[REDACTED] came into the [REDACTED] Medical Center Emergency Room in [REDACTED] today around 6:00 pm lethargic and unresponsive related to a Subutex and Valium overdose. It is unknown how many pills [REDACTED] consumed.

[REDACTED] has been seen by the doctor, and he is better now that he has Narcan Drip (given to overcome an opiate overdose) to reverse the effects of Subutex, which would act like a narcotic and cause respiratory depression and sedation. [REDACTED] Tachycardic (heart rate) and his oxygen stats were low. [REDACTED] would have died if he had not been brought to the ER.

Mother [REDACTED] claims that she has a prescription for the drugs. [REDACTED] is unsure how [REDACTED] got the drugs. [REDACTED] claims that [REDACTED] got into her purse and got the drugs out. The pills were in the prescription bottles with child safety caps in place. Law enforcement has not been contacted.

CPSI [REDACTED] spoke with RN [REDACTED] who stated the child is currently in critical condition and will be moved to PICU soon. RN states the mother keeps leaving to room to go outside and smoke every few minutes. RN states the child's oxygen level was 80% upon arrival and the child has multiple cavities in its teeth. DTF Agents observed with CPSI [REDACTED] environmental concerns noted which caused the parents to be arrested for child neglect. [REDACTED] was asleep on furniture in the living room and had roaches crawling on her and there were large traps set up all over the home. On 3/21/2013 a CFTM was held at the [REDACTED] County office.

Summary

[REDACTED] began the meeting with introductions. This is the first meeting that the foster mom - [REDACTED] has ever attended and requested that we be cautious of using acronyms. The confidentiality agreement was discussed and reviewed. This meeting was also supposed to be a seven day meeting to develop a permanency plan but the parents have retained [REDACTED] as their attorney. There are criminal charges pending and he advised them not to attend the CFTM. [REDACTED] reviewed the CPS history with the family. This referral was for a DEC and the mother stated that [REDACTED] was asleep right where he had been in playing in the floor. She went to pick him up and put him on the couch but he was limp. She saw her purse in the floor and saw a pill container laying open in the floor. The family keeps their medication in a lock box due to a prior CPS case. The mother stated that when she was pregnant with [REDACTED] she knew that she would be gone and miss her scheduled dose of medications so she placed one dose of her suboxen and valium in a pill box and put it in her purse. When she found [REDACTED] in the floor she noticed that the pill box was out of her purse and open in the floor. [REDACTED] was taken to the ER. At a home visit to see the other two children the re were environmental issues in the home, especially the comment made by the father that there was a wolf rat that the father has set out traps to catch. [REDACTED] was asleep and had roaches crawling on top of her. The father was arrested for felony child neglect and abuse. The mother was also scheduled to be arrested on the same charges. An IPA was completed that would prevent the mother from leaving the hospital with [REDACTED] AMA. The children were removed and placed in foster care. The three children were initially placed in the foster home of [REDACTED] but she quickly began to realize that these three children under the age of four with their needs was more than she can handle and plans had to be made to move the children. The decision was made by the placement unit that the children would be separated and [REDACTED] would remain with [REDACTED] and that the other two would be placed with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she was completely not ready and she should have realized that but her husband was very excited. The children did not cry and was not upset. [REDACTED] stated that the children were dirty and unkept. [REDACTED] mumbles and does not speak very plainly. She is not a hazard to herself. It's hard to get her to make a decision between such things like milk and juice. She does not like to sleep in a bed. [REDACTED] stated that sat in the floor in the [REDACTED] that she could not sleep on the couch due to the location of the living room and the bedrooms in the home. [REDACTED] finally fell asleep. [REDACTED] was picked up at the hospital and did not display outward signs of emotional distress on [REDACTED] part at being picked up by a stranger. [REDACTED] did not display outward signs of excitement when [REDACTED] came home. [REDACTED] describes the children as disconnected. [REDACTED] doesn't talk. He understands her commands such as time out and scoot back from the television but doesn't seem to have any concept

that the stove is hot, or that you can't jump on the table, move the baby bed etc. [REDACTED] states that neither of the older children seem to be interested in the baby. [REDACTED] stated that the degree of supervision that [REDACTED] requires made it impossible for her to keep all three children. She stated that she would keep [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] or she would keep [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] suggested that the CAC be contacted to see if play therapy for [REDACTED] is appropriate or if they have any other services that they can offer for the children. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appear to be speech delayed. [REDACTED] explained to the foster mom that a medical and dental needed to be scheduled and she would assist with that. [REDACTED] spoke to the CAC. They will work with the four year old and the three year old. The CAC informed [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had two other children that she does not have custody of due to sexual abuse perpetrated by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] The victim in that case is still in therapy at the CAC.

On 3/15/2013 at 8:30 P.M. CPSI [REDACTED] was paged to respond to P1 at [REDACTED] Hospital E.R. to respond to a near fatality due to suspected subutex and valium overdose of 3 year old [REDACTED]. CPSI [REDACTED] while in route to the hospital contacted [REDACTED] County DTF Lt. [REDACTED] who agreed to meet CM at the E.R. Upon arrival at E.R. at 9:15 A.M. CPSI [REDACTED] spoke with RN [REDACTED] who stated the child is currently in critical condition and will be moved to PICU soon. RN states the mother keeps leaving to room to go outside and smoke every few minutes. RN states the child's oxygen level was 80% upon arrival and the child has multiple cavities in its teeth. LT. [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED] spoke with Mrs. [REDACTED] about the incident. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated the father was outside working on his truck and she was in the home washing the dishes while the children were playing in the living room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were playing in the floor while [REDACTED] was asleep in his playpen in the living room. The mother looked over and saw [REDACTED] laying in the floor asleep right where he had been playing. She picked him up to place him on the couch and he was limp. She saw that the contents of her purse were spilled on the floor and remembered placing medication in her purse inside a yellow plastic box (see file for photo of box). She stated that during her pregnancy with [REDACTED] she had a prenatal visit and thought she would be gone all day. Not wanting to miss a dose of her medication she placed 1/2 a subutex and 1/2 of a valium in a small plastic pill bottle in a zippered compartment in her purse. Mrs. [REDACTED] immediately realized [REDACTED] must have taken the medication and got the child to the ER for treatment. Mrs. [REDACTED] states both her and her husband is on suboxin and keep it locked up in the same box this CM saw before in the closet in her bedroom. CPSI [REDACTED] call TL [REDACTED] who had conversations with RA [REDACTED] who stated to enter into an IPA with the mother stating she would not leave the hospital with the child against medical advice and to go check out the home and get fathers to sign as well. DCS attorney [REDACTED] approved the IPA and Mrs. [REDACTED] signed it. About that time [REDACTED] woke up and the Dr. stated he should be fine and out of danger from this point on but will still most likely spend the weekend in the PICU for observation. CPSI [REDACTED] as well as the two DTF agents from the HCSO, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went to the residence at [REDACTED]. There were environmental concerns noted which caused the parents to be arrested for child neglect. [REDACTED] was asleep on furniture in the living room and had roaches crawling on her and there were large traps set up all over the home. The father stated the traps were set out in an effort to catch a warf rat that had been coming in and out of the home. There were also large amounts of trash and other debris in the home.
