On 05/24/2013, [Redacted] was observed at [Redacted] Hospital and it was noticed that he was on a respirator to protect the airway. [Redacted] was unable to provide a statement due to his age and his condition at the time.

The ICU doctor, [Redacted] was spoken to and stated that the doctors in the ER determined that [Redacted] was not run over by the truck. He did not have a spinal cord injury, no head injury except for the laceration that received stitches, and a grade 1 laceration on the liver that will heal on its own. The only lung problems the child has is due to the breathing tube that was placed in his throat. The child was fully expected to be home within a week.

It was stated that the family had been to the grandfather's home to do laundry. Due to the fact that there are so many children and the laundry too, the mom put the carseat in the back of her truck [Redacted]. The children were in the car without car seats and most of them were not wearing a seat belt. The mother reports she stopped at a corner store for cookie and drinks for the children and while she was in the store, the children

in the backseat switched places. The five year old, ██████████ and the 1 year old, ██████████ moved from the middle of the back seat to by the door. It was reported that ██████████ started playing with the door and it opened a little. While he was playing with the door, ██████████ started looking out of the window for his mom and when the mom came back to the truck and started it up and preceded to put the truck in reverse and back up, the door swung open and ██████████ fell out of the truck. DCS defines Lack of Supervision as the failure to provide adequate supervision, by a parent or other caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that: a) The child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the child's level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or b) Caretaker inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child but is unable or unwilling to supervise; c) Any registered sex offender residing in a home with unrelated minor children or victim of offender, and/or caregiver knowingly resides with and/or allows children to be unsupervised with a registered sex offender.

Victim [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is too young to provide a statement and it appears that the siblings in the car with the victim also gave conflicting stories. The only story that seems compelling is that the mother went into the store, leaving the children in the car. Upon which, the children in the back seat changed positions, someone open the back door enough that allowed the infant for fall out when the mother returned and started her car in reverse. The mother admitted that no one was buckle in a car seat.

The mother was interviewed as well as some of the children in the car at the time of the incident. The victim is currently doing well. The mother is currently without a vehicle at this time. The assessment of the children shows safe as there are no immediately harm factors identified at this time.

This case does meet the criteria for indication due to the mother's lack of supervision of the children which caused a child to be injured. A copy of the indication letter will be placed in the case file and the original sent to the parent. The 740 Classification and Decision form will be forwarded to Juvenile Court upon the closure of this case.

She stated that she has car seats now and she is getting ready to go back to work in the morning so they children will be attending daycare now. She stated that she is employed by ██████████ ██████████ on ██████████ and that the children will be attending ██████████ Daycare on ██████████. Ms. ██████████ stated that ██████████ is fine and he was in the hospital for about 2-3 weeks. She stated that he was released from the hospital with no problems. She stated that he sustained some scrapes and bruises, but that was all. She stated that she learned her lesson from this incident. She stated that after the incident, her truck was towed and because they were charging so much, she was unable to get it back, so they sold it. She stated that she is currently working on trying to get her another vehicle. Ms. ██████████ stated that she has 7 children in all and after this last baby, she got her tubes tied. She stated the apartment is 4 bedrooms/ 1 bath and that they have been living in the apartment complex for about 4 years now.

Investigator III observed the children as they were preparing for bed. ██████████ was on the couch asleep, the mother was holding ██████████ and the other 5 children were preparing for bed. The children appeared to be well taken care of and appeared to be developmentally age appropriate. The gentleman that answered the door was ██████████ the father of the 3 oldest children. The mother stated that he did not live there, but he comes over to spend time with the children and he helps her take care of them.

[REDACTED] received a grade 1 laceration on the liver that will heal on it's own. The lung issues occurred when the breathing tube was placed in his throat.
