Describe (in detail) circumstances surrounding death/near death:

The minor child, [REDACTED] his mother, [REDACTED] his brother, [REDACTED] the mother's paramour, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED] were involved in a car accident on [REDACTED] at approximately 12:45 pm ET on 8/7/13. [REDACTED] was transported from the scene via ambulance to [REDACTED] Hospital. According to EMS [REDACTED] coded in the field and had to be intubated by EMS personnel. [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Hospital ER at approximately 1:58 pm ET and was transported to [REDACTED] Medical Center via ambulance and arrived at [REDACTED] Medical Center ER at approximately 2:52 pm ET. [REDACTED] was treated in the ER by [REDACTED] who is a Pediatric Trauma Physician. [REDACTED] injuries were determined to be Anoxic Brain Injury which means that his brain was without oxygen for an extended period of time. The CT Scan confirmed this diagnosis and no hemorrhage was observed on the scan. Physicians observed a widening of the Atlanto Dental Interval and Atelectasis was also shown on the scan meaning he had fluid in his lungs. [REDACTED] pupils were fixed and non-reactive upon arrival at [REDACTED] was on life support immediately and he was stabilized with fluids and a ventilator. According to medical staff, [REDACTED] coded this morning and was pronounced dead at approximately 8:52 am after extensive efforts were made to resuscitate him with Epi and chest compressions. [REDACTED] pulse would come back and then would weaken. [REDACTED] had a possible C2 fracture of the spine but wasn't confirmed. [REDACTED] was pronounced dead and taken to the medical examiner where an autopsy will be performed. According to medical personnel it is believed that [REDACTED] was in a 5-point car seat due to what appeared to be burns consistent with a harness.

Describe (in detail) interview with family:

CM [REDACTED] did arrive at the hospital at the time of [REDACTED] passing; CM [REDACTED] was unable to engage the mother and father verbally due to their dealing with the loss of their son. CM [REDACTED] did engage the medical personnel during her visit at the hospital. CM [REDACTED] did attempt to engage victim's brother, who is also receiving treatment at [REDACTED] Hospital, who is currently on life support due to having a bronchial/tracheal injury and head injury.

A formal interview with the family hasn't been completed at this time due to the sensitive nature of the case. The mother, [REDACTED] is currently hospitalized in the TSIC which is a trauma unit for adults. The mother had surgery due to having a broken femur and Tibia/Fibia on 8/8/13. The mother was medicated due the surgical procedure she had. The mother did hold [REDACTED] once he had passed. According to medical staff the father was present and appropriate. The father remains in the PICU lounge as no one is allowed to stay in the PICU after hours.

CM [REDACTED] has engaged medical staff at [REDACTED] Medical Hospital, but [REDACTED] had already passed away when CM [REDACTED] arrived. Hospital staff will be updating CM [REDACTED] as further information is available or if condition changes.

Describe disposition of body (Death): CM [redacted] observed [redacted] in the PICU once he had passed. CPSI [redacted] talked with RN [redacted] on 8/8/13 and also observed photographs of [redacted] body and found there to be burns and markings on his shoulders which could be consistent with a harness from a 5-point car seat. He was wearing a neck brace, and hooked up to an IV, and was intubated.

Describe law enforcement or court involvement, if applicable:
 CM [redacted] talked with [redacted] Officer [redacted] on 8-8-13. Officer [redacted] worked the car accident which took place on [redacted] on 8-7-13. Officer [redacted] reported when he arrived both children were lying on the ground with EMT staff working on them. He did report there was a booster seat in the car and a car seat as well. He did not know if either of the children were in those safety seats upon his arrival. CM asked him if he knew who the first person on the scene was or who took the children from the car. He did not know how they got out of the car.
 According to a preliminary report by [redacted] Sgt. [redacted] [redacted] was driving the vehicle which was a four-door [redacted] south on [redacted] when the vehicle crossed the center line, traveling across the northbound lanes, then south on an emergency lane, and then leaving the road. The vehicle then crashed into a concrete culvert, where it came to rest. The mother, [redacted] was in the passenger seat and both children were in the back seat. The initial [redacted] report stated that it was unknown if the three adults were wearing seatbelts, it also states the car seats and boosters were in the vehicle for two small children but it was also not known if they were being used to secure the two minor children at the time of the wreck. An indication of how violent the wreck was was the [redacted] battery was thrown forward from the vehicle and sitting on the grass about 50 feet from the vehicle.

Summarize the key points and dates of the child or children's statements and/or the observation of the child or children's physical state or home environment:

On 8/9/13 CPSI [REDACTED] did observe 5-year old [REDACTED] in the PICU. He was covered with a CARS cartoon blanket which was one of his favorite cartoons, he had a stuffed kitten at his bedside, along with a Batman balloon as this was his favorite action figure. CPSI [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] head, neck, and face to be very swollen as well as his lips. CPSI [REDACTED] observed the tubes running out of his chest and saw the fluid being drained from his body that appeared to be red in color. CPSI [REDACTED] talked to [REDACTED] nurse for the evening, [REDACTED] who stated that [REDACTED] has a non-repairable chest injury and anoxic brain injury. She further stated that he has a non-repairable bronchial/tracheal injury as well. She stated that the tests ran on his brain this morning all came back negative meaning he has no brain activity. RN [REDACTED] showed CPSI [REDACTED] left leg and showed that he still has reflex which is normal but she hasn't showed the family because it would give them false hope. CPSI [REDACTED] asked RN [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] was in pain and she said no. She said that when he came in he had some small breathes which was around 4:00 am and there has been nothing since. CPSI [REDACTED] rubbed [REDACTED] hand before leaving.

On 8/8/13 CPISA [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] in the PICU after he had already passed.

Pictures were taken of both boys and photographs of both children are in the file.

Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

On 10/18/13 CPSI [REDACTED] presented the Lack of Supervision and Neglect Death Allegations against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to CPIT at the District Attorney's Office in [REDACTED] on this date. People present were ADA [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] Det. [REDACTED] YSO [REDACTED] TL [REDACTED] Lt. [REDACTED] CAC therapist, [REDACTED] and CAC [REDACTED] ADA [REDACTED] and CPSI [REDACTED] did talk to ADA [REDACTED] and the results of the toxicology report on Mr. [REDACTED] were negative for all drugs. ADA [REDACTED] stated that after her conversation with ADA [REDACTED] that no criminal charges will be brought at this time. After presenting the facts of the case it was determined that the case would be closed as allegation unfounded/alleged perpetrator unfounded, no services, no prosecution regarding both allegations. The mother does have two other children that hasn't been in her care for several years even though there is a custody order granting her visitation and joint custody of the children with the father of those children being the primary custodian. It was discussed and recommended that DCS not intervene in this matter.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

On 9/16/13 CPSI ██████ talked to ██████ ██████ CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ who put the children in their car seats the day of the accident and she said that ██████ and ██████ did. She said that ██████ was in a car seat and ██████ was in a booster seat. She said that ██████ was in a booster but he kept taking his seat belt off so they had to get another car seat where he couldn't get out of it. She said that ██████ stayed in a booster because he didn't try to take his seat belt off. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ if she ever had any concerns with how the boys were restrained and she said that ██████ and ██████ both always put the children in their restraints the way a child is supposed to be restrained. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ where they were going and she said that they went to the ██████ ██████ in ██████ the day of the wreck because ██████ and ██████ both had to see a specialist about their knees. She said that afterwards they stopped at ██████ ██████ to eat. She said that on the way back she told ██████ she was going to take a nap because she had to work that night at ██████ ██████. She said that ██████ was fine, she believes that ██████ had gone to sleep, and both boys were asleep. She said that she went to sleep as they were passing ██████ ██████ in ██████. She said that she didn't wake up until they had already ran off of the road and her air bag hit her. She said that she only remembers bits and pieces from the accident. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ if ██████ was up all night and she said no. CPSI ██████ asked her if she or ██████ had used any drugs the night before and she said no, absolutely not.

On 9/19/13 CPSI ██████ talked to ██████ ██████ CPSI ██████ asked Mr. ██████ if he was taking medication at the time of the accident or now and he said that he only medication he took was ██████ for his stomach but he hasn't taken it in six months. CPSI ██████ asked Mr. ██████ if both children were in proper restraints and he said yes. He said that ██████ was in a car seat that he had bought him because he kept getting out of the old car seat so he bought one that he couldn't get out of. CPSI ██████ asked ██████ who put the boys in their car seat/booster that day and he said that he buckled ██████ into his car seat and his mom, ██████ buckled up ██████. CPSI ██████ asked ██████ if the car seat and booster was anchored properly in the car and he said yes. He said that he did go to sleep but it was from where he ate. He said that ██████ was asleep, his mom was asleep, and both boys were asleep. CPSI ██████ asked Mr. ██████ if he has smoked marijuana the night before or that day and he said no mam, the last time I smoked pot was about 5-months ago.

Summarize witnesses' descriptions of what they saw and what they believe indicates child abuse/neglect:

On 9/19/13 CPSI ██████ talked to ██████ ██████ CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ if she could tell me what she remembers from that day and she said no much. CPSI ██████ asked her what time they left that morning and she said she and ██████ both had a doctors appointment in ██████ at Dr. ██████ ██████ and saw Dr. ██████. She said that they left ██████ around 8:00 or 8:15 am. She said that she and ██████ both had x-rays on their knees and she said had a shot in her knee. She said that after they left the doctor they went and eat at the ██████ ██████. She said that they headed back around 12:00 pm. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ who put ██████ and ██████ in their car seats and she said that ██████ buckled ██████ in his car seat and she buckled ██████ into his booster. She said that ██████ kept unbuckling himself from his older car seat so ██████ went to ██████ and bought him a new one and one that he couldn't get out of. She said that ██████ didn't try to get out of his. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ if the booster and car seat were anchored properly in the car and she said yes. CPSI ██████ asked Ms. ██████ where ██████ seat belt was at on this body when she buckled him and she said that he was strapped across the top of his upper legs near his waist. She said that the seat belt didn't come across his chest. Ms. ██████ said that both boys were restrained when they left ██████ and restrained when they left the ██████ ██████. She said that she was tired on the way back and went to sleep right when they got to ██████ ██████ because that is the last thing she remembers seeing. CPSI ██████ asked her if anyone else was asleep and she said that she knows that both boys were asleep but she doesn't know about anyone else. She said that she doesn't remember anything after that.

Summarize any other evidence or factors that support the investigative finding(s) for the allegation(s) of abuse/neglect:

At the closing of this case all interviews have been completed and all dictation has been entered. DCS received a referral in August of 2013 with the allegation of Lack of Supervision (severe) against the mother, [REDACTED] and her paramour, [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The case was initially assigned to CPSA [REDACTED] on-call and was transferred later that day to CPSI [REDACTED]. CPSA [REDACTED] met the initial response. CPSI [REDACTED] added allegations of severe Neglect Death allegations against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on both minor children. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were involved in a car accident on 8/6/13 in [REDACTED]. The mother's paramour, [REDACTED] was driving the vehicle, the mother, [REDACTED] was a passenger, and [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED] was also a passenger. [REDACTED] passed away at [REDACTED] on 8/8/13 and [REDACTED] passed away at [REDACTED] on 8/10/13. Both passed as a result of injuries sustained in the accident. The investigation revealed that both boys were restrained but not properly according to a report completed by [REDACTED]. During the investigation allegations were made that Mr. [REDACTED] admitted to smoking marijuana the night before and sitting up all night the night before the accident. Mr. [REDACTED] denied drug use and denied sitting up the night before as he and Ms. [REDACTED] both reported that they went to bed around 11:00 pm the night before. Mr. [REDACTED] did state to THP Investigator, [REDACTED] that he did stay up the night before and went to sleep on the way back from [REDACTED] due to him being tired. Mr. [REDACTED] admitted to CPSI [REDACTED] that he did go to sleep on the way back to [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] due to him eating too much at lunch which over eating always makes him sleepy. According to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] in his car seat and [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] in his booster. A bystander stopped at the accident and reported that he cut the children out of their child restraints and pulled them out of the car prior to law enforcement and medical emergency personnel arriving on the scene. Mr. [REDACTED] toxicology screen was negative for all drugs which supports that he wasn't under the influence at the time of the accident. Based on a lack of evidence and the recommendation of CPIT, and staffings with supervision it was determined that both Ms. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] wouldn't be indicated for the allegations of severe Lack of Supervision and Neglect Death. There are no other children in the home.

At the closing of this case all interviews have been completed and all dictation has been entered. DCS received a referral in August of 2013 with the allegation of Lack of Supervision (severe) against the mother, [REDACTED] and her paramour, [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The case was initially assigned to CPSA [REDACTED] on-call and was transferred later that day to CPSI [REDACTED]. CPSA [REDACTED] met the initial response. CPSI [REDACTED] added allegations of severe Neglect Death allegations against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on both minor children. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were involved in a car accident on 8/6/13 in [REDACTED]. The mother's paramour, [REDACTED] was driving the vehicle, the mother, [REDACTED] was a passenger, and mother, [REDACTED] was also a passenger. [REDACTED] passed away at [REDACTED] on 8/8/13 and [REDACTED] passed away at [REDACTED] on 8/10/13. Both passed as a result of injuries sustained in the accident. The investigation revealed that both boys were restrained but not properly according to a report completed by [REDACTED] Highway Patrol. During the investigation allegations were made that [REDACTED] admitted to smoking marijuana the night before and sitting up all night the night before the accident. [REDACTED] denied drug use and denied sitting up the night before as he and [REDACTED] both reported that they went to bed around 11:00 pm the night before. [REDACTED] did state to THP Investigator, [REDACTED] that he did stay up the night before and went to sleep on the way back from [REDACTED] due to him being tired. [REDACTED] admitted to CPSI [REDACTED] that he did go to sleep on the way back to [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] due to him eating too much at lunch which over eating always makes him sleepy. According to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] in his car seat and [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] in his booster. A bystander stopped at the accident and reported that he cut the children out of their child restraints and pulled them out of the car prior to law enforcement and medical emergency personnel arriving on the scene. [REDACTED] toxicology screen was negative for all drugs which supports that he wasn't under the influence at the time of the accident. Based on a lack of evidence and the recommendation of CPIT, and staffings with supervision it was determined that both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] wouldn't be indicated for the allegations of severe Lack of Supervision and Neglect Death. There are no other children in the home. [REDACTED] did report for 9-months that she was pregnant and reported that the baby passed in the accident which was false as [REDACTED] wasn't pregnant at the time of the accident. Medical records have been requested and received. CPSI [REDACTED] did give [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] information regarding grief counseling. CPSA [REDACTED] engaged [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] upon meeting the initial response. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] supposedly had a miscarriage in [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] again had tattooed [REDACTED] on his arm.

CPSI [REDACTED] talked to social worker at [REDACTED] who informed CPSI [REDACTED] that she did meet with the mother, [REDACTED] briefly today and that the mother is on suicide watch and has a sitter with her at all times.

7:20 pm ET

CPSI [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Center to conduct a face to face on 5-year old [REDACTED] who is on life support in the PICU. Upon arrival CPSI [REDACTED] was informed by RN [REDACTED] and RN [REDACTED] that the mother has been to the NICU twice today to visit with [REDACTED] but continued to talk about her baby, [REDACTED] that she lost in the wreck and briefly forgot that [REDACTED] had passed away yesterday. CPSI [REDACTED] was informed by nursing staff that there was no change in [REDACTED] condition and he was still non-responsive. [REDACTED] had three brain test done this morning which were all negative, meaning no signs of brain activity. He had an EEG, Cold Caloric Reflex, and Corneal Reflex. CPSI [REDACTED] was informed that he will have another EEG in the morning to determined if he will be clinically declared dead.

CPSI [REDACTED] talked with Deputy [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] who informed CPSI [REDACTED] that he had gone up to the 5th floor to see the mother, [REDACTED] but there were approximately 25 people in the room taking pictures of [REDACTED] in the bed. Deputy [REDACTED] showed CPSI [REDACTED] one of the pictures of [REDACTED] that was posted on [REDACTED]. He stated that the mother, [REDACTED] has two other children by [REDACTED] who is a lot older than her and he believes that they are ages 8 and 13. He said that he doesnt know their names but knows that when [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] separated that [REDACTED] got custody due to [REDACTED] mental issues. He stated that [REDACTED] has had three baby showers and received approximately 2,000.00 in gifts and gift cards and wasnt even pregnant.

CPSI [REDACTED] did observe 5-year old [REDACTED] in the PICU. He was covered with a CARS cartoon blanket which was one of his favorite cartoons, he had a stuffed kitten at his bedside, along with a Batman balloon as this was his favorite action figure. CPSI [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] head, neck, and face to be very swollen as well as his lips. CPSI [REDACTED] observed the tubes running out of his chest and saw the fluid being drained from his body that appeared to be red in color. CPSI [REDACTED] talked to [REDACTED] nurse for the evening, [REDACTED] who stated that [REDACTED] has a non-repairable chest injury and anoxic brain injury. She further stated that he has a non-repairable bronchial/tracheal injury as well. She stated that

the tests ran on his brain this morning all came back negative meaning he has no brain activity. RN [REDACTED] showed CPSI [REDACTED] left leg and showed that he still has reflex which is normal but she hasnt showed the family because it would give them false hope. CPSI [REDACTED] asked RN [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] was in pain and she said no. She said that when he came in he had some small breathes which was around 4:00 am and there has been nothing since. She said that the father has been appropriate but the mother when in the PICU yesterday was still asking for her new baby as well as today and forgot that [REDACTED] had passed way. RN [REDACTED] stated that when the mother visited with [REDACTED] earlier today that she told the sitter that is with her that she needed pain medicine and when the nurse brought it the mother yelled at the nurse and said that she didnt want any pain medicine and didnt ask for it. RN [REDACTED] also stated that a man called the PICU earlier today and identified himself as the childrens stepfather and asked if [REDACTED] had passed way and he appeared to have a shaky voice and was told that information couldnt be given but if he knew the family he could call and get a status update from them. She said that he hung up after that. CPSI [REDACTED] again my contact information to the PICU and told them to call with any changes and to call once the other tests were completed in the morning. CM [REDACTED] arrived at the PICU unit at [REDACTED] Hospital located in [REDACTED] at 9:16 AM. CM introduced herself to staff and was told the 3 year old [REDACTED] had passed. CM asked when the time of death was called and learned it was at 8:52 AM on this date. Nurses reported there was a diagnosis of Anoxic Brain Injury which is lack of oxygen to the brain. CM asked the nursing staff if [REDACTED] spine was severed and they said it was questionable. CM [REDACTED] told the staff she had heard it had been severed and needed to confirm. The biological father [REDACTED] was present in the PICU room as was the maternal grandmother, [REDACTED]. CM asked the nursing staff if they could contact [REDACTED] with case management as [REDACTED] wasn't going to be available until 11:00 AM today. [REDACTED] arrived and asked CM [REDACTED] what the Department would need for their records. CM [REDACTED] told her whatever they could provide and she said they would get records to CM. CM provided the nursing staff with all contact numbers for CM as well as the fax number to the office. CM asked [REDACTED] if there would be an autopsy and she said probably as they do most of the time. CM [REDACTED] did not speak to any of the family as CM felt this wasn't the time for the Department to be asking questions or disrupting the families time of grief.

CM did observe [REDACTED] as the grandmother was standing next to him. He was a tall boy and very cute. He appeared to be big for his age. Of course he was not conscious and had life support tubing connected to him. CM also observed [REDACTED] after his family left the PICU. The nurse was taking all the tubing from his body. CM told the nurse he was a good looking young man and was now at peace and an angel with God. CM thanked the nurse for allowing CM to view the child.

CM talked with the team leader [REDACTED] from the ER while in the PICU. She reported if [REDACTED] had been restrained as he should have been there would not have been a seat belt mark around the neck area. {See pictures in CPS File} She reported [REDACTED] had coded at the scene and was taken to the [REDACTED] where he was revived and then transferred to [REDACTED] PICU. RN [REDACTED] reported Pediatric Surgeon [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] injury was inoperable as there was a hole in his trachea area. She told CM [REDACTED] the doctor had told the family and staff that [REDACTED] would not make it due to his injuries. CM learned his throat had been crushed by the seat belt.

CM asked the nurses if the mother lost the baby and they told CM [REDACTED] she wasn't pregnant. It is reported [REDACTED] had been telling everyone she was pregnant and due on 8-16-13. The hospital checked as the EMT's could find no

CPSI [REDACTED] called and talked to RN [REDACTED] with the PICU at [REDACTED] Medical Center on this date regarding [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who passed way earlier today and his brother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who was still on life support. CPSI [REDACTED] informed RN [REDACTED] that I was the new CM assigned to the case and was calling to familiarize myself and to check on [REDACTED]

RN [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] passed way this morning around 8:52 am ET. RN [REDACTED] stated that an autopsy will be performed on [REDACTED]. She said that at this point the cause of his death is injuries obtained during a car accident. CPSI [REDACTED] apologized if I may ask the same questions that CM [REDACTED] did earlier today and she said that was fine. CPSI [REDACTED] asked RN [REDACTED] what [REDACTED] injuries were. RN [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had an Anoxic Brain Injury which means that his brain was without oxygen for an extended period of time. RN [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] coded in the field and was intubated in the field by the EMTs. She said that he has a questionable C2 Fracture of the spine. She said that according to his CT Scan there was no hemorrhage. She said that the CT also showed a widening of the Atlanto Dental Interval. She said that [REDACTED] injuries were discussed with the trauma team at [REDACTED] once he arrived via ambulance to the ER. She said that his brain showed Atelectasis which means fluid in his lungs. She said that his pupils were fixed and non-reactive upon arrival to the ER. She said that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was the admitting physician and he is a Pediatric Trauma Doctor. She said that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are the two Critical Care Doctors in the PICU that were attending to [REDACTED]. CPSI [REDACTED] asked RN [REDACTED] what time [REDACTED] arrived at the ER at [REDACTED] and she said that he arrived at 2:56 pm ET. She said that [REDACTED] was on life support right away and was on the vent and was receiving fluids. She said that he coded this morning, medical staff started Epi and chest compressions. She said that they got his pulse back briefly but couldnt keep it. She said that he coded on life support. CPSI [REDACTED] asked if the parents had talked about [REDACTED] being a donor and she said that the father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] wanted to but the mother refused.

CPSI [REDACTED] asked about [REDACTED] condition. RN [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] via [REDACTED] at 2:08 pm ET. She said that when [REDACTED] arrived in the ER that he wasnt intubated and came in responsive talking high pitch that went to a little whisper which is a sign of a tracheal injury. She said that he does have a bronchial/tracheal injury. She said that the medical staff tried to intubate him but werent successful due to the damage of his trachea. She said that he started coding upon arrival to the ER at [REDACTED] so they started Epi and chest compressions and brought his heart rate back up. She said that the trauma team had to make an incision on his throat to insert a 3.5 cuffed Endotracheal Tube to open up his airway. She said that his throat is stitched. She said that he is now on the vent and has also been

diagnosed with Anoxic Brain Injury. She said that [REDACTED] CT Scan showed a lot of air in his lungs and neck. She said that when listening to him that it sounds like rice crispies when milk is pour on it. She said that when you touch his chest and neck that is what you hear. She said that he has extensive subacute emphysema that is tracking from his neck into his face. She said that Dr. [REDACTED] viewed [REDACTED] Scan and said that [REDACTED] head injury was worse than brothers. She said that [REDACTED] pupils were fixed and non-responsive when he arrived in the PICU. She said that [REDACTED] is currently on three different drips; Epi drip, dopamine drip (helping with heart rate and blood pressure), and Baso Pressin drip (helping with his kidneys) because he had a lot of urine output. She said that tomorrow [REDACTED] will be the Critical Care Physician in the PICU and they will begin running a series of tests on [REDACTED] brain to see if there is any activity. She said that the following tests will be conducted: Brain Apnea which is where medical personnel will take [REDACTED] off of the vent to see if he breathes on his own, Corneal Reflex which is where medical personnel will hold cotton balls to the eye to keep the eye open to look for a twitch, the Cold Caloric Reflex which is where medical personnel will put ice cold water in a feeding tube syringe and put a drop in the ear and will open the eye to see if there has been any reaction. She said that the last test will be an EEG. She said that [REDACTED] currently has three tubes running from his chest, two in the right side and one in the left side which is helping with the air and bloody fluid. She said that the main part of his injury is on the right side of his chest. She said that he has also a Foley Catheter so that they can accurately measure his urine output. She said that it is very doubtful that [REDACTED] will survive.

CPSI [REDACTED] asked if medical staff could tell whether or not either child was restrained properly in the vehicle upon impact and she said that [REDACTED] appeared to have two marks and burns on top of both shoulders which would be consistent with the harness from a 5-point car seat. She said that from what she read in the chart EMS stated that neither child was restrained properly which means that even if [REDACTED] was in the car seat, the car seat itself may not have been anchored properly. She said that [REDACTED] has no marks consistent with him being restrained in a booster. She said that he has no bruising at the waist or across his chest.

CPSI [REDACTED] asked about the family and she said that the mother had surgery this morning to repair a femur, tibia, and fibia. She said that the mother was brought down this morning when [REDACTED] passed away and she held him. She said that the mother was still medicated from surgery. She said that the mother, [REDACTED] did hold [REDACTED] after he had passed. She said that she yelled at the doctor and kept yelling for [REDACTED] to wake up. RN [REDACTED] said that the mother yelled for another doctor. [REDACTED] was able to calm her some so the mom asked about [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] calmly told her that his head, lungs, and heart was sick right now and they were doing all that they could do for him. RN [REDACTED] said that the mother is a patient in the TSIC which is a trauma unit for adults. RN [REDACTED] said that the father, [REDACTED] has been appropriate and there was a question as to who has custody because the parents are still married but the mother is the primary custodian. RN [REDACTED] stated that when the mother was pinned in the car she kept yelling at EMTs about her baby saying that she was 9-months pregnant. Everyone started to panic and called the labor and delivery team to book an OR to do an emergency c-section and when the mother is brought in the team cant find the baby so they start to panic thinking the baby came out at impact so they started looking for blood on the mother and found none. The doctors determined that the mother wasnt even pregnant. RN [REDACTED] stated that she talked with the maternal grandmother who told her that [REDACTED] told the family that the baby was small and only weighed a pound, that her due date was 8/16/13 but that the doctor was going to put off delivery to 8/28/13 and would do a c-section which was the explanation that the mother gave to the family due to her not gaining weight. The grandmother reported that no one had gone to the OB appointments with the mother at the mothers request. RN [REDACTED] said that no one has been able to find out who the OB is. RN [REDACTED] stated that the family reported that the mother took [REDACTED] out of school early to go to an OB appointment in [REDACTED] and they wrecked on the way back. RN [REDACTED] was also informed by the maternal grandmother that [REDACTED] had a partial hysterectomy and was told that she wouldnt be able to have any more children. RN [REDACTED] stated that the mothers boyfriend is 19-years old and was the one driving the car when they wrecked. RN [REDACTED] said that the boyfriend hasnt been heard from. She stated that the father stays in the PICU lounge with his girlfriend whom the mother refuses to allow to have visits in the PICU with the children. 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10. Caretaker describes the child in predominantly negative terms or acts toward the child in negative ways that result in the child being a danger to self or others, acting out aggressively, or being severely withdrawn and/or suicidal.
11. Caretaker's emotional stability, developmental status, or cognitive deficiency seriously impairs his/her current ability to supervise, protect, or care for the child.
12. There is a pattern of prior investigations and/or behavior that suggests an escalating threat to child safety.
13. Other (specify)

If no immediate harm factors are observed, proceed to Section 3

Section 2: Safety Interventions

If no immediate harm factors are present, go to Section 3. If one or more immediate harm factors are present, consider whether safety interventions one through eight will allow the child to remain in the home for the present time. Check the item number for all safety interventions that will be implemented. If there are no available safety interventions that would allow the child to remain in the home, indicate by checking item nine or ten, and follow procedures for initiating a voluntary agreement or taking the child into protective custody. Mark all that apply:

Non-Protective Custody Interventions:

1. Intervention or direct services by worker as part of a safety plan.

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Section 3: Safety Decision
