Mrs. [REDACTED] denies being at the residence at the time of [REDACTED] attempted overdose but does admit to allowing to child to fall back into his old drug habits after returning to her custody. Mrs. [REDACTED] also denies giving drugs to any other of her children.

Reporter states: [REDACTED] (14), [REDACTED] (14), [REDACTED] (possibly 16), and [REDACTED] (5) live with their mother [REDACTED]. Reporter stated the family lives at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] or the city could be [REDACTED]. The reporter is not aware of the children having any special needs or disabilities. A neighbor called 911 this morning (03-20-2013) at 6:09am ET regarding an overdose by [REDACTED] had walked to the neighbors home, [REDACTED] and he had slurred speech. He told her he had overdosed and had tried to kill himself. When Officers got to Ms. [REDACTED] home, [REDACTED] had slurred

speech and was going in and out of consciousness. He said he had taken Xanax, Adderall and Oxycontin in an attempt to kill himself. [REDACTED] said he is prescribed the Adderall. He said his grandfather and grandmother (names unknown) get prescription medication, and when they get their medication, the family goes crazy. According to [REDACTED] they front people medication for payment later and they burn the pills and snort them. He did not directly say that the other pills he took came from the grandparents. [REDACTED] was transported by ambulance to [REDACTED] Childrens Hospital. Officers tried to contact [REDACTED] mother. [REDACTED] advised reporter that once his mother learned that the police were coming she got the other children in the vehicle and left the home. The front door of the mothers open was open, but no one was inside. Officers found that the home was extremely damaged which [REDACTED] had admitted that he done the damage. Officers also found narcotics throughout the residence. Snort-type straws, mirror plates, marijuana residue, and loose pills on tables were seen in all rooms in the home. Pills that appeared to be Oxycontin had been burned and were found in [REDACTED] room. Loose pills were found in the mothers room which [REDACTED] shares with her mother. It is possible that the mother and other children went to the childrens grandmothers home on [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] TN [REDACTED]. The reporter did not have the grandmothers name, complete address or phone number. Reporter does not know [REDACTED] medical condition at this time. He was semi-conscious when he was driven away in the ambulance. According to Detective [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] Sheriffs Office, there is already an active case on the family. Detective [REDACTED] has talked to a DCS supervisor in [REDACTED]. According to the neighbor Ms. [REDACTED] the mother recently got the children back in her care after they had been in DCS custody.

On 9-3-13 there was an adjudication hearing before the Honorable Judge [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] Juvenile Court. Present at the hearing were [REDACTED] and her attorney [REDACTED] GAL [REDACTED] FSW [REDACTED] DCS attorney [REDACTED] and CPS supervisor [REDACTED]

DCS did not seek a severe abuse court finding against the mother. Ms. [REDACTED] stipulated to D&N due to unavailability due to hospitalization and improper guardianship due to drug use. The father remains incarcerated in [REDACTED] he is a federal inmate. There was a finding of D&N as related to the father due to his unavailability due to incarceration in the [REDACTED] Detention Center at the time of removal. The father had been arrested for the promotion of meth manufacture.

The next permanency plan hearing date is on November 12 at 9 AM. In October there will be a Foster Care Review Board hearing. The children remain in DCS custody in foster care.

On March 6th at 9:00 a.m. CM [REDACTED] went to the [REDACTED] resource home to check on the welfare of [REDACTED] CM [REDACTED] arrived at the residence and was allowed to speak with child in private at the home.

CM [REDACTED] discussed with the child how things have been going in her new resource home. [REDACTED] disclosed no safety concerns to the CM regarding her current placement or her resource parent. CM [REDACTED] also again discussed the reason for the child returning to foster care. [REDACTED] maintained the same story initially reported to the department that her brother was using drugs and got in trouble. [REDACTED] denied that she was at the residence at the time of the incident and any knowledge of drug use by her mother or anyone else. CM [REDACTED] discussed with [REDACTED] how she was found to be positive when drug screened at her health screening and she reported she was unsure of how she tested positive.

After leaving the resource home CM [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] High School and spoke with [REDACTED] CM [REDACTED] discussed with the child how her resource home was going and how her relationship was with her resource parents. [REDACTED] disclosed no safety concerns. CM [REDACTED] discussed with [REDACTED] the night her and her siblings re-entered custody and [REDACTED] again denied being at the residence when her brother was using drugs. She reported she that he had stole the medication from her deceased grandmother and stated her and her other siblings had been staying with her mother at her grandmother's home. [REDACTED] denied any knowledge of drug use by her mother or any other family siblings.

After leaving [REDACTED] High School CM [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] Elementary to check on the welfare of [REDACTED] CM [REDACTED] arrived and it was determined the child was on a field trip to the middle school at the time of the visit. School personnel reported no safety concerns to the CM since the child has begun attending their school.

Initial CFTM was held on this date 03/27/2013 to discuss that immediate needs/concerns and functional strengths of the children and family and develop immediate action plan. All four of the [REDACTED] children were removed from Mother on 03/20/2013 and placed back into state custody by CPS removal. [REDACTED] participated by phone from his current placement. [REDACTED] admitted that he took a bunch of his prescribed medication over a bad phone call with his girlfriend. On 03/20/2013, [REDACTED] law enforcement was called to the home and subsequently called [REDACTED] co. CPS and [REDACTED] was then rushed to the hospital after the overdose. [REDACTED] later was certified to [REDACTED] was suicidal ideations and acting on impulse. [REDACTED] therapist [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] appears to be ambivalent at times and appears to go back and forth. [REDACTED] stated that his true concern was being separated from his siblings currently. Treatment recommendations from [REDACTED] are for [REDACTED] to receive substance abuse treatment and mental health care in a level IV setting. [REDACTED] stated that he wants to learn his step down plan once he completes his treatment recommendations. Mother stated that she agreed with the recommendations of [REDACTED] Dr. [REDACTED] DCS Psychologist stated that level IV is for a period of stabilization before stepping down. [REDACTED] was placed in level IV through [REDACTED] earlier when the children were in state custody. The team discussed that once [REDACTED] steps down from level IV the current FH that the other children are placed with may have enough room for [REDACTED] to eventually transition back with his siblings. FP [REDACTED] did state that he runs a very structured and strict home and that the rules would be followed and that no drugs would be in the home. [REDACTED] (Grandmother) stated that when [REDACTED] takes his medication like he is supposed too that he does very well.

The team then discussed the issues that Health Connect CM [REDACTED] was having with the family keeping appointments with her prior to the children coming back into state custody. [REDACTED] stated that she was getting ready to close out the case right before the children came back into custody, but after [REDACTED] suicide attempt she was instructed by her supervisor to extend their services to the family. CPS FSW [REDACTED] then reported that [REDACTED] police responded to the home that [REDACTED] was at and stated that he had taken Xanax, Oxycodone, and Adderol and stated that he was sleeping when they arrived. FSW [REDACTED] reported that Mother and the other three children were allegedly at the Grandmothers home during this time. Mother was then notified that [REDACTED] was being transported to Children Hospital. Mother, [REDACTED] (MGM) and MGMs paramour (driver) then left to go to the hospital and in route to the hospital were involved in a wreck on [REDACTED] Highway. MGM was pronounced dead at the hospital and Mother and MGMs paramour were in critical condition. Mother is still in the hospital and participated by phone in the meeting.

Mrs. [REDACTED] her mother [REDACTED] and her paramour [REDACTED] were driving to Childrens Hospital and were involved in an automobile accident. Ms. [REDACTED] passed away and Mrs. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were taken to [REDACTED] Medical Center.

FSW and CPS first went to Ms. [REDACTED] residence where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (her daughter) were at the home. CPS obtained information from them and they reported the children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were on their way to [REDACTED] Hospital.

FSW and CPS then went to [REDACTED] Hospital. The children later arrived and FSW and CPS talked with the family about the situation. There were several family members at the hospital. CPS [REDACTED] later came to the hospital.

CPS talked with hospital personnel and they reported there was drug paraphernalia on Mrs. [REDACTED]. The children completed well checks at the hospital later in the day; as there were concerns about some environmental and drug exposure. [REDACTED] was positive for benzodiazepine and THC and [REDACTED] was positive for THC. [REDACTED] did not test positive for anything. [REDACTED] was in the restroom for a long time and there are concerns she may have altered or did something to the results.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were later able to briefly visit with their mother in the ER. An ER nurse came and talked with them about this and what to expect; as she had many broken bones in her face and broken pelvic bone. FSW, the family and the nurses discussed whether the children should see Mrs. [REDACTED] in that condition.

Mrs. [REDACTED] was sedated when the children went back there and she was unable to talk, as her mouth was wired shut, due to the broken bones in her jaw. The visit was brief.

After this, FSW and CPS transported the children to the office. They were later transported to a temporary placement
