The child is not in state custody.

[REDACTED] (last name unknown, age 14), [REDACTED] (last name unknown, age 8), [REDACTED] (last name unknown, age 3), and [REDACTED] (age 4 months) have been living with their mother, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County. The birth father to [REDACTED] is [REDACTED]. He lives at an unknown location.

A woman named [REDACTED] (relationship unknown) was stated to be in the home when this happened.

It is unknown at this time who has custody of the four children. [REDACTED] stated she has had an Immediate Protection Agreement (IPA) in place since January, 2018 and is only supposed to be supervised with [REDACTED] by the child's aunt, [REDACTED] and the child's father, [REDACTED].

On 3/30/2018 [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital by EMS as a CPR in progress. According to the initial report by EMS, [REDACTED] was found unresponsive in the bathtub. There are not a lot of details regarding what happened and the story from [REDACTED] is very "fuzzy." According to EMS when they asked [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] was last seen alive and breathing she reported 20 minutes or so prior to EMS' arrival (time unknown). [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was in the home and [REDACTED] was supposed to be supervising the children while [REDACTED] slept. It is unknown who at this time put [REDACTED] in the bathtub. EMS arrived at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital right at 8:00 P.M. [REDACTED] heartbeat was regained after extensive CPR in the hospital and on the scene. It is unclear at this time how long [REDACTED] did not have a heartbeat. Law Enforcement was on the scene and it is believed there are currently Detectives involved. [REDACTED] did mention having an IPA while speaking with EMS and Law Enforcement and stated that [REDACTED] (father) and [REDACTED] are supposed to supervise her while she has [REDACTED]. Based on the information known at this time, it is believed [REDACTED] (father) is in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was not at the home. [REDACTED] was seen at the hospital but at the time of the report, it is unknown where she is.

[REDACTED] is currently in the PICU in room [REDACTED] under the care and supervision of Dr. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is medically stable but it is unknown how serious [REDACTED] injuries are or if he is going to be able to recover. It was stated in the medical notes that the main medical problems are due to fatal submersion, respiratory failure and cardiac arrest. [REDACTED] is still currently very sick due to this. It is unknown what [REDACTED] neurological response is at this time. Tests are still being run on [REDACTED]. This is being considered a near death situation due to the length of CPR, [REDACTED] current conditions, and the unknown factors. It is unknown if [REDACTED] had any injuries when he came into the hospital. [REDACTED] has



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been to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital before and abuse and neglect was suspected which was reported to DCS in intake [REDACTED]. It is not believed there have been any child deaths or serious injuries in the household. At this time it is unknown if this was caused due to abuse or neglect due to the lack of information known. None of the other children have been seen or spoken with. [REDACTED] made it seem as if the other three children were with [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] but this cannot be confirmed.

On March 30, 2018 at 9:31PM, the Department of Childrens Services (DCS) received a referral for an allegation of Lack of Supervision regarding Alleged Child Victim (ACV) [REDACTED] Jr. (4 months). The Alleged Perpetrator (AP) was identified as birth mother, [REDACTED] Jr. passed away due to fatal submersion, respiratory failure and cardiac arrest on March 31, 2018, at approximately 12:20AM. The Abuse Death allegation was added with [REDACTED] named as the AP. The birth father, [REDACTED] Sr., was also added to the investigation as an AP for Lack of Supervision. This investigation was assigned to Child Protective Services Investigator (CPSI) [REDACTED] by Lead Investigator (LI) [REDACTED]. This case was worked in conjunction with Metro Police Department (MPD) Officer, Detective [REDACTED] and Detective [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] Jr. (4 months) lived at home with birth parents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Sr. Also in the home are siblings [REDACTED] (14), [REDACTED] (9), and [REDACTED] (4). Birth father, [REDACTED] shares custody of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Birth father, [REDACTED] has limited contact with [REDACTED] and attempts to contact him were unsuccessful.

On March 30, 2018 at 9:31PM, DCS received a referral stating [REDACTED] (14), [REDACTED] (8), [REDACTED] (3), and [REDACTED] Jr (4 months) were living with their mother, Ms. [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] stated she had an Immediate Protection Agreement (IPA) in place since January 2018 and is only supposed to be supervised with [REDACTED] Jr. by the child's aunt, [REDACTED] and the child's father, [REDACTED] Sr. [REDACTED] Jr. arrived at [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital by EMS with CPR in progress. EMS reported [REDACTED] Jr. was found unresponsive in the bathtub. Additionally, Ms. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] Jr. was last seen alive and breathing 20 minutes prior to EMS arrival. Medical documentation stated the main medical problems were due to fatal submersion, respiratory failure, and cardiac arrest.

On March 30, 2018, CPSI [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED] birth mother. Ms. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] Jr. was placed in the care of his birth father, [REDACTED] Sr., because she has an open CPS Investigation from January 2018. Ms. [REDACTED] stated Mr. [REDACTED] Sr. left [REDACTED] Jr. in her care because he was traveling to [REDACTED] TN to visit his ill father. Ms. [REDACTED] stated she took a nap and [REDACTED] babysat

[REDACTED] Jr. Ms. [REDACTED] stated when she woke up she and [REDACTED] took a bath. Ms. [REDACTED] stated her recollections of the events prior to [REDACTED] death were fuzzy and she could not recall any additional details. Ms. [REDACTED] stated she was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Ms. [REDACTED] breath smelled of an alcoholic beverage upon initial contact at the hospital.

On March 30, 2018, CPSI [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED] Ms. [REDACTED] reported she had arrived at the home to take Ms. [REDACTED] to the store, and [REDACTED] Jr. was in Ms. [REDACTED] care. Ms. [REDACTED] reported Ms. [REDACTED] was taking a bath with [REDACTED] Jr. Ms. [REDACTED] reported while Ms. [REDACTED] was in the bathtub she went outside and sat in her car to use the phone. Ms. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] ran outside crying, told her [REDACTED] Jr. was in the bathtub with Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Jr. was blue. Ms. [REDACTED] reported she and [REDACTED] ran into the house and she observed Ms. [REDACTED] in the bathtub asleep. Ms. [REDACTED] reported she began to administer CPR on [REDACTED] Jr. Ms. [REDACTED] reported while all the commotion was happening, Ms. [REDACTED] was in the bathtub sleeping and attempts to wake her were unsuccessful. Ms. [REDACTED] stated Ms. [REDACTED] did not become responsive until later, after EMTs banged on the bathroom door to notify her they were transporting [REDACTED] Jr. to [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital.

After further investigation, CPSI [REDACTED] verified on January 18, 2018, DCS received a referral for an allegation of Drug Exposed Child regarding ACV [REDACTED] Jr. (3 months), with Ms. [REDACTED] named as the AP. Ms. [REDACTED] left the ACV in his car seat for an unknown period of time. Ms. [REDACTED] had a car accident with the ACV and was found intoxicated at a strangers residence. Ms. [REDACTED] assaulted a paramedic and was arrested during this incident. [REDACTED] Jr. was transported to [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital for further observation. Ms. [REDACTED] was later charged and convicted of Child Endangerment and Assault; she is currently serving a suspended community supervision sentence of 11 months. CPSI [REDACTED] was assigned to the investigation and Ms. [REDACTED] agreed to place [REDACTED] Jr. in an Immediate Protective Agreement with [REDACTED] Sr. In addition, Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Sr. agreed all contact between [REDACTED] Jr. and Ms. [REDACTED] would be supervised by [REDACTED] Sr. On March 27, 2018, the investigation was transferred to Family Support Services (FSS) Worker, [REDACTED] for additional services, by CPSI [REDACTED] The IPA was updated and Ms. [REDACTED] was referred for a parenting assessment and drug treatment. Upon FSS receiving the case for transfer, Ms. [REDACTED] had not participated in any DCS services. CPSI [REDACTED] closed the investigation as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated for Drug Exposed Child of [REDACTED] Jr. by Ms. [REDACTED]

On April 12, 2018, CPSI [REDACTED] observed a forensic interview of [REDACTED] Forensic Interviewer [REDACTED] conducted the interview, while Detective [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED] observed via live video in an adjoining room. Forensic Interviewer [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to tell her about the events that led to the accident regarding [REDACTED] Jr. [REDACTED] reported Ms. [REDACTED] stated she was going to take a bath with [REDACTED] Jr. [REDACTED] stated she went outside and when she returned to the bathroom she saw [REDACTED] Jr. in the bathtub, under Ms. [REDACTED] leg; [REDACTED] Jr. was submerged under water in the bathtub. [REDACTED] reported she took [REDACTED] Jr. out of the tub, patted him on his back, and ran outside for help. [REDACTED] reported Ms. [REDACTED] was asleep in the bathtub and she attempted to wake her, but she did not wake.

On June 21, 2018, the final autopsy was received for [REDACTED] completed on April 2, 2018, by [REDACTED] A. [REDACTED] M.D, Center for Forensic Medicine, [REDACTED] TN. The autopsy states, "On postmortem examination, there is a black male infant with areas of therapeutic intervention and without significant external traumatic injuries. Internal examination reveals an edematous brain and congested edematous lungs. Toxicology analysis is negative." Cause of death was determined to be drowning and manner of death was determined to be accident.

On July 24, 2018, CPSI [REDACTED] presented this case to the [REDACTED] County Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT). Members were in attendance from DCS, the Child Advocacy Center, the District Attorneys Office, and [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital. The team was in agreement that there was a preponderance of evidence that supports the substantiation of Abuse Death.

On September 13, 2018, CPSI [REDACTED] received Metro Police Department Case Summary from Detective [REDACTED]. Detective [REDACTED] stated while investigating the death of [REDACTED] Jr., he interviewed Mr. [REDACTED]. Detective [REDACTED] stated during interviews conducted it was discovered Ms. [REDACTED] consumed alcohol prior to falling asleep while in the tub with [REDACTED]. Detective [REDACTED] stated, Ms. [REDACTED] stated she bought, a shot of vodka earlier that afternoon; though she denied being intoxicated, she admitted it was enough to cause her to fall asleep. Detective [REDACTED] stated further evidence to indicate possible impairment was the inconsistent statements of Ms. [REDACTED] during her initial encounter with law enforcement at her apartment and the hospital. At a court hearing on September 24, 2018, Ms. [REDACTED] did not contest allegations in the petition as to the abuse and dependent and neglect concerns included therein regarding Lack of Supervision.

During the course of the investigation an Immediate Protective Agreement (IPA) was initiated and the surviving siblings were placed with relatives. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were placed with [REDACTED] birth father, and [REDACTED] was placed with [REDACTED] maternal aunt. A safety plan was established and agreed to by all caregivers that all face to face contact between [REDACTED] and the children would be supervised by [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]. In addition, all visits between [REDACTED] and the children could not be supervised by other friends or relatives. A Non-Custodial Permanency Plan (NCPP) was initiated and agreed by all caregivers stating that [REDACTED] would complete a Mental Health Assessments and follow recommendations, complete Parenting Assessment and follow all recommendations, complete an Alcohol and Drug Assessment and follow all recommendations, and cooperate with Metro Police Department investigation of [REDACTED] death. CPSI [REDACTED] conducted follow-up visits with [REDACTED] the surviving siblings, and temporary custodians and there were no further concerns. A transitioning staffing was conducted with Family Support Services (FSS), the NCPP was updated, and the family will continue to be monitored by FSS. An FSS case remains open with the family to track and monitor A&D services and compliance with the mother, as additional support services for the family. The children remain placed with Ms. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] at this time.

According to DCS Policy Chapter 14, Work Aid 1, Section E, Child Death is defined as:
Child Death:

1. Child death is defined as:
 - a) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect.
 - b) Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
 - c) Any child death caused by abuse or neglect resulting from the parent or legal custodian/caretaker failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of the child. Child deaths are always treated as severe abuse.
2. A near death, per Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 37-5-107(c)(4) is defined as a serious or critical medical condition resulting from abuse, neglect or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the child subsequent to the abuse or neglect.

NOTE: When an initial referral or a referral on an open case contains information that suggests the child is in a serious or critical medical condition as a result of the allegation(s) or has been determined to meet the criteria for an allegation of near death as defined above, the Child Abuse Hotline selects Preliminary Near Death (PND) Indicator in TFACTS on the participants tab on a new intake or the investigative persons tab on an active case. The information does not have to come from a physician.

Failure to provide adequate supervision, by a parent or other legal custodian/caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that:

- a) The child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the child's level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or
- b) Caregiver inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child, but is unable or unwilling to supervise (e.g., the caregiver is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, is depressed, sleeps during the day or has inadequate parenting knowledge or skills).
- c) Any registered sex offender residing in the home with unrelated minor children or victim of offender and/or caregiver knowingly resides with and/or allows children to be unsupervised with a registered sex offender

There is a preponderance of evidence that supports the substantiation for all allegations against [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Sr. This case will be closed as Allegation Substantiated, Perpetrator Substantiated for the allegations of Abuse Child Death by Alleged Perpetrator, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Lack of Supervision by alleged perpetrators, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Sr. and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] against Alleged Child Victim, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Jr.
