Detective [REDACTED] shared her case summary with CPSI. Case Summary: "On June 30, 2013, I responded to [REDACTED] after being notified that the above named four year old male child had been transported there after being pulled from a swimming pool. After arriving at the hospital I learned the victim was in grave condition. The parents of the victim, who speak Arabic, were at the hospital and I observed that they were quite distraught.

The incident occurred at the apartment complex swimming pool at the [REDACTED] located on [REDACTED] where the victim and his family reside.

[REDACTED], a cousin to the victims father assisted in translation in the interview of the victims mother, [REDACTED] who was distraught throughout the interview. [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED], cell [REDACTED], is her husband and the father of their four children. Besides the victim their other children are as follows:

[REDACTED], 12 yoa, DOB [REDACTED], [REDACTED], 5 yoa, DOB [REDACTED], [REDACTED], 7 yoa, DOB [REDACTED]. Both parents work at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] works the day shift usually from 0700-1530 hours. [REDACTED] works the night shift usually from 1600 until midnight. She reported that [REDACTED] worked the previous evening and she worked earlier in the day. When she left for work in the morning, the children were left in the care of their father. She arrived home around 1600-1615 hours and a neighbor, unknown name, informed her that emergency personnel was on the scene because of her son.

Attempts were made to locate an Arabic speaking translator through the Police Department and the hospital. One could not be located. Staff at the hospital then used the Language Line to inform the parents of their sons condition. [REDACTED] became very distraught.

I went to the apartment complex and learned that the complex has a video camera that looks out on the pool and that the drowning had been captured in the video. In the video, it is revealed that the victim went into the water and at first stayed by the steps but then ventured further in the water. He is then seen fighting the water and the time displayed is 1601:20 hours. He fights the water until 1603:49 hours. A female believed to be a juvenile pulls him to the pools edge. Ten minutes pass from the time that the victim is pulled from the water until [REDACTED] arrives on the scene. Patrol officers inform me that the time is off on the video because of the time that they arrived at the scene. It is believed that the time is actually 1608 hours when the victim began fighting the water. I observed that the pool is enclosed with a fence and has two entry/exit gates. Only one gate is visible in the video. Each gate has a latch type lock on the outside near the top of the gate. Apparently, the victim came in to the pool area by following someone old and or tall enough to reach the latch to open the gate.

On July 1, 2013, I learned that [REDACTED], a DCS case manager was assigned to the case. I then spoke to [REDACTED]

I received a copy of a supplement report from Officer [REDACTED]. In his report, he wrote that he interviewed [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] told Officer [REDACTED] that the victim had been with him fifteen minutes prior to the incident. [REDACTED] also told Officer [REDACTED] that he had lost his brother and was looking for him.

I learned from ECC that call to them is received on Sunday, June 30, 2013 at 1612 hours. A male caller reports that a little baby is in the water.

I have received a copy of the Autopsy Report. The cause of death is listed as: drowning and the manner of death is listed as: accident. The report also notes that the victim was diagnosed with severe hypoxic brain injury secondary to drowning and suffered residual severe metabolic acidosis with cardiac dysfunction after being brought to the hospital.
