It is reported that [REDACTED] was sleeping in the bed with his mother, [REDACTED] and his three siblings. The cause of death on 9-29-2012 was asphyxiation. This was caused by the 11 year old in the bed rolling over and laying on top of the child. In the report it stated that the house was filthy and sparsely furnished. Medical personnel tripped twice walking down the hallway due to debris being everywhere. The family was asked to reenact what happened as they remember it and there was some questions raised after the reenactment on exactly where the child was lying in regards to the mother and the sibling.

This case was reviewed by the medical board during a monthly meeting and the DCS worker on the board suggested that it be reported.

On 04/19/2013, CPSI III, ██████████ spoke with ██████████. ██████████ stated that she was asleep on the couch and she heard her mom screaming and crying. She stated that her mom was looking for the baby. She stated that when she went in the room, her mom had the baby in her arms. She stated that she was scared so she ran to go and get her cousin. She stated that ██████████ was a good baby and he was loved by everyone. She stated that they all miss him. ██████████ stated that she is a cheerleader and a majorette. She stated that she makes good grades and enjoys school. She stated that her mom takes good care of her and her siblings. On 04/19/2013, ██████████ was interviewed and stated that everything in the home is fine. He stated that his moma takes good care of them. He stated that when he went to bed, the baby was laying close to moma. He stated that he slept at the bottom of the bed and his sister, ██████████, was up there at the top with moma and the baby. He stated that as soon as they woke up the baby was under ██████████. He stated that his moma had to go to the hospital with ██████████. He stated that he was a good baby and he was a good big brother to him. On 06/20/2013, CPSI III ██████████ spoke with ██████████. ██████████ stated that everything is fine in th home. She stated that she passed to the 6th grade and she makes good grades. She stated that she has been doing the activities with the ██████████ Church but she is getting ready to go her aunt's house and go swimming at ██████████ Pool. She stated that on the day of the incident, ██████████ was sleeping at the bottom of the bed and she was at the top of the bed with her mom and the baby. She stated that she was close to the baby. She stated that she sleeps wild and thinks she rolled over on the baby. She stated that her mom woke her up and she was crying. She stated that she asked her mom why was she crying and she told her that she rolled over on the baby. ██████████ first statement of what her mom said was you killed my baby, but she changed it after CPSI III asked her to repeat the statement. ██████████ stated that she still think about it sometimes. She stated that her mom called the ambulance and they took him to the hospital. She stated that she does not sleep in the bed with her mom anymore. ██████████ was very soft spoken when she was talking to CPSI III.

Summarize professional, medical or psychological findings or opinions: What is the collateral's oral or written finding/opinion of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

The autopsy results state that the cause of death is overlying. The contributory cause of death is co-sleeping with parent and siblings. The manner of death is accident.

Summarize alleged perpetrator's statement or admission: What is the perpetrator's explanation of the incident(s)/allegation(s)?

On 04/19/2013, CPSI III ██████████, made a home visit and spoke with the mother, ██████████. ██████████ stated that her sister and family were over to the house and left about between 9:30pm and 10:00pm. She stated that they went to bed about 11:00 pm. She stated that after they left, she watched TV in her room for a little while before going to sleep. She stated that she fed ██████████, burped him, checked his diaper, and changed his onesie and socks. She stated that she had started putting cereal in his bottle so he would sleep until about 5:00 or 6:00 in the morning. She stated that he was in the bed with her and when she went to sleep, it was just him and her in the bed. She stated that he has always slept with her because when she would put him in his pack-in-play, he would cry and she would have to take him out. She stated that he was asleep

on his back which is how she always put him. She stated that was close to the window and he was on the outside, but in the middle of the bed. She stated that her bed is King size. ██████████ stated that she woke up between 6:00am and 7:00am and was looking for him. She stated that she saw her daughter, ██████████, in the bed with them and ██████████ was lying where he was supposed to be. She stated that ██████████ was on her back asleep. She stated that her initial thought was that her 15 year old, ██████████, had come in the room and took him back in there with her, but she hadn't. She stated that she tapped ██████████ to wake her up, but she didn't respond. She stated that she tapped her two more times a little harder and she woke up this time. She stated that she asked ██████████ where the baby was. She stated that when ██████████ woke up, she rose up a little and that's when she saw ██████████ under her. She stated that she grabbed him and he wasn't breathing. ██████████ stated that she ran in the front room to her other daughter and told her to go call 911 because her phone was dead. She stated that they ran to the neighbor's house and knocked on the door, but there was no answer. She stated that after knocking several times, her daughter ran to her niece's boyfriend house. She stated that she ran out the house with ██████████ and met up with them coming back to her house and on the phone with 911. She stated that the neighbor finally came out and attempted to do CPR on ██████████. She stated that the ambulance got there and they took over and then took him to the hospital. She stated that the doctor told her that there was nothing else they could do for him because he was real sick and not breathing on his own. ██████████ stated that the house was a mess that day because she was going through the kids clothes for the change in the weather. She stated that she had taken all of the clothes out of the closet and bags, but she didn't finish because she had a headache. She stated that she cleans house daily because she has 7 kids.

Describe (in detail) cause or circumstance regarding the death/injury: On 04/19/13, the Department of Children's Services received a referral with the allegations of Environmental Neglect and Neglect Death. The report states it is reported that ██████████ was sleeping in the bed with his mother, ██████████ and his three siblings. The cause of death on 9-29-2012 was asphyxiation. This was caused by the 11 year old in the bed rolling over and laying on top of the child. In the report it stated that the house was filthy and sparsely furnished. Medical personnel tripped twice walking down the hallway due to debris being everywhere. The family was asked to reenact what happened as they remember it and there was some questions raised after the reenactment on exactly where the child was lying in regards to the mother and the sibling. This case was reviewed by the medical board during a monthly meeting and the DCS worker on the board suggested that it be reported.

Describe (in detail) interview with family: On 04/19/2013, CPSI III, ██████████ made a home visit. CPSI III spoke with the mother, ██████████ Ms. ██████████ stated that her sisters were over to the house visiting with them and they left around 9:30pm-10:00pm. She stated that went and got in the bed and watched TV for a little while. She stated that before she went to sleep, she fed ██████████, burped him, checked his diaper, and changed his t-shirt and socks. She stated that she expected him to sleep all night because she had started putting cereal in his bottle at night. She stated that he normally would wake around 5:00am or 6:00am. She stated that when she went to sleep, it was just her and ██████████ in the bed. She stated that he had a play yard to sleep in, but he would always cry when he was in it so she started putting him in the bed with her. She stated that she laid him on his back as usual, in the middle of the bed and on his blanket. She stated that she woke up about 6:00 something, close to 7:00am. She stated that she didn't see him when she woke up and thought maybe her 15 year had come in the room and got him. She stated that she saw her 11 year old daughter, ██████████ in the bed where he was supposed to be. Ms. ██████████ stated that ██████████ was on her back, asleep, and she started tapping her to wake her up, but she didn't respond. She stated that she tapped her two more times, a little harder, and she woke up. She stated that she asked ██████████ where was her baby and she said that when ██████████ raised up a little, she saw him under her. She stated that she immediately grabbed him and he wasn't breathing. She stated that she ran in the front room and told her 15 year old to call 911 because her phone was dead. She stated that she and her 15 year old ran to the neighbor's house and started knocking on the door. She stated that the neighbor did not answer so her 15 year old ran to her niece's boyfriend house. She stated that she knocked a couple more times and then began running towards her niece boyfriend house. She stated that her daughter and niece and boyfriend were coming towards her and they had 911 on the phone. She stated that the neighbor finally came out and began to do CPR on the baby. Ms. ██████████ stated that the ambulance came and they took over and transported him to ██████████. She stated that after working on him, the doctor told her that he was not breathing on his own, he was really sick, and there was nothing else they could do for him. Ms. ██████████ stated that she has a King size bed and she slept close to the window. with him in the middle of the bed.

Ms. ██████████ stated that her house was a mess that day because she had began going through all of the kids clothes to change out for the season change. She stated that she did not finish with the clothes because she had a bad headache so stuff was everywhere. She stated that she cannot afford dressers right now so she puts all the clothes in garbage bags. She stated that it's not uncommon for the kids to come and get in the bed with her. She stated that at first, they all use to sleep in the front room on the floor and the baby would be in his play yard. She stated that she was still sore from her C-section so she and the baby began sleeping in the bedroom.

The mother has 7 kids in all that reside in the home with her. The home consists of 4 bedrooms. Two of the bedrooms

did not have beds, one bedroom had a mattress on the floor, and the other bedroom had a king size bed. Clothes were observed in one of the rooms in grabage bags, but were neatly stacked against the wall. The home was not in disarray and was clean. No debris or clutter was observed in the home.

The allegation of Environmental Neglect and Neglect Death will not be indicated. This case was received on 4/19/13 and coordinated with [REDACTED] PD through morning CPIT on 5/3/13 with DA [REDACTED]. Previous history of the family was pulled and recorded in Tfact by CPSI3 [REDACTED]. All DCS forms were signed and the house hold composition recorded in Tfacts. All children other than the oldest child (due to him refusing to speak with CPSI3 [REDACTED]) were interviewed and/or observed. The mother was interviewed as well as a maternal Aunt. The safety assessment was completed with the screening decision of safe due to no immediate safety issues at this time. On 6/13/13, the autopsy results were received with the case of death being overlying, the contributory cause of death is co-sleeping. The manner of death is accident. The notice of Child Fatality report was completed on 4/19/13. Several homevisits were made with the family. During the assessment, it was determined that the family was in desperate needs for beds as the family was sleeping on the floor or several were sleeping on in the King size bed. Referrals were made with [REDACTED] and PSG's were completed so that the family could received beds and bedding. Counseling was also provided for the family.

The 740 Classification and Decision form will be forwarded to Juvenile Court upon the closure of this case. Evening CPIT was staffed on 7/18/13 with the team decision of AUPU and no prosecution.

On 04/19/2013, the Department of Children's Services received a referral with the allegations of Neglect Death. The victim, [REDACTED], passed away on 09/29/2012 and the cause of death was asphyxiation. There were concerns of environmental neglect in the home. It was stated that the home was sparsely furnished and filthy. Unannounced visits were made to the home on several occasions and the home was still sparsely furnished, but no filth was observed. All of the children were interviewed and observed. The mother stated that she and the baby and three of her other children were sleeping in the bed together. She stated that when she woke up the next morning, she could not find the baby. She stated that when she woke up her 11 year old, she saw that the baby was under her. The mother is currently employed and did not have the means to secure beds for all of the children in home. CPSI III completed case services for beds, bedding, and counseling for [REDACTED]. The autopsy results were received and state the cause of death is overlying, the contributory cause of death is co-sleeping with parent and siblings, and the manner of death is accident. The case was presented at CPIT Review and the CPIT agreed with the CPS classification decision. After investigating the allegations of environmental neglect and neglect death, the allegations are unable to be substantiated. All investigative tasks have completed. This case is being submitted to TL for review.

The Neglect Death referral was assessed and assigned by Team Leader, [REDACTED], on 4/19/2013, to CPSI CM3, [REDACTED]. The referral states, [REDACTED] (<1) and three unknown children (11), (8), and (2) lived with their mother [REDACTED].

It is reported that [REDACTED] was sleeping in the bed with his mother, [REDACTED] and his three siblings. The cause of death on 9-29-2012 was asphyxiation. This was caused by the 11 year old in the bed rolling over and laying on top of the child. In the report it stated that the house was filthy and sparsely furnished. Medical personnel tripped twice walking down the hallway due to debris being everywhere. The family was asked to reenact what happened as they remember it and there was some questions raised after the reenactment on exactly where the child was lying in regards to the mother and the sibling.

Response is due on 4/20/2013. The referent letter was mailed on 4/19/2013. Juvenile Court and the District Attorney are notified of referrals and classification on a monthly basis per local protocol and policy. Documentation of face to face contact should be entered within 24 hours of face to face contact with the family. Case must be classified at 30 days from the date of the referral. The case will reach fifteen days on 5/4/2013, thirty days on 6/4/2013, and sixty days on 7/4/2013.
