Describe (in detail) cause or circumstance regarding the death/injury: Said child resides in the home with his mother and her fiance. Child came home from school (via school bus) as usual and entered the home. The family owns two pitbulls. Child stated that he was home alone and usually is for a few minutes when he gets home from school. Child stated that one of the dogs jumped on him and the harder he fought the dog the madder it got. The child's right arm was nearly torn off by the dog. There is no blood flow to the right hand. The child was also bitten in the face and neck.

Describe (in detail) interview with family: [REDACTED] reported that the family just moved to [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] and have actually been living in the area for 3 weeks. [REDACTED] reported that the child is always in the home alone for 20-30 minutes after school. [REDACTED] works in [REDACTED] and is on her way home when the child gets home from school. This has been the situation for 3 weeks now. [REDACTED] said that the child always calls her when he gets home from school and she was working late. She stated that when the child did not call, she called him and he was screaming and crying. [REDACTED] said that she contacted [REDACTED] 911 and told them to send an ambulance to the home. The child was air lifted to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that her fiance was on his way home as well when she contacted him and told him to get there fast. [REDACTED] stated that they have had the dogs since they were puppies and have no idea what happened or why they did what they did. Animal control came and got the aggressive dog and it was destroyed. The family is getting rid of the other dog as well. There are no other children in the home.

[REDACTED] went home after being attacked by the dog. There was no one home and [REDACTED] sat at home for about an hour. The arm was almost ripped completely off and [REDACTED] has no vascular pulse in his arm. [REDACTED] reported that his mother works and the boyfriend works close to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was home alone and just sat waiting on someone to come home. The boyfriend came home first and contacted 911. However it was noted that boyfriend did not feel that he needed to go to the hospital with [REDACTED] is in critical condition and in surgery. The outcome is unknown, but it is likely that if [REDACTED] makes it he will not have his left arm. [REDACTED] is at the hospital with [REDACTED]

He stated that they used to stop at the 7-11 to get breakfast in the mornings. ██████████ reported that he likes living with his mom and ██████████ and said that ██████████ was supposed to be his dog when he was a puppy. ██████████ reported that he feels safe.

Staff from ██████████ Medical Center sent copies of nursing notes sharing concerns. The child had numerous surgeries to repair and rebuild his arm. Skin graphs were taken from his right thigh.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

CPSI ██████████ and Lt. Det. ██████████ conducted AP interviews with ██████████ and ██████████ at the ██████████ County DCS office on 02/15/2013. This interview was recorded and placed on a disc. Both ██████████ and ██████████ reported having a plan for ██████████ to come in to the house, get the phone off of the charger, and go straight to his room when he got home from school. This plan was for his protection according to the mother and her boyfriend. ██████████ and ██████████ were interviewed separately. Both denied that the pit bulls that they had have ever been aggressive. Both denied that ██████████ has ever expressed any fear of the dogs. ██████████ and ██████████ reported that they do not know what happened to cause the dog ██████████ to attack ██████████. The other dog was sent to live with the child's biological father in ██████████ and ██████████ were very defensive of the dogs and did not appear to understand the seriousness of the attack. ██████████ and ██████████ both consented to allow a urine specimen to be collected for the purpose of a substance abuse screening. ██████████ tested negative for all tested substances and ██████████ failed the screening for THC. ██████████ and ██████████ reported that they moved to TN because the neighborhood they lived in was very bad and unsafe.

Both denied having any knowledge that this attack would happen if ██████████ was left alone. ██████████ had been home alone for 20-30 minutes everyday after school for 3 weeks prior to this incident.

TL [REDACTED] reviewed this case on this date as the case was presented to CPIT. The specifics of the case were discussed. The dog that bit the child has been euthanized. The family got rid of the other dog in the home. There are no more dogs in the home. The child got home from school and the dog attacked him. The mother called the child and all the mother could hear was the child crying and screaming. The mother told the child to try and get out of the house, but he was unable. The mother called 911. The child was airlifted to [REDACTED] Medical Center. The child had surgery that night and ended up having a total of 5 surgeries. The child was getting some feeling back in his hand. The child has been discharged and is now home. The family voiced concerns about the mother and boyfriend using drugs. The mother was clean and her fiancé was positive for THC. The fiancé does not provide care for the child. The child is usually not home alone long. Usually, the child is only home for around 30 minutes alone, while the mother is in route home from work. The mother reported that the neighbors usually keep an eye on the child as he walks from the school bus home. The mother reported that they have taught the child "dog safety" and they do not let the child play rough with the dog. Other family members report that the dog that bit the child had a history of being aggressive. The mother reported that the child had a routine when he got home from school. The child was supposed to enter the home into the laundry room, get the phone, and then go straight to his room and close the door. According to the nurses at [REDACTED] Medical Center, the child reported to them that he was afraid of the dog. The child reported that the dog was his friend when he was a puppy, but he got mean. The child reported to the nurses that he wanted a nice puppy, not a mean one. The child told nurses that when he wakes up, he would like to have a light to make sure [REDACTED] was not there. The child told the nurses that he wanted to make sure [REDACTED] was dead. The child told the nurses that this was his fault and [REDACTED] had to die because of him. The child tried to make excuses for why the dog bit him. CPS discussed mental health counseling with the mother. CPS is also going to recommend an A & D assessment. CPS is recommending the classification of AIPI for severe lack of supervision. The family has remedied the situation, as they have gotten rid of the dogs. CPS has spoken with the child's biological father, who is not legitimized and there are no legal/formal arrangements for visitation. The mother has full custody of the child. This case was presented to CPIT on this date (02/28/2013) and the team agreed with the classification recommendations. The following next steps/tasks to be completed are to include, but are not limited to the following:

- Complete a family permanency plan during an FSTM to outline next steps for the family to include a mental health intake/trauma focused evaluation
- Make a referral or PSG for an A & D Assessment
- Update case recordings

Both denied that the pit bulls that they had have ever been aggressive. Both denied that [REDACTED] has ever expressed any fear of the dogs. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reported that they do not know what happened to cause the dog [REDACTED] to attack [REDACTED]. The other dog was sent to live with the child's biological father in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were very defensive of the dogs and did not appear to understand the seriousness of the attack.
