]. Mother reports that she last saw [REDACTED] around late October. Team discussed this concern and FSS will continue to address this with father. Mother is to complete parenting classes and provide proof to DCS. She reports that she is completing the classes with a private company, but wasn't able to provide the contact information for the agency. Mother reports that she has completed 2 sessions thus far. Mother will provide DCS with the information for the agency where she is completing the parenting classes. Mother is to complete an alcohol and drug assessment. Mother reports that she completed an assessment at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at the end of October. DCS needs a copy of the assessment. Mother was unsure of the recommendations of the assessment, but reported that she is in therapy at [REDACTED]. CPS reported that mother had refused two drug screens in June 2015 at the start of the case. Mother tested in August at court (not a random drug screen) and was negative for all drugs. CPS has not called mother in for any other drug screens. Mother will need to comply with random drug screens and report to the DCS office within 3 hours of being called. Mother needs to obtain and maintain stable housing. Mother reports that she lives with her friend and has her own bedroom. Mother stated that [REDACTED] would have her own bedroom too. Mother reports that she is not on the lease of the apartment and she is trying to get a place of her own. Mother and [REDACTED] are to have grief counseling.
