the child or otherwise harmed the child, either accidentally or non-accidentally, as the autopsy would show any trauma. Mrs. [REDACTED] then admitted to CM that the child had "rolled" out of her arms at approximately 2:00am while she was sitting, holding the child in the recliner. She stated the child's bottle fell into the floor and, when she reached down to pick it up, he fell out of her right arm. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated the child fell face up and was crying but seemed okay and returned to sleep.
