[REDACTED] was taken by helicopter to [REDACTED] last night (09-02-2013) around 9:00pm. She was having seizures and was not responsive. She was intubated at [REDACTED].

According to the mother, four days ago [REDACTED] fell out of her baby swing. She said when she came out of the bathroom she found the child on the floor. The reporter does not think the child was taken to the doctor on that day. The mother said she did not think the child was hurt.

The mother said the child's paternal aunt, [REDACTED] (last name unknown), picked up the child around 2:00pm on 08-31-2013 and returned the child to the mother's home around 2:00pm on 09-02-2013. The aunt left the child in the care of the mother's boyfriend because the mother was at work at [REDACTED]. According to the mother, the child's maternal grandmother went to the home around 7:30pm and found the child unresponsive, and the grandmother then called the mother at work. The reporter assumes the grandmother also called for an ambulance. The mother said her boyfriend did not call her at work to advise her that there was something wrong with the child. According to the mother, she and her boyfriend spoke on the phone about an hour before the grandmother called her. She said her boyfriend told her that the child appeared sleepy and he was going to put her to bed.

The child's CT scan shows a right subdural hematoma and global cerebral parenchymal hypo density suggest global ischemia (reporter does not know what that means). [REDACTED] injury was described as a brain bleed. She is not responsive but it is unknown if it is due to her medical condition or if it is because she has a breathing tube. She was not responsive when she arrived at the hospital. She is in critical condition. Reporter does not have the medical knowledge to state if she is or is not expected to survive.

Through the course of this case the allegations of Severe Abuse and Abuse Death with AP [REDACTED] mother's paramour. A referral was received stating that [REDACTED] was taken to [REDACTED] Hospital after Ms. [REDACTED] was called home from work due to concerns with [REDACTED]. The referral stated that Mr. [REDACTED] had been watching [REDACTED] while Ms. [REDACTED] was at work. Through the course of the investigation, [REDACTED] prognosis was poor. CPSI [REDACTED] and CPA [REDACTED] met with the SW and Dr who are involved with the child. The following is a summary of the information obtained regarding the family and baby:

Dr. [REDACTED] reports she and SW [REDACTED] both spoke with the mother to the child and informed her that the child is very sick and may not live. CPSI [REDACTED] asked about a skeletal survey being performed but was told the infant is not stable enough for the test at this time.

Dr [REDACTED] reports the mother told them that last Monday the baby fell out of swing and had a faint bruise on her arm and a small red mark to her face and thinks it was from the carpet. The mother said later her mother told her about a bruise to her ear. When asked the mother said the paternal aunt cared for the baby during the weekend and at about 145 dropped her off at home. The mother reports the baby was fine and at at noon and mom left at 215 to go to work. She said at about 730 or so she felt compelled to call her boyfriend who was watching the baby and he said the baby was sleepy and he was going to lay her down. The mother said her mother called her and she the baby was non responsive. She said her mother's boyfriend went to check on her boyfriend [REDACTED] and when [REDACTED] answered the door he had the baby in his arms and she was lifeless. The mother said when she got there the baby was on the floor and was unresponsive. The mother reports her mother's boyfriend is the one who said to go and get grandma.

When asked, mother said the baby was picked up at 2pm on Saturday and returned 2pm on Monday and when the grand other went to the house the baby was lifeless at 730.

The mother reports she and [REDACTED] have been together since May and Dr. [REDACTED] reports [REDACTED] has not come to see the baby. She also reports the mother stated she did not spend enough time with her daughter and her mother (maternal grand mother) can not care for her due to health issues.

Dr. [REDACTED] the father to the child is [REDACTED] and he is very upset.

The baby does move her legs spontaneously but is too unstable for an MRI or skeletal Survey at this time.
