Today [REDACTED] went to sleep and woke up and the children were missing. The children were playing on the floor when [REDACTED] went to sleep. [REDACTED] found [REDACTED] found that the screen had been pulled out from the dining room window. [REDACTED] started searching for [REDACTED] and called [REDACTED] who was at work. [REDACTED] was found at the bottom of the pool and had drowned. This incident occurred between 4:00pm and 4:30pm today. [REDACTED] and the two children were the only ones in the home at the time of the incident.

The home environment is observed to be trashy. There is no known history of abuse or neglect in the home. The parents do not have any known history with police.

LACK OF SUPERVISION:

DCS Policy defines Lack of Supervision as a failure to provide adequate supervision by a parent or other caretaker, who is able to do so. A lack of supervision allegation or determination means that the child has been placed in a situation that requires actions beyond the child's level of maturity, physical ability, and/or mental ability; or the Caregiver inadequately supervises a child. The caregiver is with the child but is unable or unwilling to supervise (e.g., the caregiver is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, is depressed, sleeps during the day, or has inadequate parenting knowledge or skills). Lack of Supervision is also defined as any registered sex offender residing in a home with unrelated minor children or victim of offender, and/or caregiver knowingly resides with and/or allows children to be unsupervised with a registered sex offender.

NEGLECT DEATH:

DCS Policy defines any child death that is the result of the caretakers failure to meet childcare responsibilities.

The Department received a referral on 4/11/13 concerning the Neglect Death and Lack of Supervision of ██████████ and ██████████. The case was responded during on call hours by CPSI ██████████ and then transferred to CPSI ██████████ for completion. CPSI ██████████ was advised to make contact with child and his family and request autopsy in the absence of CPSI ██████████. CPSI ██████████ obtained copy of autopsy on 11/20/2013. The cause of death is Drowning and the manner of death is Accident.

CPSI ██████████ responded to the referral. Per her investigation, the mother, ██████████ reported that she had fallen asleep while watching the twins and TV. When she woke up, the twins were missing. It was discovered by ██████████ upon his arrival home that ██████████ somehow fell in the pool and he had drowned. The pool was uncovered. He initiated CPR and 911 was called. ██████████ was transported to the hospital and pronounced dead. The sibling, ██████████ was placed on an IPA with the maternal aunt and uncle, ██████████ and ██████████. A Child and Family Team Meeting was held. The decision made to proceed with PCO.

Approval for expedited placement with maternal aunt, ██████████ and her husband. The expedite paperwork was approved by Team Coordinator along with Regional Administrator ██████████. The PCO was filed.

A subsequent home visit at the ██████████ home was made by CPSI ██████████ to ensure safety of ██████████ surviving child if he returns home. CPSI ██████████ verified pool covered and drained. There was also a fence around pool and another fence to divide the backyard from the pool area. A Drug screen completed and negative for ██████████. The Preliminary Hearing was held and ██████████ was allowed to return to his parents, ██████████ and ██████████ on 4/17/13. The funeral for ██████████ was held on 4/18/13. Grief counseling is being provided by the ██████████.

[REDACTED] informed that she was watching Jeopardy while [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were playing with their ipads in the same room where she was watching television. She advised that she fell asleep. [REDACTED] reported that she woke up and saw that Jeopardy (a 30 min. show) was still on, but didnt see the boys. She reported that she immediately began to call for them. [REDACTED] advised that she keeps the door leading to downstairs and upstairs locked so the children will not go to the bottom or top floor. She informed that they usually either go into the family room and play with their toys or go to her room and watch television. [REDACTED] reported that she walked through the kitchen and saw the screen was missing from one of the nearest windows once you enter the kitchen from the living room. She advised that the window was unlocked because they wanted to let fresh air in the home due to it being stuffy in the house. The window is observed to be a tall and slender window that sits very close to the floor. It has a latch/handle that has to be turned in order to open the window. CPSI, [REDACTED] observed the screen to be mangled (still attached but pushed outward) from the window. [REDACTED] reported that she heard one child when as she approached the window and called out both of the childrens name. She informed that she could see [REDACTED] but didnt see [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported that she went out of the backyard and saw [REDACTED] playing. She advised that she asked him about the whereabouts of his brother even though he is 2 years old. [REDACTED] informed that she looked around the pool and down the hills in her backyard. She reported that she went to the front of the home with [REDACTED] and looked for [REDACTED] and called out his name. [REDACTED] advised that she went back into the home with [REDACTED] and began to look around for [REDACTED]. She reported that she went back outside and went to a next door neighbors home and asked if they had seen her son. [REDACTED] also reported that she asked some children that she saw outside if they had seen her son. She advised that she then contacted her husband and informed him of the situation. [REDACTED] reported that she contacted 911 and family to help her find her son. She informed that her husband came home and immediately jumped in the pool. [REDACTED] reported that the pool was dirty since the fall and weather due to the pool not being covered. She informed that her brother also came to the home and jumped in the pool to look for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that the police had arrived and informed her to look around the home in places that a child might hide. She informed that shortly after that she heard screaming from outside as her husband had jumped back into the pool and found [REDACTED] at the bottom of the pool.
