CPSI was not able to observe the deceased child [REDACTED], as she had died on 4/19/13 and the Department did not received the referral until 4/26/13.

A statement was obtained from [REDACTED], half-brother, of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is only 10 years old. He reported that he did not sit next to [REDACTED] during the ride from school to his grandmother's ([REDACTED]) home. However, he stated [REDACTED] slept during the ride to his grandma's. He stated that when he came in from outside, he observed his grandmother trying to give [REDACTED] oxygen. He stated the police, ambulance and firemen came to the house and transported [REDACTED] to the hospital. NOTE: [REDACTED] later asked his brother if [REDACTED] was breathing when they were driving home. [REDACTED] (brother) stated, "No". CPSI noted that [REDACTED] was clean and neat in his appearance. He did not have any marks or bruises on his person that would indicate abuse.

A statement was obtained from [REDACTED], half-brother. [REDACTED] is 5 years old. He stated that [REDACTED] stopped breathing in the car. When asked how he knew, he stated that [REDACTED] stomach was not moving up and down. He stated that she did start breathing again when they arrived at his grandma's ([REDACTED]). However, she stopped breathing again and the Ambulance, Fire Department, and police came to the home. [REDACTED] was dressed neatly in dress pants and a white shirt. CPSI noted that he did not have any marks or bruises on his

Therefore, ██████████ died of complications due to her prematurity and the manner of her death was natural.

. ██████████ reported that ██████████ was born at 25 weeks gestation. She only weighed one pound and one ounce. she stated that her lungs had developed as they (medical staff) had given her steroids to ensure the lungs were developed. ██████████ had been born with a hole her heart. ██████████ had had heart surgery to rectify the hole. ██████████ also had a lung disease and she had to have oxygen (CPSI observed the oxygen tanks), ██████████ also noted that medical staff kept giving ██████████ steroids due to problems with her lungs. ██████████ reported that ██████████ kept having set backs due to problems with her heart and breathing. On the day ██████████ passed, ██████████ took ██████████ to see ██████████. She reported that ██████████ did not pick her up and have any "hands on" time. He only obtained a history from her. She stated that she had told ██████████ that ██████████ was eating right at that point. She did not feel like with was getting a good "suck" on the bottle. ██████████ reported that she also went to the WIC office to initiate the WIC and to SSA. At that point, she returned home as it was time to pick up the boys from school. She came into the apartment, took ██████████ out of the car seat and laid her on the couch. They rested for a minute before going to ██████████ Elementary School to get the boys. ██████████ stated that she noticed the time and had "told" ██████████ that she would take her to "grandma's so she could eat once the boys were in the car". Once she had the boys, she drove to her mom's house. She took ██████████ out of the car, carseat and all and took her inside the house to the bedroom. She fixed her bottle and tried to feed her, but ██████████ would not take the bottle. At that point, she realized that ██████████ was not breathing. She started CPR and yelled for her mom to call 911. Her mom, ██████████ took over the CPR and had ██████████ talk with the 911 operator. EMS arrived and ██████████ was transported to the hospital where she was pronounced dead. ██████████ reported that when the oxygen came to be installed the worker had put the oxygen at 1/4 liter of oxygen whereas it was 1 liter of oxygen at the hospital. ██████████ questioned the worker, but he showed the orders that called for the 1/4 oxygen. ██████████ also noted that she had forgotten to take the heart monitor with her that day.

According to the referral, ██████████ was found unresponsive in her car seat at approximately 3:50 PM on 4/19/13. It was reported that EMS responded to the call and transported ██████████ to ██████████ Hospital where she was pronounced dead. It was noted that ██████████ had been discharged the day before on 4/18/13 from the ██████████ Medical Center. CPSI contacted the Coroner's office and spoke with Investigator ██████████. She stated that the autopsy was complete, but the report was still pending. However, there had not been any marks, bruises, or other signs of trauma on ██████████ body that would indicate abuse. In fact, it appeared that ██████████ death was due to complications of her prematurity. Contact was made with the family. ██████████ had been born at 25 weeks gestation. ██████████ weighed only one pound and one ounce. She was born with a hole in her heart. Team Leader [REDACTED] reviewed and approves this investigation for closure. Child [REDACTED] was found not breathing while her mother was trying to feed her a bottle. Mother [REDACTED] performed CPR and yelled for maternal grandmother, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] took over the CPS while mother talked with the 911 operator. When EMS arrived at the home, they transported [REDACTED] to the hospital where she was pronounced dead 4-19-13 at 4:17 pm. CPSI [REDACTED] interviewed mother, [REDACTED]. Mother informed CPSI [REDACTED] that child [REDACTED] was a premature child and she had lots of complications as a result. According to mother, [REDACTED] only weighed one pound and one ounce. [REDACTED] had been born with a hole her heart. [REDACTED] had heart surgery to rectify the hole. [REDACTED] also had a lung disease. According to the autopsy, the cause of death was complication of premature birth. This case was coordinated with the [REDACTED] Police Department and staffed in evening CPIT. The classification decision was AUpU for Neglect Death. It should be noted that mother, [REDACTED] had two other children [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. According to CPSI [REDACTED], both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appeared to be in good health and there were no concerns noted.

CPSI did speak with [REDACTED]. He was dressed neatly in a T-shirt and shorts. This worker did not observe any marks or bruises on his body that would indicate abuse. [REDACTED] was playing with a "Leap Frog" device that allowed him to draw pictures. He told this worker that he knew his ABCs. He recited them for this worker. He also reported that he could count to 100. [REDACTED] was in Pre-kindergarten at [REDACTED] Elementary School. [REDACTED] is friendly and outgoing. He is constantly smiling. He told this worker that he likes school, but he does not miss it! [REDACTED] reported that he can ride a two wheel bicycle without the training wheels! He was very proud. The autopsy report listed the cause of death was "Complication of Premature Birth" and the manner of death was listed as "Natural". The Pathological Diagnoses were listed as "Infant small for age, consistent with premature birth and Chronic lung disease". The autopsy reported noted that there was no evidence of trauma to [REDACTED] body during the postmortem examination. It also noted that [REDACTED] was small for her age due to her prematurity. The report also noted that her lungs displayed abnormalities that were consistent with "bronchopulmonary dysplasia". Therefore, [REDACTED] died of complications due to her prematurity and the manner of her death was natural.

CPSI noted that grief counseling had not been placed in the home yet. [REDACTED] stated she did not want grief counseling at this time. She reported that she was moving to [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], she already has an interview for a job at a nursing home. The interview is to take place on 7/16/13. [REDACTED] noted that she had realized that she would not be able to move until [REDACTED] case with the Department was closed. However, she wants to move as soon as possible. [REDACTED] reported that she had planned to move prior to [REDACTED] death, but at that time she had planned for [REDACTED] to get stronger and was prepared to wait for about a year before moving. However, due to [REDACTED] death she wants to go ahead and move as quickly as possible. CPSI asked about grief counseling for the boys. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] does not need grief counseling due to his age and immaturity/lack of understanding. However, she noted that [REDACTED] may need grief counseling in the future. [REDACTED] noted that [REDACTED] is currently receiving counseling and medication at [REDACTED] Counseling Center for his diagnosis of ADHD.

CPSI asked about [REDACTED] ADHD. [REDACTED] noted that [REDACTED] has been suspended from school due to his ADHD. He attends [REDACTED] Elementary School. He was suspended for taking his medication to school. He is currently taking Vyvanse 50 mg. He was also suspended for having a "tantrum" at school. However, his behavior has improved since he is on his medication and is receiving his counseling on a regular basis.
