In the middle of the night between June 8 and June 9, 2013, there was a house fire at the address of [REDACTED], where the two families resided. It was found the cause of the fire was that [REDACTED] fell asleep while smoking in the bed while connected to her oxygen tank. The oxygen tank did not blow up. The mattress ended up catching fire.

As a result of the fire [REDACTED] (12 year), [REDACTED] (3 years), [REDACTED] (29 years), and [REDACTED] passed away. [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] all received injuries from smoke inhalation from the fire. The surviving persons did spend time in the hospital. Those who did survive were woken up due to the smell of the smoke. It is unknown if the family had smoke detectors or working smoke detectors in the home.

No charges have been made against anyone in the home. It has been alleged by family that [REDACTED] has caught fire to the bed three times before.

Mother states that she is aware of the situation somewhat as she has previously spoken with CM [REDACTED]

Mother reports that she was in the hospital for a long time and that she suffered second degree burns as a result of the house fire. She also showed this CM scars on her wrists and hands from where she had to break the glass out of the windows trying to escape the fire in the home. She reports that she tried to go back in after making sure that [REDACTED] was safe but that the fire and the smoke was too much. Since that time, her son, [REDACTED] has been seeing a psychologist at [REDACTED] pediatrics by the name of [REDACTED].
