Concerning the allegations, Neglect Death reported the following:

[REDACTED] is the aunt of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] reports that all she knows is that [REDACTED] choked on a hot dog. [REDACTED] has been at her home since Monday. She reports that she and her husband [REDACTED] keep [REDACTED] and his brother [REDACTED] daily Monday Friday each week even at night. [REDACTED] does report that [REDACTED] (the mother of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] does have her own apartment but she helps her by keeping the children so that she can work.

[REDACTED] reports that she was at school when this happened. Her mom texted a friend in her class and told her it was an emergency. [REDACTED] reports that she called home from a friends phone and that s when [REDACTED] told her that [REDACTED] choked on a hot dog.

[REDACTED] reports that nothing like this has happened before. She reports that she has no concerns with [REDACTED] watching the children and still has no concerns with him now. [REDACTED] reports that she doesnt believe that [REDACTED] would do anything to hurt the children.

CM received a phone call from TC [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who reported that [REDACTED] and her husband [REDACTED] have history of drug use and that [REDACTED] has Arrest history involving drug use. TC [REDACTED] instructed CM [REDACTED] to ask each involved adult for a drug screen

CM Asked [REDACTED] if she would take a drug screen. [REDACTED] reported she would at first then reported that she would need to see a court order telling her to take a drug screen before she will take one. [REDACTED] got really upset and walked out of the interview.
