The reporter states [REDACTED] (15) lives in the home with her younger female sibling (approx 14) whose name is unknown by the reporter, their birth mother [REDACTED] (approx 38), and [REDACTED] paramour, [REDACTED] (age unknown). The family lives at [REDACTED] County). The child was not in DCS custody.

On July 9, 2015, [REDACTED] reported to EMS personnel and medical staff at [REDACTED] Hospital that she found [REDACTED] unresponsive in a room at their home and was unable to wake her. She said she immediately called EMS who arrived at the home. EMS transported [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital via ambulance. At the time [REDACTED] spoke with EMS and [REDACTED] medical staff, and told them [REDACTED] had reportedly overdosed on some unknown medications that were in her home.

[REDACTED] was admitted to [REDACTED] and stayed throughout the weekend. On July 11, 2015 she had a brain hemorrhage that she was unable to recover from. Two (2) brain death exams were performed by medical staff at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was pronounced yesterday, July 12, 2015. The reporter states the brain hemorrhage was caused by the overdose. The reporter does not know the specific drug(s) [REDACTED] was positive for at the time of admission. The reporter does not know what other drugs [REDACTED] may have had access to in the home.

According to [REDACTED] sister a day prior to [REDACTED] overdose, [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] Benadryl along with three (3) shots of some type of alcohol to calm her down. [REDACTED] has a history of mental illness and has had a hard time coping with the mental illness. She has had two (2) prior suicide attempts and had recently been in in-patient treatment in [REDACTED] for a couple of weeks. She completed that treatment and was released near the end of June.

No autopsy has yet been completed and [REDACTED] body remains at [REDACTED] Hospital because her organs will be donated. The scheduled date for the autopsy is unknown by the reporter.

LE has not been contacted because initially [REDACTED] death was viewed as a typical suicide and the family was very appropriate; there were no initial concerns of any wrongdoing or suspicious activities. The reporter does not know if LE will be contacted by the hospital staff now that new information has become available regarding [REDACTED] actions towards [REDACTED] prior to her death.

According to the reporter, [REDACTED] acknowledged that she was aware that the actions allegedly taken by [REDACTED] were completely inappropriate in handling the situation. However, she states she has not had an opportunity to speak with [REDACTED] since the incident occurred, although he was at the hospital while [REDACTED] was being cared for. [REDACTED] stated to her knowledge, [REDACTED] has never done anything like this before and she was surprised to hear that he had done anything.

The reporter had no additional information to provide for the report.

On 07/13/2015 CPSI [REDACTED] did not interview/observe [REDACTED] as she was pronounced deceased at [REDACTED] Hospital before DCS investigation begun. According to DCS Work Aid 2 "It is not required for the DCS Case Manager to observe the deceased child".

On 07/14/2015 Child Protective Services Investigator [REDACTED] (CPSI) met with [REDACTED] (14 years old) privately at her family home in a bedroom reported to be her sister [REDACTED] room to discuss the investigation of abuse death and lack of supervision. In order to engage [REDACTED] CPSI [REDACTED] explained that CPSI [REDACTED] job is to make sure children are safe at home and school and CPSI [REDACTED] just needed to ask her a

few questions. She reported last week she woke up, she went into her mother's room, and her mother was just coming out the shower. She reported they both went into [REDACTED] bedroom. She reported at this time she and her mother found [REDACTED] unresponsive so her mother called 911. She reported on Sunday she was actually at the family home when she got the call [REDACTED] had passed away. She reported her family had only been in Tennessee about 1 month coming from [REDACTED] where she was born. She reported her family moved to Tennessee to start a new life. She reported she knew her sister smoked Black and Mild's but she did not do any other drugs as far as she knows. She reported in [REDACTED] she was making A's, B's, and C's but [REDACTED] had been expelled from alternative school for fighting. She denied her mother's boyfriend [REDACTED] giving her sister [REDACTED] any medications and/or alcohol prior to her sister's hospitalization at [REDACTED]. Observations: CPSI [REDACTED] observed no visible marks or bruises on [REDACTED]. CPSI [REDACTED] ended face to face contact with [REDACTED] by thanking her for speaking with CPSI [REDACTED].

On 07/14/2015 Child Protective Services Investigator [REDACTED] (CPSI) met with [REDACTED] (12 years old) privately at her family home in a bedroom reported to be her sister [REDACTED] room to discuss the investigation of abuse death and lack of supervision. In order to engage [REDACTED] CPSI [REDACTED] explained that CPSI [REDACTED] job is to make sure children are safe at home and school and CPSI [REDACTED] just needed to ask her a few questions. [REDACTED] reported she had not been here in Tennessee when the incident occurred with [REDACTED] but was actually in [REDACTED] with other family members. She reported she did not get here until 3 days ago. [REDACTED] reported her family was previously living in [REDACTED]. Observations: CPSI [REDACTED] observed no visible marks or bruises on [REDACTED]. CPSI [REDACTED] ended face to face contact with [REDACTED] by thanking her for speaking with CPSI [REDACTED].

On 07/15/2015 CPSI [REDACTED] spoke to Ms [REDACTED], LCSW at telephone number [REDACTED]. She reported she is a social worker at [REDACTED] Hospital in the Emergency Department. She reported [REDACTED] was being treated at [REDACTED] Hospital from 07/09/2015 until her passing for an overdose. She reported during [REDACTED] hospitalization she never spoke with [REDACTED] sister nor [REDACTED] mother boyfriend personally. CPSI [REDACTED] ended phone conversation by thanking Ms. [REDACTED] for her time and for working with the department.

On 01/05/2016 CPSI [REDACTED] called and spoke to Sergeant (Sgt.) [REDACTED] at telephone number [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Police Department regarding the [REDACTED] family as collateral in this case. Sgt. [REDACTED] reported in January, March, April, May, June, September, October, and November of 2011 [REDACTED] was reported as a runaway. Sgt. On 07/14/2015 CPSI [REDACTED] interviewed Ms. [REDACTED] at her family home in the living room. She reported her family recently moved from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] TN on 06/21/2015. She reported [REDACTED] has runaway 39 times. She reported [REDACTED] would stay away for 3 to 4 days at a time. She reported [REDACTED] was placed at [REDACTED] Youth Detention Center (YDC) in [REDACTED] for some time due to her delinquent behaviors. She reported November 2013 she bought [REDACTED] back home and then [REDACTED] was placed at the YDC again because her and some friends were found in an abandoned building. She reported 11/10/2014 [REDACTED] maternal uncle was killed and [REDACTED] grandmother moved to [REDACTED]. She reported [REDACTED] stayed with her grandma for two weeks before the family moved to Tennessee. She reported since November 2014 [REDACTED] has tried to commit suicide two different times. She reported the last time [REDACTED] tried to commit suicide she called the police and they got [REDACTED] a psychological evaluation in

She reported ██████████ started taking the Prozac and did a 180 degree turn for the better. She reported on 07/09/2015 she woke up early like 6:00AM. She reported she bumped into ██████████ in the hallway and ██████████ was extremely apologetic. She reported around 11:00AM she noticed ██████████ was nodding off in which she assumed was from the Prozac she had given ██████████ that morning as prescribed; therefore, she told ██████████ to go lay down. She reported she then went to take a shower. She reported after her shower she got dressed. The Department of Children's Services (DCS) Child Protective Services Unit received a referral on 07/13/2015 with the allegations of Abuse Death and Lack of Supervision regarding non-custodial child [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] (15 years old) resided in her family home with her younger female siblings [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] mother [REDACTED] and mother's boyfriend [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] Tennessee. On July 9, 2015 [REDACTED] reported to EMS personnel and medical staff at [REDACTED] Hospital that she found [REDACTED] unresponsive that morning in their family home. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital Emergency Room via ambulance. Speaking with hospital staff [REDACTED] informed medical personnel that [REDACTED] possibly overdosed on medications that were in their family home. [REDACTED] was admitted to [REDACTED] Hospital throughout the weekend. On July 11, 2015 [REDACTED] had a brain hemorrhage that she was unable to recover from. [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased on July 12, 2015 after having two brain death exams. It has been reported [REDACTED] brain hemorrhage was caused by the overdose. It is unknown the specific drugs [REDACTED] was positive for at the time of her admission into the hospital. According to one of [REDACTED] sisters, a day prior to [REDACTED] episode, [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] Benadryl along with three shots of some type of alcohol to calm her down. [REDACTED] has a history of mental illness and has had a difficult time coping with her mental illness. [REDACTED] has had two prior suicide attempts and had recently been in-patient in [REDACTED] for a few weeks, but she completed the treatment program and was released near the end of June. No autopsy had yet to be completed on [REDACTED] has her family will donate her organs. Law enforcement initially was not contacted because [REDACTED] death was being viewed as a typical suicide and the family was appropriate.

The investigation into the incident was conducted by Metro Police Detectives [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], DCS Child Protective Services Unit Investigative Coordinator [REDACTED], and Investigator [REDACTED].

3. Any child death that is the result of the caretaker's failure to meet childcare responsibilities. Neglect death is always treated as severe child abuse.

CPSI [REDACTED] received the final autopsy report by mail on 11/12/2015 from the Forensic Medical Examiner's Office.

The case was presented to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigation Team on 11/18/2015. The Team members were able to come up with an agreement that there was insufficient evidence to substantiate the allegations of Abuse Death and Lack of Supervision due to the final autopsy reporting suicide as the manner of death.

Currently there is not a preponderance of evidence to substantiate the allegation of Child Neglect Death.

The case will be closed and classified as Allegation Unsubstantiated Perpetrator Unsubstantiated for the allegation of Child Abuse Death and Lack of Supervision.

Investigator [REDACTED] was assigned the following P1 referral by [REDACTED]:

"The reporter states [REDACTED] (15) lives in the home with her younger female sibling (approx 14) whose name is unknown by the reporter, their birth mother [REDACTED] (approx 38), and [REDACTED] paramour, [REDACTED] (age unknown). The family lives at [REDACTED] County). The child was not in DCS custody. On July 9, 2015, [REDACTED] reported to EMS personnel and medical staff at [REDACTED] Hospital that she found [REDACTED] unresponsive in a room at their home and was unable to wake her. She said she immediately called EMS who arrived at the home. EMS transported [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital via ambulance. At the time [REDACTED] spoke with EMS and [REDACTED] medical staff, and told them [REDACTED] had reportedly overdosed on some unknown medications that were in her home. [REDACTED] was admitted to [REDACTED] and stayed throughout the weekend. On July 11, 2015 she had a brain hemorrhage that she was unable to recover from. Two (2) brain death exams were performed by medical staff at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was pronounced yesterday, July 12, 2015. The reporter states the brain hemorrhage was caused by the overdose. The reporter does not know the specific drug(s) [REDACTED] was positive for at the time of admission. The reporter does not know what other drugs [REDACTED] may have had access to in the home. According to [REDACTED] sister a day prior to [REDACTED] overdose, [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] Benadryl along with three (3) shots of some type of alcohol to calm her down. [REDACTED] has a history of mental illness and has had a hard time coping with the mental illness. She has had two (2) prior suicide attempts and had recently been in in-patient treatment in [REDACTED] for a couple of weeks. She completed that treatment and was released near the end of June. No autopsy has yet been completed and [REDACTED] body remains at [REDACTED] Hospital because her organs will be donated. The scheduled date for the autopsy is unknown by the reporter. LE has not been contacted because initially [REDACTED] death was viewed as a typical suicide and the family was very appropriate; there were no initial concerns of any wrongdoing or suspicious activities. The reporter does not know if LE will be contacted by the hospital staff now that new information has become available regarding [REDACTED] actions towards [REDACTED] prior to her death. According to the reporter, [REDACTED] acknowledged that she was aware that the actions allegedly taken by [REDACTED] were completely inappropriate in handling the situation. However, she states she has not had an opportunity to speak with [REDACTED] since the incident occurred, although he was at the hospital while [REDACTED] was being cared for.
