Mother is prescribed Amitriptyline, Gabapentin, Alprazolam and Cylexa and is diagnosed with BiPolar. While being interviewed at the hospital mother was experiencing chest pains and was taken back to the Emergency Room for medical evaluation at ██████████ ██████████ She provided DCS with her medications and pill counts were accurate. Mother did admit to using THC about 2 weeks ago.</p> <p>Aunt, ██████████, was also interviewed at the hospital. This case came to the Departments attention on 10-11-13 with allegations of neglect death.

DCS policy defines Neglect death as:

1. Any unexplained death of a child when the cause of death is unknown or pending an autopsy report.
2. Any child death caused by abuse resulting from direct action of the childs caretaker or the consequence of the childs caretakers failure to stop another persons direct action that resulted in the death of a child. Child deaths are always treated as severe child abuse.
3. Any child death that is the result of the caretakers failure to meet childcare responsibilities. Neglect death is always treated as severe child abuse.
4. Near Death - A serious or critical medical condition resulting from child abuse or child sexual abuse, as reported by a physician who has examined the child subsequent to the abuse.

Summary and results of the investigation:

[REDACTED] traveled with her mother, brother and grandmother to [REDACTED] from their home town in [REDACTED] TN. They arrived around 11 pm and was last fed around 3 am and was found deceased around 5:30 am. [REDACTED] slept in a bed with her mother and brother with one on either sides of her. The autopsy report stated it was accidental unless other factors arise but the cause of death is positional asphyxia which was a consequence of overlying due to unsafe sleeping environment.

Based on the summary and the results of the investigation, each allegation of neglect death meets the criteria as outlined by policy. This case is being classified as Allegation Substantiated / Perpetrator Substantiated. This case is being submitted to Lead Investigator [REDACTED] for review and closure.

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW/ CASE STAFFING -

This case was staffed on this date between investigator [REDACTED] and lead investigator [REDACTED]. This case came to the Department's attention on 10/11/13 as a neglect death case. The last admin review was held on 07/29/14, and at that time, [REDACTED] legal was going to confer with [REDACTED] legal to see if a severe abuse petition could be filed in [REDACTED] as that is where the birth mother is currently residing. An email had been sent to [REDACTED] attorney [REDACTED] asking that he contact [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] to see if this was a possibility. Inv. [REDACTED] called and spoke with DCS attorney [REDACTED] again to see if he has had a chance to follow up with [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. He had not yet had a chance to speak with her.
