CPSI observed [Redacted] numerous times throughout the investigation. He appeared to be healthy and CPSI observe no concerns regarding [Redacted]. CPSI spoke with [Redacted]. He stated that he is 9 years old and in the 3rd grade. He stated things have been good at home and that he and his family are still staying with his nana [Redacted]. He stated that everyone is still sad from his sister dying. CPSI informed [Redacted] that CPSI was not at the hotel when the incident occurred and if he can tell what he remembers. He stated that he was sleeping on the bed with his twin sister and younger brother [Redacted] and he woke up his father crying and screaming. CPSi asked ██████████ if he remember staying at the hotel and what happen to his little sister and ██████████ stated that he was sleeping and woke up to his father trying to make ██████████ breath. He stated that his father could not make her breath because she was dead. ██████████ stated that he seen his father push on ██████████ stomach to make her breath and he was telling her "baby, come back to daddy". ██████████ began to cry and asked CPSi to contact his mother due to not wanting to be at school because he does not like it and he is bored.

CPSi received a copy of ██████████ autopsy report on 3/15/2013 from detective ██████████ and the Cause of Death was overlaying and the Manner of Death was Accident

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

On Call CPSA ██████████ responded to MRH. Detective ██████████ was present and interviewed the family at the time of the incident. Detective ██████████ stated that he spoke to the parents ██████████ and ██████████. The family was staying in a motel with six of their biological children and two cousins for a total of 8 children and 2 adults in the room. The father, ██████████ stated that the infant, ██████████ and 1 year old ██████████ was sleeping on the bed in between the parents. The father, ██████████ woke up and noticed that that ██████████ was laying on the infant ██████████ face. The father said that ██████████ was not breathing. The father started CPR. The mother contacted 911. The mother was walked through CPR instructions until EMS arrived. The EMS took control of the child while in route to ██████████. At ██████████ an ER Doctor pronounced the infant dead.

CPSA was able to speak to the mother at the scene of the incident and she stated she woke up to her husband screaming. The mother stated that the infant, ██████████ was sleeping in between the parents on the bed. The one year old ██████████ was laying on top of the infant face with his bottom only clothed in a diaper. The mother stated that the father started CPR from classes that they had learned at ██████████. The mother stated that she dialed 911 and they walked her through CPR.

On 3/11/2013, CPSi ██████████ spoke with Mrs. and Mr. ██████████. Mrs. ██████████ stated that she was in the hospital yesterday due to shock after the death of ██████████. She stated that she was given medicine for her nerves and release. CPSi explained to Mrs. ██████████ that the previous case, CPSi was conducting home visits at the ██████████ address and asked what happen to that residence due to them being in the hotel. Mrs. ██████████ stated that she was staying with her cousin and helping her with her children and her cousin was on Section 8 housing and they found out that everyone was in the home. She stated that she went to her mother's house first but they argue sometimes and she just wanted to get away with her family and that is why they were staying at the hotel for a couple of days. She stated they stated staying at the hotel on Thursday 3/7/2013. Mr. ██████████ spoke with CPSi and explained that he woke up about 9 or 10am and he observed ██████████ face down on the bed and ██████████ was on top of her. He stated that he seen ██████████ diaper print on the side of ██████████ face. He stated that time he tried CPR on ██████████ and after they called 911. CPSi explained to Mr. and Mrs. ██████████ that there was a concern with the condition of the room and the cleanliness and Mr. and Mrs. ██████████ stated once they

CPSI [REDACTED] received a P1 Investigation Referral # [REDACTED] on 03/11/2013 for allegations of Environmental Neglect, Lack of Supervision and Neglect Death with the alleged victim listed as [REDACTED] (1) [REDACTED] (3 months) Unknown (later known as [REDACTED] (10), [REDACTED] (8) [REDACTED] (8) and [REDACTED] (6)) and with the alleged perpetrator listed as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (birth parents).

On 5/17/2013, CPSI present this case to [REDACTED] County CPIT. CPSI present that Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] will be Indicated on the allegation of LOS and ENN due to the circumstances of the hotel room when referral was made. CPSI present that DCS will be closing the allegation of Neglect Death (NGD) as AUPU due to after interviewing all parties involved, it was determined that there is no evidence to substantiate the allegations in the case. CPSI received a copy of [REDACTED] autopsy report on 3/15/2013 from detective [REDACTED] and the Cause of Death was overlaying and the Manner of Death was Accident. ADA [REDACTED], Detective [REDACTED] and Nurse [REDACTED] disagreed with the classification due to wanting to take the case to Grand Jury.

After reviewing the case, RA [REDACTED] agreed to classify and close the case as AIPI regarding the allegation of Neglect Death. Due to the death of [REDACTED] being a result of the actions taken by the parents. By living in a hotel with 6 children, 2 adults and 2 additional people while they could have stayed with a family member and chose not to. RA [REDACTED] states there is no mention of the sleeping arrangement for the toddler (less than 2) and no mention of the supervision of the childrne while the parents were still asleep with the baby after 9am.

The statement can be found in the case file and CPSI will present this case back to [REDACTED] County CPIT on 6/21/2013.

Present for the discussion were CPSI [REDACTED], TL [REDACTED] and Attorney [REDACTED]. The decision was made that we would not pursue severe abuse in the petition filed in court, because it was only a ratified safety plan in court. The children were never removed from the care of the parents. The allegation of neglect death had to be indicated, due to circumstances of the case, but the case was not pursued in court.

Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she was staying with her cousin and helping her with her children and her cousin was on Section 8 housing and they found out that everyone was in the home. She stated that she went to her mother's house first but they argue sometimes and she just wanted to get away with her family and that is why they were staying at the hotel for a couple of days. She stated they stated staying at the hotel on Thursday 3/7/2013. Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] tested positive for their prescriptions and denied it affects their ability to care for the children.

An IPA was put in place for the parents to be supervised by maternal grandmother [REDACTED] until further orders of the court. The petition was dropped due to Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] obtained their own residence with adequate space for the children and they are cooperating with services.

On 5/17/2013, CPSI present this case to [REDACTED] County CPIT. Describe (in detail) cause or circumstance regarding the death/injury: CPSA responded to [redacted] Hospital. Detective [redacted] was present and interviewed the family at the time of the incident. Detective [redacted] stated that he spoke to the parents [redacted] and [redacted]. The family was staying in a motel with six of their biological children and two cousins for a total of 8 children and 2 adults in the room. The father, [redacted] stated that the infant, [redacted] and 1 year old [redacted] was sleeping on the bed in between the parents. The father, [redacted] woke up and noticed that that [redacted] was laying on the infant [redacted] face. The father said that [redacted] was not breathing. The father started CPR.

The mother contacted 911. The mother was walked through CPR instructions until EMS arrived. The EMS took control of the child while in route to [redacted] Medical Center.

At [redacted] Medical Center an ER Doctor pronounced the infant dead. [redacted] is being sent to [redacted] for a Autopsy. The full report is not in but there were no signs of trauma or signs of abuse.

The death is tentatively being listed as a suffocation while the toxicology report is pending.

The infants bedroom was looked at. Pictures were taken by Detective [redacted] and items such as blankets and sheets were taken in to be examined. There is no biological birth history on the infant at this time or any genetic abnormalities known with the biological family.

Information is being gathered about the biological parents and other information as the investigation goes on. This is all of the information known at this time.

Describe (in detail) interview with family: CPSA was able to speak to the mother at the scene of the incident. The mother stated that she woke up to her husband screaming. The mother stated that the infant, [redacted] was sleeping in between the parents on the bed. The one year old [redacted] was laying on top of the infant face with his bottom only clothed in a diaper. The mother stated that the father started CPR from classes that they had learned at [redacted]. The mother stated that she dialed 911 and they walked her through CPR. The father [redacted] was not present during the interview. The family reported that his whereabouts are unknown and that he is having a really hard time coping with the incident. The children, [redacted] and [redacted] were interviewed. The children reported that they were sleeping at the time of the incident and did not see what happened. CPSA observed the living quarters of the hotel room to be in complete disarray. There was uneaten food particles on the floor and left in bowls that had been sitting out for what appeared to be days. There were cigarette butts not in ashtrays. There were dirty diapers laying on the floor. There was medication (non-narcotic) that was not properly locked. There was a hunting knife laying on the floor with an open blade. An expedited home study was performed and the siblings in this matter were placed with the maternal grandmother. The parents will be staying with the maternal grandmother also, but a Temporary Restraining Order is being filed to only give the parents supervised contact at this time.

CPSA spoke with Investigator [redacted] from the medical examiner's office in [redacted] and an autopsy was completed and results are pending. [redacted] stated that there was nothing out of the ordinary and tests are in the process. The medical examiner stated that the family story is consistent with suffocation.

There was an open case with CPSI [REDACTED] at the time of death. The allegations were Drug Exposed Infant and Drug Exposed Child. The alleged victims were listed as [REDACTED] and the alleged perpetrator was listed as [REDACTED]. The CPS referral reported [REDACTED] had a prescription for Lortab, and she had some pills leftover from that particular time. [REDACTED] claims that she had teeth problems while she was pregnant, and she took Lortabs for that. A drug screen was done on the baby 2 days after birth, so its validity is compromised. The drug use was only discovered when the baby started showing signs of withdrawal. [REDACTED] was prescribed Lortab in April 2012 due to abscesses regarding her teeth. She was also prescribed Lortab after [REDACTED] birth by her OBGYN. At the time of the drug screen, [REDACTED] was already taken the prescribed lortab from the hospital. [REDACTED] was positive for opiates, but cannot be determined timeframe due to [REDACTED] being prescribed the meds. [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] were given drug screens by the hospital. CPSI referred the [REDACTED] family to Healthy Families and the services were working in the home, CPSI conducted school visits and home visits at the family home [REDACTED] in [REDACTED].

After interviewing all parties involved, it was determined that there is no evidence to substantiate the allegations in the case or that [REDACTED] was neglectful in the drug use due to the medication being prescribed. This case is being closed as AUPU.
