Describe (in detail) circumstances surrounding death/near death:

Mr. ██████████ was interviewed at ██████████ Children's Hospital on 11/15/2013. He stated on last night, 11-14-2013 his wife; ██████████ nursed the ██████████ about 11:45 PM for approximately 30 minutes. ██████████ burped and went back to sleep. He stated ██████████ had been gassy and fussy so they bought her some Gripe medicine to give her some relief from the gas. Mr. ██████████ reports ██████████ woke up again at 1:20 am and she was crying and he got up to get the dropper to give her some Gripe medicine. He stated Mrs. ██████████ was rocking ██████████ but she kept crying. Mr. ██████████ stated ██████████ had a bowel movement and her Mrs. ██████████ changed her diaper and she began passing gas. He stated Mrs. ██████████ was moving ██████████ legs in a bicycle motion thinking this would help soothe the ██████████. The ██████████ continued to cry so Mrs. ██████████ got up and walked and rocked ██████████. He stated the ██████████ had another bowel movement or wasn't finished with the first bowel movement. Mr. ██████████ continued stating ██████████ and Mrs. ██████████ were in the living room and the father put his C-Pap machine on. He stated that he thought he heard his wife say she didn't think the ██████████ was breathing and he got up to make sure he heard her correctly. He stated he went into the living room and asked for ██████████. Mr. ██████████ stated the ██████████ was wrapped in her blanket and he blew in her face to see if she would move. He stated she took a deep breath and he didn't see or feel her breathing. The father unwrapped ██████████ and laid her on an ottoman and Mrs. ██████████ started CPR. Mr. ██████████ retrieved his cell phone and called 911 at 2:15 AM. He stated that the 911 operator stayed on the phone and the phone on speaker while they were instructed on what they needed to do until the paramedics arrived. Mr. ██████████ stated he had to run downstairs to let the paramedics in and the paramedics took ██████████ in the ambulance and the parents followed them to ██████████ Children's Hospital.

Mrs. ██████████ stated on Thursday, November 14, 2013 in the afternoon, she and the ██████████ took a walk around the neighborhood for approximately 20 minutes. Mrs. ██████████ reports being a stay at home and no babysitter are ever required. Mrs. ██████████ stated her mother assisted her in caring for ██████████ when she first got out of the hospital. Mrs. ██████████ stated her mother helped her for one week with the ██████████ due to her having a C-Section and a weight restriction. Mrs. ██████████ stated the ██████████ had been a little fussy for a few days and they bought her some Gripe medicine to help with gas and the fussiness. Mrs. ██████████ stated her husband came home around 8 pm and the ██████████ was in her bedroom sleeping. Mrs. ██████████ stated she was breast feeding her ██████████ and she does not pump milk due to her being with the ██████████ at all times. Mrs. ██████████ stated she nursed the ██████████ at 11:45 pm and burped her. She stated ██████████ was crying a little harder than normal. Mrs. ██████████ stated her husband went and purchased Gripe medicine and the dropper and she gave the ██████████ some Gripe medicine; she fell back to sleep. She stated ██████████ started crying around 1:20 am and at this time the ██████████ was in her co-bassinette in her parents' room. Mrs. ██████████ picked ██████████ up and started rocking her and she began passing gas. Mrs. ██████████ stated that she did bicycles with

the [redacted] legs to help soothe her. She stated the [redacted] had a bowel movement and she changed the [redacted] on her bed. Mrs. [redacted] stated that her [redacted] kept crying, a hard cry, and she wondered if she was hungry, but she wasn't. She states walking with the [redacted] and thought this would help, and then the [redacted] had another bowel movement. Mrs. [redacted] reports getting a diaper out of the [redacted] room and walked to the living room and changed the [redacted] on the sofa. Mrs. [redacted] stated the [redacted] stopped crying and was breathing hard, but she thought it was because she had been crying so hard, she said she did that about 3 times and went to sleep. She stated her [redacted] sleeps sound, so she laid her on the sofa. Mrs. [redacted] looked at her [redacted] and appeared that she was not breathing. She called her husband from the bedroom and said she didn't think the [redacted] was breathing. Mrs. [redacted] stated her husband took the [redacted] and the [redacted] took a breath and he laid her on the ottoman and un-wrapped the [redacted] and stated she is not breathing and she started CPR while her husband called 911. She stated her husband put the phone on speaker and they followed the instructions of the operator until the paramedics arrived and they took [redacted] to the [redacted] Children's Hospital, and they followed them.

When CPSI [redacted] arrived at [redacted] Children's Hospital she was met by [redacted] [redacted] the social worker on duty at the time [redacted] was brought to the hospital. As [redacted] [redacted] was taking CPSI [redacted] to the private conference room to meet the family and the detectives she asked about the current medical status of baby. Law enforcement was already at the hospital by the time DCS received the initial referral on [redacted]. At the time of CPSI [redacted] arrival Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] were already meeting with the family. Both detectives were given the same information as law enforcement and CPSI [redacted] interviewed the family together. Both went to the home to conduct the re-enactment. It appears Mrs. [redacted] re-enactment was consistent with statement she gave to both DCS and law enforcement.

At this time there is no court involvement, either in criminal court or juvenile court, pertaining to the family and the incident.

Case Summary

This case was received as a P1 Neglect Death on 22 day old [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The baby was having difficulty breathing and the parents called 011, but they could not save the baby. This baby was the mother's first child and the father's second child. No other children live in the home. The medical examiner states the baby could have died from heart complications, but the autopsy report is not complete at this time.

The case is being Unsubstantiated, pending the autopsy report and CPIT.

The parents did not sign any forms due to the father stating it was too much for his wife right after the reenactment. The family asked if DCS could give them some time. The family is Muslim, so the funeral will take place on Saturday, 11-16-2013. The father stated he will get in touch with CPSI [REDACTED] after the funeral.

The family did not give any collaterals.

CPSI called the father on Monday, 11-18-2013 and left a message. Mr. [REDACTED] stated his wife went to [REDACTED] with her sister and mother. He stated his wife could not take staying in the home. CPSI stated that grief counseling could be provided. Mr. [REDACTED] stated they might need it at some point, but not at this time. He stated he did not know how long his wife would be in [REDACTED] but he would go see her when his work schedule permitted him.

CPSI left a message on 11-25-2013 and 12-17-2013 for Mr. [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was also called and there was no answer.

A home visit was made on 1-26-14, but there was no answer at the outside door. CPSI called Mr. [REDACTED] and informed him that CPSI was at his home. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he and his wife are in [REDACTED] with his wife's family. He stated they would probably be there for at least 2 or 3 weeks and they would call when they come home. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he still has not heard anything from the detective or anybody concerning his daughter. CPSI asked how they were doing and he stated he is ok, but it is just one day at a time with her.

CPSI interviewed the mother at [REDACTED] Children's Hospital. Mrs. [REDACTED] is a new mother that does not have any other children. The mother was very upset and could barely stand on her own.

Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that on Thursday, November 14, 2013 in the afternoon, she and the baby took a walk around the neighborhood, it was no more than 20 minutes. Mrs. [REDACTED] is a stay at home mother and states that no one else has watched her baby, except for when she first got out of the hospital. The mother stated that her mother came to help her for one week with the baby due to her having a C-Section and having a weight restriction. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that the baby had been a little fussy for a few days and they bought her some gripe to help with gas and the fussines. The mother stated that her husband came home around 8 PM and the baby was in her room sleep and she was sleep in her own room. The new mother stated that she was breast feeding her baby, and she does not pump milk due to her being with the baby at all times. The mother stated that she nursed the baby at 11:45 PM and burped her. She stated that she was crying a little harder than normal. She stated that her husband went and got the gripe medicine and the dropper and she gave the baby some gripe medicine. The baby went back to sleep. The baby started crying around 1:20 AM and at this time the baby was in her co-bassinette in her parents room. Mrs. [REDACTED] picked her crying baby up and started rocking her, she stated that when she picked her up the baby started passing gas. The mother stated that she did bicycles with the [REDACTED] legs to help soothe her. She stated that the baby had a bowel movement and she changed the baby on her bed. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that her baby kept crying, a hard cry, and she wondered if she was hungry, but she wasn't. She stated that she started walking with the baby and thought this would help, and then the baby had another bowel movement, so she got a pampers out of the baby's room and walked to the living room and changed the baby on the sofa. She stated that the baby stopped crying and was breathing hard, but she thought it was because she had cried so hard, she said she did that about 3 times and went to sleep. She stated that her baby sleeps sound, so she laid her on the sofa. The mother looked at her baby and it didn't look like she was breathing, she called her husband from the bedroom and said she didn't think the baby was breathing. She stated that her husband took the baby and the baby took a breath and he laid her on the ottoman and unwrapped the baby and stated she is not breathing and she started CPR while her husband called 911. She stated that her husband put the phone on speaker and they followed the instructions of the operator until the paramedics arrived and they took the paramedics took the baby to the hospital, and they followed the ambulance to the hospital.

The baby was burped and went back to sleep. The baby was in her co-sleeping bassinet in her parents room. The father stated he and his wife were taking, he was on the floor and his wife was on the bed. He stated that the baby had been gassy and fussy so they bought her some gripe medicine to give her some relief. The baby woke up again at 1:20 AM, [REDACTED] was crying and dad got up to get the dropper to give her some gripe medicine. He stated that her mother was rocking her, but she kept crying. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the baby had a bowel movement and her mother changed her and the baby was passing gas. He stated that the mother was moving her legs in a bicycle motion thinking this would help soothe the baby. The baby continued to cry so the mother got up and walked and rocked the baby. He stated that the baby had another bowel movement or wasn't finished with the first movement. The baby and the mother were in the living room and the father then laid down and put his C-Pap machine on. He stated that he thought he heard his wife say she didn't think the baby was breathing and he got up to make sue that is what she said. He stated he went into the living room and asked for the baby. He stated that the baby was wrapped in her blanket and he blew in her face to see if she would move. He stated that she took a deep breath and he didn't see or feel her breathing. The father unwrapped his baby and laid her on a ottoman and the mother started CPR, the father went to retrieve his cell phone and called 911 at 2:15 AM. He stated that the 911 operator stayed on the phone and he had the phone on speaker while they were instructed in what they needed to do until the paramedics arrived. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he had to run downstairs to let the paramedics in and the paramedics took the baby and the parents followed them to [REDACTED] Children's Hospital.
