[REDACTED] came rushing into the [REDACTED] Medical Center ER this evening with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported that she was at work this evening, and her paramour was home with the children. [REDACTED] stated that when [REDACTED] arrived home, [REDACTED] was unresponsive. [REDACTED] reported that her paramour brought [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to the ER. Security reported that the paramour sat outside for approximately 10 minutes, and then he drove off. Since that time, the paramour has been taken into Police custody. [REDACTED] was stabilized enough to be taken to [REDACTED] where she is currently.

It is obvious that the child was beaten, because she had bruising and a scratch on her chest. [REDACTED] had a seizure at the ER and her pupils were different sizes, indicative of a head injury.

On 05/29/2013, the Department of Children's Services received a referral with the allegations of Physical Abuse and Sexual Abuse. The report states ██████ came rushing into the ██████ Medical Center ER this evening with ██████ ██████ reported that she was at work this evening, and her paramour was home with the children. ██████ stated that when ██████ arrived home, ██████ was unresponsive. ██████ reported that her paramour brought ██████ and ██████ to the ER. Security reported that the paramour sat outside for approximately 10 minutes, and then he drove off. ██████ that time, the paramour has been taken into Police custody. ██████ was stabilized enough to be taken to ██████ where she is currently. It is obvious that the child was beaten, because she had bruising and a scratch on her chest. ██████ had a seizure at the ER and her pupils were different sizes, indicative of a head injury. Additional information was received stating ██████ reported that ██████ dropped her off at work at 10am this morning, and she called ██████ to pick her up at 8pm this evening. While on the phone, ██████ reported that he whipped ██████ but did not report why. ████████ was interviewed and stated that she has been dating ██████████ a little bit over a year and they lived with him for a little over 6 months. She stated that he had never disciplined ██████████ before. She stated that he kept her while she worked for the past couple of months. She stated that ██████████ talks real good and never told her that he has mistreated her or whipped her. She stated that ██████████ and ██████████ had a good relationship and she never complained about him at all. She stated that everyone in her family liked him and thought he was a good guy. She stated that during the day, she would text him every so often to check on them. ██████████ stated that on that day, she received about 3 messages from him. She stated that she told him about her being offered a permanent position on the job and he texted her back and told her he was happy for her. She stated that she didn't ask about ██████████ at that time. She stated that she texted him again later and told him that she was off work and she would try to get her aunt to drop her off. She stated that he called her 10 minutes later and told her that he whipped ██████████ because she was being hard headed. She stated that he sounded funny to her and not his normal happy self. She stated that she asked him was she was okay and was she hurt and did she need to go to the hospital. She stated that he told her he didn't know and she told him that he needed to bring her to him right now and then she hung up. She stated that she started walking away from her job. She stated that he kept calling her and she told him she did not want to talk to him, just bring her baby. She stated that they live about 20-25 minutes away but it didn't seem like it took that long. ██████████ stated that when he got there, he opened the door and ██████████ was in his arms. She stated that she got in the car and grabbed her from him. She stated that she appeared to be unconscious and her eyes were half open. She stated that she started breathing in her mouth to try and get her to open her eyes. She stated that he was telling her to calm down and that ██████████ was okay. She stated that she kept telling him to just take them to the hospital. She stated that he was saying that she was sleeping and they just needed to go home and let her sleep it off. She stated that she kept calling her name and she wasn't responding. She stated that she told him to take them to the hospital now or they would walk. She stated that he took them to the ██████████ Medical Center. She stated that they moved her out of the room because she was so hysterical. She stated that the Security Officer told her that the gentleman that brought her was still downstairs. She stated that he kept calling her phone, but she kept ignoring his call. She stated that the police questioned her and then had her to call him to come in for questioning, but he hung up on her.

DCS policy defines Child Death/Near Death as any unexplainable death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report. DCS policy also defines Child Death/Near Death as any child death caused by abuse resulting from direct action of the child's caretaker or the consequence of the child's caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of a child. Child deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.

DCS Policy defines that Sexual Abuse occurs when the target is a child as children are presumed unable to give informed consent to sexual relationships with adults. This includes sexually motivated behavior and intentional acts that produce sexual arousal or gratification such as explicit sexual acts, sexual penetration, sexual touching, and intentional contact with genitals, buttocks or breasts; adolescents or adults instructing children to engage in such behavior with each other; indecent exposure/voyeurism; and intentionally exposing a child to sexual explicit material.

After reviewing the case, it was noted that on 6/13/13, this case was presented to Evening CPIT where it was agreed upon by the team members to indicate for Physical abuse. Law Enforcement also decided to prosecute for Aggravated Child Abuse and Child Neglect. The mother's partner was charged with Aggravated Child Abuse and First Degree Murder. According to Evening CPIT on 6/13/13, the case was to be returned once the rape kit was completed. After reading this report, it is not certain if a Rape Kit was completed or not.

Investigator 3 [REDACTED] has been instructed to call [REDACTED] or Dr. [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] to determine if a Rape kit was completed and if so, what are the results. The medical examiner, forensic report shows Blunt trauma to the Head, Torso, Extremities, and Head and Neck area. Within the summary of the autopsy states, "Autopsy and microscopic examination was most significant for residual blunt trauma to the head. The Cause of death is Complications of Multiple Blunt Traumatic Injuries and the manner of death is Homicide.

Once the determination of the rape kit is completed, this case will be reviewed for approval.

[REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] kept saying that there was no reason to go to the emergency room and that the [REDACTED] was sleeping.
