On 05/13/2013, the Department received a referral concerning the allegation of Neglect Death of ██████████. According to the referral, ██████████ was a four month old male that was found unresponsive in his crib at 10:33 AM on May 11, 2013. ██████████ was transported to ██████████ by EMS. ██████████ was pronounced dead at 11:12 AM. ██████████ is the mother of ██████████

Summarize any other evidence or factors that support the investigative finding(s) for the allegation(s) of abuse/neglect:

CPSI interviewed ██████████, mother of ██████████. ██████████ reported that ██████████ had been to see Dr. ██████████ of the ██████████ on Monday, 5/6/13, for a follow up and his four month immunizations. He had been to the doctor's a week or so prior for thrash, bronchitis and an ear infection. ██████████ reported that ██████████ was usually not a fussy baby. He was happy. She reported that they had been visiting with ██████████ family as his sister (██████████) had gone to the prom on Friday, 5/10/13, and had returned home late-about 1:30 AM-2 AM Saturday morning. She reported they had initially left him in his car seat as he was asleep. ██████████ reported she fell asleep and ██████████ cared for him the rest of the night. ██████████ stated that when she woke up the next morning she checked on him and he was fine. (He was in his bassinet at this point). She started cleaning house and then the two little boys woke up and wanted eggs and bacon for breakfast. ██████████ and ██████████ got ready to go to the store. They stated that since their cousin, ██████████ (16 y/o) and a family friend (██████████) was present they would leave the 2 year old (██████████) and the four year old (██████████) and take ██████████. ██████████ picked up ██████████ (he was on his stomach at this time). When he picked him up ██████████ was facing ██████████. ██████████ stated his face was purple. She started screaming. ██████████ placed ██████████ on the bed and started CPR and 911 was called. According to ██████████, they did not get home until about 1:30 AM. He stated that when they returned home, ██████████ was asleep in his car seat so they left him in it. ██████████ stated ██████████ fell asleep, so he took care of ██████████. He reported that at about 4 AM, ██████████ woke up and was fussy, so he changed his diaper and tried to give him a bottle. But, he only took a little. He tried to give the bottle to ██████████ two different times as he was fussy, but ██████████ would not drink his bottle. Reportedly, he took less than an ounce. ██████████ stated that this was unusual as ██████████ likes to eat and is never fussy. He finally put him in the bassinet on his back so he could "calm himself". ██████████ rolled over on his stomach and fell asleep. ██████████ reported that ██████████ was able to roll from back to stomach and stomach to back independently. He stated that he kept checking on him as he was on his stomach. He stated that ██████████ face was to the side and his pacifier was in his mouth. ██████████ noted that Dr. ██████████ had told him if the baby rolls to his stomach independently to allow him to stay with monitoring. ██████████ reported that he went to sleep. He woke up; checked on ██████████ and he was fine-his face was to the side and his pacifier was by the side of his mouth. He got ready to go to the store and picked up ██████████ to put him in his car seat. He was facing away from him and ██████████ started screaming. He turned him around and he was purple in the face.

DCS policy defines Child Death/Near Death as any unexplainable death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report. DCS policy also defines Child Death/Near Death as any child death caused by abuse resulting from direct action of the child's caretaker or the consequence of the child's caretaker's failure to stop another person's direct action that resulted in the death of a child. Child deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.

It should be noted that on 5/14/13, the former Investigator [REDACTED] interviewed a relative, [REDACTED] who was on the scene during the death of the infant. On 5/14/13, Investigator [REDACTED] also spoke with the mother, [REDACTED] the father, [REDACTED] the sibling [REDACTED] who would not respond to Investigator [REDACTED] and another sibling who was too young to interview, but it was noted that the child was observed. Investigator [REDACTED] also interviewed other family members and observed the area where the child slept. Other siblings were also interviewed who live with the maternal grandmother.

Investigator [REDACTED] received the case on 10/7/13, who completed the recommendations of follow-up with the family; received the necessary signed documents and received the autopsy of the infant. The recommended tasks were completed and the autopsy results stated the cause of death being undetermined and the manner of death could not be determined. The case was presented to CPIT on 11/14/13 with the team's agreement of AUPU for Neglect Death and no Prosecution.

CPSI went to [REDACTED] to meet with siblings, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Also present was [REDACTED], maternal grandmother. [REDACTED] was angry when this worker arrived. She stated that she had been waiting for this worker. CPSI told [REDACTED] that she had just left her daughter, [REDACTED] home. CPSI explained that [REDACTED] had been late meeting her due to having to stay at the cemetery longer than expected. [REDACTED] did not apologize, but did "warm up" to this worker. All three girls were dressed in their school uniforms of blue skirts and white polo shirts and white tennis shoes. Their hair was neatly combed. This worker did not observe any marks or bruises on their person at this time that would indicate abuse. It should be noted that the twins were giggling when this worker attempted to engage them. They stuttered. They would answer direct questions only. They were very shy. [REDACTED] was very difficult to understand.

CPSI arrived at the home prior to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] returning home. CPSI was able to observe [REDACTED]. He is an active two year old. He was dressed in a Tshirt and diaper. He was grinning and running from person to person when this worker arrived. He was too young to interview. However, CPSI was able to note that he did not have any marks or bruises on his person. He was friendly and not scared of this worker/stranger.

The family contacted the parents and they stated they were almost at the home. [REDACTED] arrived in a couple of minutes after our conversation. She noted that the visit to the cemetery had taken longer than expected. She noted that the funeral would take place on Monday, 5/20/13. He reported that at about 4 AM, ██████████ woke up and was fussy, so he changed his diaper and tried to give him a bottle. But, he only took a little. He tried to give the bottle to ██████████ two different times as he was fussy, but ██████████ would not drink his bottle. Reportedly, he took less than an ounce. ██████████ stated that this was unusual as ██████████ likes to eat and is never fussy.
