On July 31, 2013 Law Enforcement received a call from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she stabbed her two children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], a couple of times in their chest. [REDACTED] was stabbed in his chest and side. It is unknown how many times or where [REDACTED] was stabbed, but he had at least one stab wound to his chest. After this, [REDACTED] reported that she wanted police to kill her.

Upon Law Enforcement arrival, [REDACTED] had his eyes open and was breathing. His brother, [REDACTED], was unresponsive and CPR was being performed by Officer [REDACTED], who had already made the scene. Fire department made the scene and transported both children to [REDACTED] Hospital, where they were pronounced dead.

The mother, [REDACTED], remains incarcerated and has been charged with the murders of her two sons, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. This case has been classified as AIPI for Abuse Death, presented and approved by the CPIT team. The surviving sibling, [REDACTED] remains in the custody of the maternal grandmother, [REDACTED]. Services to address grief and mental health have been placed for the child and the grandmother. A Family Services Team Meeting will be conducted and this case will be transferred for Family Support Services.

[REDACTED] reported telling [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] is not watching her and that [REDACTED] was in [REDACTED]. She stated that she could no calm her down because she insisted that [REDACTED] had cameras in her apartment.

When asked if she ever thought about getting custody of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] reported that she had custody of [REDACTED] but the Judge said she was a stranger to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] report not wanting to deal with [REDACTED] and her rages. She stated [REDACTED] s family did not want to deal with her because of the way she is. [REDACTED] said this is why my son left her [REDACTED] also stated that once [REDACTED] called her while in hospital with tubes down her throat and cursed her out real bad. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was at her home for 3 weeks in the month of June.
