The mother, ██████ stated that she woke up around 11:00 pm last night, 12/28/13, to feed ██████. At that time she took both ██████ and her brother, ██████ to the livingroom. She laid on the loveseat and put ██████ behind her knees and laid ██████ on her chest after feeding. She stated that she made sure ██████ face was turned to the side. ██████ woke up around 2:00 am this morning, 12/29/13, to feed ██████ again. She said that at that time everything was fine and ██████ had no problems with feeding or going back to sleep. ██████ stayed on the loveseat in the living room and left ██████ on her chest with her face uncovered. When ██████ woke up around 5:00 this morning, she noticed that ██████ had not moved, but was not breathing. She said that she picked her up and her head flopped. Her husband, ██████ rushed ██████ to ██████ Hospital in ██████ where she was pronounced deceased. ██████ stated that they did not attempt CPR and took her to the hospital themselves because they could get her there faster than an ambulance could get to them.

CPSI ██████ went to the family home around 11:00 am 12/29/13. CPSI knocked on the door and ██████ answered. CPSI introduced self and asked to come in the home. ██████ welcomed CPSI in and offered a place to sit. ██████ 10 months old, was in his high chair eating dry cereal. ██████ 5 years old, was very interested in who CPSI was and tried talking to CPSI and sitting in CPSI's lap during the majority of the visit. ██████ friend and grandparents were at the home. Her grandmother was cleaning up the kitchen and living room. Her grandfather was sitting on the couch. Her friend tried to corale ██████ and ██████ and then ██████ when he woke up. Both ██████ and ██████ wanted CPSI's attention and were very talkative. CPSI did not speak with them by themselves at this time because ██████ stated that they didn't know what was going on, just that ██████ wasn't at the home. She stated that the oldest sibling, ██████ was having the hardest time with it. The boys all appeared healthy and happy. CPSI noticed that their faces were dirty and was told that they had just eaten breakfast and had hot chocolate. ██████ appeared to be in shock. She was teary eyed, but was more focused on taking care of the children running around the room than being sad. She was able to talk with CPSI and not be angry or overly sad.

CPSI asked ██████ to fill out release forms for ██████ so that CPSI can contact the hospital and coroner. She was willing to sign them. CPSI asked ██████ to explained what happened and she stated that she woke up around 11:00 pm last night, 12/28/13, to feed ██████. At that time she took both ██████ and ██████ to the living room. She fed ██████ and then laid down on the loveseat and put ██████ behind her knees and ██████ on her chest. She stated that she made sure ██████ face was turned to the side. ██████ woke up around 2:00 am this morning, 12/29/13, to feed ██████ again. She said that at that time everything was fine and ██████ had no problems with feeding or going back to sleep. ██████ remained on the loveseat in the living room and put ██████ back on her chest with her face turned after feeding. When ██████ woke up around 5:00 this morning, she noticed that ██████ had not moved, but was not breathing. She said that she picked her up and her head flopped. Her husband, ██████ rushed ██████ to ██████ Hospital in ██████ where she was

pronounced deceased. [redacted] stated that they did not attempt CPR and took her to the hospital themselves because [redacted] could get her there faster than an ambulance could get to them. She stayed at the house with the older children.

[redacted] showed CPSI how they were laying on the love seat and CPSI was able to get a picture of it. [redacted] stated that a man, CPSI believes it to be the coroner or investigator, took pictures of the room and drew a diagram. She also stated that when [redacted] was born he had pneumothorax and was transported to the NICU in [redacted]. When he was seven or eight weeks old he stopped breathing and they rushed him to the hospital in time to be resuscitated. She reported that [redacted] had been born prematurely and her lungs were under developed. When she was two days old she went into respiratory distress and was intubated then sent to the NICU in [redacted] from [redacted] Hospital in [redacted]. She said that after she was released she was fine. She did not indicate any current health problems for [redacted].

The father, [redacted] and the oldest brother, [redacted] 8 years old, were sleeping while CPSI was at the house. CPSI did not ask for them to be woken up at that time, but stated that CPSI would have to talk with them soon. [redacted] stated that [redacted] and [redacted] were very upset. CPSI was able to lay eyes on [redacted] and he was curled up in the bed with [redacted] clutching his sister's blanket. [redacted] began crying when she saw [redacted]. She stated that his heart is broken. CPSI offered to help her get counseling for the family and [redacted] was thankful.

While CPSI was talking with [redacted] a church member and the pastor came to the home to bring [redacted] cards made by [redacted] Sunday School class and to offer help if they needed anything. [redacted] thanked them and told CPSI that they are a huge support for her family.

She stated that she made sure [REDACTED] face was turned to the side. [REDACTED] woke up around 2:00 am this morning, 12/29/13, to feed [REDACTED] again. She also stated that when [REDACTED] was born he had pneumothorax and was transported to the NICU in [REDACTED]. When he was seven or eight weeks old he stopped breathing and they rushed him to the hospital in time to be resuscitated. She reported that [REDACTED] had been born prematurely and her lungs were under developed. When she was two days old she went into respiratory distress and was intubated then sent to the NICU in [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] Hospital in [REDACTED]. She said that after she was released she was fine. She did not indicate any current health problems for [REDACTED].
