8/21/13 CPIT Classification Meeting: This case was presented to Child Protective Investigative Team for classification. It was determined that the case is Unfounded.

An autopsy revealed thick small vessels within the heart, which limited blood to the nodal (conduction) tissue and to the muscle. Also there was a moderate bacteria infection in both lungs.

The father, ██████████ spoke to investigators and stated that was happy for ██████████ to come home and thought that she had been acting normal over the weekend. He said he believed he would have known if she was high because he could always tell by looking at her eyes. ██████████ did not know how ██████████ passed away but did not think she was able to get any illegal drugs from anyone because he had been by her side.

Summarize witnesses' descriptions of what they saw and what they believe indicates child abuse/neglect:

██████████ stated that ██████████ was breathing funny last night when she was asleep. She stated that it was a deep, labored breathing. ██████████ stated that she asked ██████████ to sleep in the room with ██████████ in case ██████████ was sick. She stated that they had blown up a mattress in the living room for ██████████. ██████████ stated that this morning, her daughter came to her room and told her that she needed help because ██████████ may be dead. ██████████ stated that they got ██████████ and he came upstairs. She stated that he and ██████████ gave ██████████ CPR. She stated that ██████████ told her that the black stuff coming out of ██████████ nose and mouth was just chocolate. She stated that he gave ██████████ mouth to mouth, so he had tasted the substance. ██████████ stated that ██████████ did chest compressions on ██████████. ██████████ stated that according to her daughter, ██████████ was not vomiting with ██████████ woke up. ██████████ stated that when she went into the room, ██████████ was lying on her side and the black substance was coming out of her mouth and nose. ██████████ stated that she wiped the substance away, but more kept coming up.

8/21/13 Closing Summary: This case came to the attention of the Department on 4/29/13 with allegations of Lack of Supervision and Neglect Death. It was alleged that while ██████████ was on a 24 hour home pass from a drug rehabilitation center, she had drug overdosed. She was being transported to the hospital on a ventilator and is not expected to live. There was a concern that ██████████ was not being supervised appropriately. Upon further investigation it was learned that ██████████ had not went back to the rehab center at the scheduled time due to transportation issues with the family. The family was interviewed and stated that ██████████ had many friends over but was supervised at all times. The grandmother, ██████████ had custody of ██████████ and stated that she and the father had searched the room for illegal drugs before ██████████ came home from the facility. There were none to be found. ██████████ was proven to have a substance abuse issues for the past few years. At the hospital, she was positive for Benzos, Opiates and Amphetamines. The autopsy showed that ██████████ had cardiac small vessel disease which was combined with drug use and bacteria in her lungs. This case is closed as Allegations UNFOUNDED Perpetrator UNFOUNDED.

Describe (in detail) cause or circumstance regarding the death/injury: [REDACTED] was brought by Ambulance to [REDACTED] Hospital and then to [REDACTED] Hospital [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] was found vomiting on the morning of 4/29. [REDACTED] was visiting family at home from a 24 hour weekend pass from [REDACTED] Rehab Center. She was suppose to return to [REDACTED] on 4/28 but the family could not transport her there due to car problems. Upon admission to the hospital a urine screen showed that [REDACTED] was positive for Benzodiazepines, Opiates, and Amphetamines. Dr. [REDACTED] stated she was not prescribed any of these medications and her symptoms were consistent with a patient that had drug overdosed. [REDACTED] was in the custody of her grandmother at the time of this incident. The medical staff at [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was in critical condition due to Post Cardiac Arrest and were doing life sustaining measurements to help [REDACTED] survive. Another report (Intake: [REDACTED] was then called in to the Department on 4/29 due to [REDACTED] passing away at 10:48pm. [REDACTED] body will be sent to determine the exact cause of death.

Describe (in detail) interview with family: [REDACTED] (grandmother) was interviewed and reported that [REDACTED] got to her home on 4/27/13 on a 24 hour pass from [REDACTED]. She has had custody of [REDACTED] since she was born due to the mother's mental health issues. She reported that [REDACTED] was acting normal and happy during her visit. On the night of 4/29, Ms. [REDACTED] stated that the mother and father stayed the night because they wanted more time with her. Mrs. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] friend's had come by to see [REDACTED] but the family did not allow her to have contact with them. However, a 26 year old friend by the name of [REDACTED] was allowed to spend some time with [REDACTED] on the evening of 4/29. The father, Mr. [REDACTED] reported that he did not leave [REDACTED] side and supervised most contact. Mr. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] requested a few minutes of alone time with [REDACTED] in her bedroom. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he did not want to allow [REDACTED] in the home but was being encouraged by the mother and grandmother to allow [REDACTED] to have certain contact friends. With taking this in consideration, Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he allowed them to have unsupervised contact. He told them he would allow 2 minutes and then counted to 60 and entered the room. He stated that [REDACTED] was standing in front of the bathroom mirror and [REDACTED] was standing beside/behind her. [REDACTED] was in the home for about 45 - 60 minutes. The father stated that he had seen [REDACTED] high off pills many occasions and did not seem like she was under the influence any time during this night.

The grandmother stated that when [REDACTED] had went to sleep in her bedroom, Mrs. [REDACTED] heard abnormal, rythmic breathing by [REDACTED]. At this time, she asked the mother ([REDACTED]) to sleep in bed with her around 1 or 2am. The next morning around 09:00, the mother told the grandmother to come in the bedroom because she believed [REDACTED] may be dying. The father and [REDACTED] (neighbor, family friend) then conducted CPR on [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] was interviewed and stated he received a call at 09:10 to help. He reported that black stuff was coming out of her nose and mouth. This was later found to be chocolate from the night before and the doctor confirmed this would have been stomach contents. [REDACTED] was lying on her back when found the morning of 4/29. The grandmother was then told to call 911 shortly after Mr. [REDACTED] arrived.

[REDACTED]) interviewed the maternal aunt, [REDACTED] and neighbor, [REDACTED] at the hospital. They were only family at hospital when investigators arrived. [REDACTED] PD Major Crimes had already conducted their investigation after the call

to 911 was made on the morning of 4/29. Major Crimes had proposed the determination of this as an Accidental Drug Overdose. There is still an ongoing investigation due to the mother not being at the home or hospital.

[REDACTED] demanded that her grandmother and she switch purses. She instructed her grandmother to take everything out of her purse and let [REDACTED] take that purse with her to [REDACTED]. The elderly grandmother complied, but struggled to get her items from the purse. [REDACTED] behavior during this time was described as "bratty". [REDACTED] staff provided the family with information about family contact/visitation schedule, etc. They attempted to clear up misconceptions about the facility. Allegations leading to custody include truancy issues, lack of supervision, and drug addiction issues for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was very open to discussing her opiate addiction, but presented as if she could stay clean without extensive assistance. She told that she had detoxed while in detention for the past twelve days. TL and FSW were very open with [REDACTED] about what type of placement was being recommended and sought, but also that DCS placement was having difficulty finding a bed immediately for the type of program that she needed. The program needed to be a dual diagnosis program to help [REDACTED] with her drug abuse and to help her with mental health issues. While [REDACTED] did not want to go to residential, she was not presenting as if she would not go. She has no history of runaways and has all of her school credits, except for the four she is currently enrolled in. She was polite and respectful. [REDACTED] was also easy to talk to and appeared to speak openly about her situation and history. FSW [REDACTED] later took [REDACTED] to her temporary DCS foster home, as no level 3 bed was available at the time.

[REDACTED] may have to return to zoned school due to her failing grades from last yr. [REDACTED] said they had not gotten a notice of her having to go back to [REDACTED] yet. [REDACTED] also has regular visits with her bio-mom on a regular basis and [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] tries to boss her mom around especially when she wants cigarettes. CM will call [REDACTED] as a follow up to see if [REDACTED] went to her appt tonight. [REDACTED] agreed to go and it was explained to her the importance of her going and why. [REDACTED] expressed that she had problems sleeping at times but is fearful of being put on meds so CM told [REDACTED] to be opened and honest with the therapist as there are other options that can be utilized other than meds.
