CPSI met and engaged Ms. ██████████ (birth mother), expressed his condolences, and asked her to provide her account of the day of the incident. Ms. ██████████ stated that on 1 January, that ██████████ appeared normal, was eating, normal nap, played, lay down for an afternoon nap, played tummy time with her, and played with her new Christmas toys.

Ms. ██████████ said that about 16.30, she lay ██████████ down for a nap, departed the residence to procure dinner (prime rib) and cigarettes and returned about 20-30 minutes later. Ms. ██████████ said that she inquired of Mr. ██████████ if he had checked on ██████████ and was told that he had not, after which Ms. ██████████ again asked Mr. ██████████ to check on the child and he reportedly answered in the affirmative. Ms. ██████████ then said that Mr. ██████████ told her that the child was cold and carried her to the kitchen table to initiate CPR. Ms. ██████████ reported that Mr. ██████████ called 911 while she started CPR, and shortly later, Mr. ██████████ continued the CPR.

Ms. ██████████ said that the father of both children is ██████████ yet his name is not on either birth certificate and the two were never married.

Ms. ██████████ said that her child was born a micro preemie and born at 25 weeks, who had previously spent 115 days in the hospital, received multiple spinal taps, and had an IVH grade two brain bleed. Ms. ██████████ added that child had a seizure three days prior to Christmas.

Ms. ██████████ submitted to a random drug screen whose results indicated positive for benzodiazepines, marijuana and tricyclic antidepressants, and also admitted to having taken seroquel (100 mg), one-quarter xanax bar, and smoke Marijuana on 2 and 3 January. A photograph of the drug panel results was taken and filed in the case folder.

Ms. ██████████ is unsure how many times she has been involved with the Department and did not seem to remember that she has an open case with Department. Ms. ██████████ had earlier denied having used any illicit substances, but later added that she is on probation with ██████████ for 1/2 xanax that was on the floor of a friend's car.

Describe (in detail) cause or circumstance regarding the death/injury: Reporter States: [REDACTED] lives in the home with her mother, [REDACTED].
 The baby was born pre-mature at 24 weeks. The baby was born with a level 2 brain bleed and was seen for seizures on 12/23 /12. The baby had known health issues.
 On 1/1/2013 the mother said she fed the baby and put her down for a nap at 4:30 pm. The child was found 5:20pm. The child was found non responsive and not breathing. The child was transported to the [REDACTED] E.R. and was pronounced deceased.

Describe (in detail) interview with family: Unsuccessful face to face at residence on 01/03/13, at about 12.30. Telephone call, same day, at about 12.45, "family at funeral home making arrangements."
 [REDACTED] {mother's paramour} interviewed on 01/03/12 at 16.00, and said that he fed the child formula on 1 January, 2012, and the child was placed down for a nap. Mother reportedly departed the residence for about 15 minutes, returned, asked him to "check on the child." Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he did so, and the child was "cold to the touch" and "not breathing." Mr. [REDACTED] reported that child was transported to kitchen table where CPR was initiated. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that "nothing odd" was noticed the day of the child's death, and that the child was "giggling and playing."

Mr. [REDACTED] submitted to a random drug screen which indicated negative for all screened substances.

[REDACTED] {birth mother} interviewed at 16.20, same day, and denied drug use and previous DCS history, then remembered "one" case." Mother stated that at about 16.30, on 1 January, 2013, that she lay child down for a nap, departed residence for food and cigarettes, after which she returned about "20-30 minutes later." Mother stated that she asked [REDACTED] if he had checked on the child, he responded that he had not, and she encouraged him to check on the child, after which Mr. [REDACTED] reported that the child was "cold." Ms. [REDACTED] said that child was transported to kitchen table, and that Mr. [REDACTED] called 911 while she initiated CPR.

Ms. [REDACTED] reported that the child was a "micro premie" and born at 25 weeks, who had previously spent 115 days in the hospital, received multiple spinal taps, and had an IVH grade two brain bleed. Ms. [REDACTED] added that child had a seizure three days prior to Christmas.

Ms. [REDACTED] submitted to a random drug screen whose results indicated positive for benzodiazepines, marijuana and tricyclic antidepressants, and also admitted to having taken seroquel {100 mg}, one-quarter xanax bar, and smoke Marijuana on 2 and 3 January.

Detective [redacted] reported that "according to mother, [redacted] was fed 4 oz of formula around 1615hrs, placed swaddled in crocheted blanket, on her back, in bassinet (as normal) around 1630. [redacted] was asleep. Mother left to go to market and returned within 5-10 mins. [redacted] was left with boyfriend, [redacted]. Mother stated she looked in on [redacted] when she returned and she appeared to still be sleeping. Boyfriend checked on [redacted] around 1715 before they were going to have dinner and found her not breathing. They started CPR and called 911. CPR was continued until the child was pronounced at the ER. The child was born at 25 weeks with a IVH Grade 2 brain bleed and was in NICU for approx 4mos. An apnea monitor was in the room with [redacted] but not in use. According to mother, it was only used at night when [redacted] was put down at bedtime. None of the statements given appear to be out of sync with what was present at the scene. In 2007, mother had another daughter, [redacted] who died at 8 weeks (SIDS).

Red Flag---- Bio Grandmother called to make sure I was aware of [redacted] death in 2007 of SIDS and that bio mother had been recently trying to get bio grandmother to take custody of her children so she could go back to school. Also she said that she was told, mother had been "doing things" during her pregnancy to try and induce labor because she didn't want to have a girl."
