The father laid [REDACTED] down on his side and went into the 2 year olds bedroom and brought him into the den to rock him to sleep.

While the father was rocking the 2 year old to sleep, the grandfather went into the room to check on [REDACTED] and noticed that he was not breathing. The grandfather called the father into the room who then tried to perform CPR on [REDACTED] while the grandfather called 911.

CPSI [REDACTED] contacted the coroner's office today. CPSI spoke with Investigator, [REDACTED] CPSI introduced herself and told Investigator [REDACTED] the reason for her call. CPSI inquired about the preliminary findings from the autopsy. Investigator [REDACTED] reported that they did not find any signs of foul play. She noted that [REDACTED] was free of any marks or bruises that would indicate abuse. CPSI thanked her for taking the time to speak with her.

[REDACTED] was observed to be constantly moving full of energy and bonded with parents. CPSI observed no marks, injuries or bruises on [REDACTED] CPSI attempted to interview child, but he would not talk with this CPSI and really didnt want to take a picture.

According to the autopsy report, ██████████ the cause of death was Undetermined (Sudden Unexplained Infant Death) and the manner of death could not be determined. There were not Pathological Diagnoses. The autopsy summary noted that ██████████ was found unresponsive in an adult bed where he had been sleeping with other children and his father, Mr. ██████████. It noted he was pronounced dead at 5:18 PM. It was noted that during the autopsy, there was no evidence of trauma to the body. The histologic, chemical, radiographic and toxicology studies were negative. The medical records were reviewed as well as the investigation. Therefore, the coroner was able to determine that the cause of death was SUID.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

The alleged perpetrator was listed as Unknown. However, the following statements were obtained from the birth father and Maternal grandfather, who were present at the time of the incident.

CPSI interviewed birth father ██████████ regarding incident. Mr. ██████████ reported that all 3 children and him were napping in the parents bed. Mr. ██████████ reported that ██████████ woke up around 3:40pm 3:50pm, he stated that ██████████ awoke grouchy and he didnt want him to wake the other babies. Mr. ██████████ reported that he exited the bed and placed infant ██████████ on his side on the upper right side of the bed. Mr. ██████████ reported that he exited the bedroom and went to rock ██████████ in the den. Mr. ██████████ reported that while he was rocking ██████████ in his arms, the grandfather ██████████ came to him and placed baby in his arms and said something was wrong ██████████. Mr. ██████████ reported that the grandfather called 911. Mr. ██████████ reported that he performed CPR on the infant for a few minutes and then the Ambulance came and took baby outside. Mr. ██████████ reported that the paramedics worked on infant for about 10 to 30 minutes then left and asked Dad if he wanted to go to the hospital with them. Mr. ██████████ reported that at the hospital they worked on him for about 10 to 15 minutes then pronounced him deceased. Parent reported that they gave up on him. [REDACTED] was sitting on the couch with her mother, Mrs. [REDACTED]. She had on a "bunny hat". She smiled and sucked on her pacifier. Mrs. [REDACTED] was not as tearful as she was during our initial visit. [REDACTED] was sitting on the couch. He was so excited as today was his birthday and he was going to have a sleep over. The boys were going to sleep in back in a tent. However, due to the weather, they will sleep under the carport. CPSI observed Mr. [REDACTED] to show affection to all three of the children. He obviously loves all of the children and they love him. Mrs. [REDACTED] was quiet and appeared to be the disciplinarian of the group.

CPSI asked about their holiday last month. Mrs. [REDACTED] reported that they had a good time. Mr. [REDACTED] agreed that they did have fun.

CPSI asked the parents if they knew that the autopsy had been completed. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she had assumed that it had as she has received a copy of the death certificate. CPSI noted that the cause of death was SUID. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she had already spoken to the pediatrician who told the family the autopsy findings. She noted that having one child die of SUID made a parent fearful for the other child/ren. She noted that she was concerned for [REDACTED] as she does not know what to look for or to avoid.

Mr. [REDACTED] reported that around 4:00pm 4:10pm, 10 minutes had went by and he went to the bathroom and went to check on the children. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that infant [REDACTED] was limp. Grandfather reported that infant [REDACTED] was still warm and his color was normal. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he attempted CPR, and reported birth father being in the den rocking [REDACTED] for his nap. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he blew into the infants mouth trying to wake him up. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he gave infant to birth father to continue CPR while he called 911. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that Ambulance came and took child outside to the Ambulance to work on him. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that they took child to hospital and the Ambulance staff told him that infant [REDACTED] was breathing but was not stable.

Mr. [REDACTED] reported when he entered the bedroom where infant [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were sleeping, he observed [REDACTED] to be on stomach with his head slightly turned to the right.

Other Children Interview/Observations:

CPSI called On Call Supervisor [REDACTED] to staff findings at 12:05am. CPSI reported to supervisor that there were no safety issues or hazards observed. CPSI had informed parents that infant [REDACTED] had to sleep at all times on a firm surface, preferably her baby bed. CPSI observed the home to have 4 bedrooms, 2 baths, kitchen and den area. CPSI observe the infant twins to have their own room, two baby beds were observed, clothing and other baby accessories. CPSI observed [REDACTED] to have bunk beds in his room and parents reported that two year old [REDACTED] to sleep with them. CPSI had parent to demonstrate how infant [REDACTED] was in the bed and how each child was position. Mr. [REDACTED] demonstrated how infant [REDACTED] was cuddled in his left arm while they laid on the bed. Mr. [REDACTED] reported that infant [REDACTED] was toward the lower right side of the bed, and originally [REDACTED] was on his right upper side. (Pictures were taken of children, and of the home)

CPSI was instructed by supervisor [REDACTED] to return back to [REDACTED] hospital to interview Medical staff. CPSI returned call back to [REDACTED] at 12:50am and relayed the following information. Attending Physician Dr. [REDACTED] was not currently on shift, he would not return until the following shift at 5am. CPSI spoke with Charge Nurse [REDACTED] who reported that the child was brought in on the day shift. Nurse [REDACTED] reported that she knew nothing about the infant, that they moved the baby to her for her to hold until discharge.

CPSI interviewed Nurse [REDACTED], who reported that he was not there when infant [REDACTED] was brought in. Nurse [REDACTED] reported no involvement with infant [REDACTED] except Disposition of the body. Nurse [REDACTED] reported that he didnt see any marks, or bruises. Nurse [REDACTED] reported that he did not see anything in the nursing notes that indicated infant had any marks or injuries.

CPSI interviewed Nurse [REDACTED], who reported that she had spoke with Charge Nurse [REDACTED] (who was on duty when infant was brought in) that she reported no suspicion of foul play and no marks or bruises. Nurse [REDACTED] reported that upon arrival the infant had a 30 heart rate and temperature was cold, that when he got there he was at core temperature.

CPSI asked several of the Medical staff of the current location of the infant, location of the morgue, but they were unable to give that information. CPSI left contact number and information for attending Physician Dr. [REDACTED] to return call regarding infant [REDACTED] and his findings at that time.
